

The Youngblood Family Fund 2023-2024 Scholarship Application

The Youngblood Family Fund was established to provide assistance to undergraduate students in the Dornsife College of Letters, Arts and Sciences at the University of Southern California. This award is intended for students who are systems-impacted (i.e., whose lives have been directly affected by the prison system or foster care system) or who have experienced homelessness or housing insecurity.

Recipients of the award must be full-time undergraduate students in the 2023–2024 academic year with a Dornsife major. Students must have and maintain a minimum USC GPA of 2.5, be in good academic standing, and be making satisfactory progress toward the completion of their academic program. If your first semester at USC is Fall 2023 and you do not yet have a USC GPA, you are still eligible to apply.

- A resume (include information regarding your academic achievements, involvement in campus and community organizations, and work experience)
- A copy of your USC Unofficial Transcript (not STARS Report), available on OASIS through the myUSC portal
- A copy of your current year Financial Aid Summary, available on FAST (Financial Aid Summary and Tasks) via the myUSC portal
- Short essay (no more than one page) on the following topic: Reflecting on your background, experiences, and interests, how will this scholarship impact your experience at USC and beyond? (Note: We do not wish to make you recount painful or traumatic experiences in order to apply, but please make sure your essay briefly indicates why you are eligible for this scholarship.)
