

Del Amo Spain Travel Fund Fall 2025 Application

PURPOSE: To study and gain a deeper understanding of the language and culture of Spain while participating in a semester-long or year-long study abroad program through USC taking place in Spain.

ELIGIBILITY: Applicants must have a declared major in USC Dornsife, have federally-determined financial need, and have a cumulative USC GPA of 3.0 or higher.

PERIOD: Fall 2025 Semester

APPLICATION DEADLINE: <u>Monday, March 24, 2025.</u> Email the completed application form and supporting documents to <u>scholarships@dornsife.usc.edu</u> by 5:00 p.m. (PST)

AWARDS: Award amounts range from \$1,000 to \$3,000.

APPLICATION MATERIALS: The applicant's file must contain the following documents:

- □ Application form
- Written statement on the following topic: How will engaging in study in Spain relate to your academic program at USC? In addition, how will living and studying in Spain contribute to your long-term educational, career, and personal goals? (maximum 2 pages)
- 2024-25 USC Financial Aid Summary from OASIS (even if you have already submitted a financial aid summary with your study abroad application, please include another copy with this scholarship application.)
- □ USC unofficial transcript: Your USC Unofficial Transcript is available at no cost on OASIS through the myUSC portal or Advise USC. Do NOT submit an official USC transcript, which requires a fee.
- □ (Optional) Statement of financial circumstances not reflected in financial aid award information if your family's financial situation has changed significantly in the past year (Max. 1 page)

FINANCIAL AID REPORTING: Any scholarship award funding received will be added to your USC fee bill and reported to the USC Financial Aid office. Scholarship funding may reduce or replace other need-based financial aid items such as grants and loans.
