

2026–2027 J. Wesley Robb Endowed Scholarship in Human Values

The J. Wesley Robb Endowed Scholarship in Human Values was established in 1987 by administrators, faculty, and former students of Professor Emeritus J. Wesley Robb to honor his lifelong service to the University of Southern California. More than 9,000 students took his “Human Values” course, or one of his seminars in medical ethics, philosophy of religion, or contemporary ethical issues.

Applicants must be students majoring in the USC Dornsife College of Letters, Arts and Sciences who will be seniors during the 2026–2027 academic year with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5. Recipients are chosen for their demonstration of significant moral leadership in the campus community, evidence of a commitment to human values, and deep concern for others. Because is a tuition-only award, students who are already receiving full tuition awards are not eligible to apply.

- A brief **resume**, including the applicant’s academic achievements, involvement in campus and community activities, work experience, and notable interests.
- **USC Unofficial Transcript**, available via ExperienceUSC under My Academics / Academic Records. There is no charge to download. Please do not submit an official transcript, which requires a fee.
- An **essay** of no more than 1000 words on how your activities both at the university and off campus demonstrate significant moral leadership, commitment to human values, and concern for other people.
- One **letter of recommendation** from a USC faculty member. The letter should be emailed by the faculty member and include both the applicant’s name and the name of the scholarship in the Subject line.
- 2025-2026 (current year) **Financial Aid Summary** from OASIS. Existing merit awards that may be renewed should be highlighted directly on this document. If no aid is received, provide a list of any merit awards received or a page stating you do not receive financial aid.
