

USC Trojan League of Los Angeles Joseph Patrick Allen Endowed Scholarship 2025 – 2026 Application

The Joseph Patrick Allen Endowed Scholarship was established in December 2001 by the Trojan League of Los Angeles in memory of Joseph Patrick Allen, former Dean of Admission and Financial Aid and Vice Provost for Enrollment at USC. Funds shall be used for tuition only, and shall not be allocated for room and board, research expenses, or supplies.

Recipients of the award must be full-time undergraduate students enrolled in the USC Dornsife College of Letters, Arts and Sciences at USC **beginning their junior year in 2025-2026**. They must have entered the University with a minimum GPA of 3.67 and have a minimum cumulative USC GPA of 3.0. In addition:

- Students must not be related to a current member of the Trojan League of Los Angeles Board or Scholarship Committee
- Students must have demonstrated merit and financial need
- Students must have demonstrated academic strengths, leadership skills, and campus and community involvement
- Students should complete a minimum of 12 units per semester, plan to graduate in four years, and maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA
- ❖ Preference will be given to permanent residents of Southern California
- * Recipients will be reviewed annually
- Scholarship finalists must be available to interview with the Scholarship Committee. You will be contacted if you are selected as a scholarship finalist.

- One letter of recommendation from a USC Dornsife faculty member
- ❖ A printout of your USC unofficial transcript (*not* STARS Report), available on OASIS via myUSC. There is no charge to download an unofficial transcript. Please do not submit an official transcript, which requires a fee.
- A summary of your USC financial aid package, which can be provided via one of the following:
 - A printout of your current year (2024-2025) USC financial aid summary, available on OASIS via myUSC (please note on this document which awards are renewable)
 - A self-generated list of the merit-based and need-based financial awards you received in 2024-2025 (please note on this document which awards are renewable)
 - A statement that you did not receive merit-based awards and/or need-based financial aid from USC in 2024-2025
- ❖ A resume (include information regarding your academic achievements, involvement in campus and community organizations, work experience, and your special talents and interests)
- An essay of not more than 300 words on how your academic program and extracurricular activities will prepare you for your chosen career
- ❖ A list of relatives who are USC alumni (if applicable)
