

**Del Amo Spain Travel Fund
Fall 2026 Application**

PURPOSE: To study and gain a deeper understanding of the language and culture of Spain while participating in a semester-long or year-long study abroad program through USC taking place in Spain.

ELIGIBILITY: Applicants must be undergraduate students with a declared major in USC Dornsife and be planning to participate in a semester-long study abroad program through USC taking place in Spain. Additionally, applicants must have federally-determined financial need and a cumulative USC GPA of 3.0 or higher.

PERIOD: Fall 2026 semester or Fall 2026/Spring 2027 academic year

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Monday, March 30, 2026, 5:00 p.m. (Pacific Time). Email the completed application form and supporting documents to scholarships@dornsife.usc.edu.

AWARDS: Award amounts range from \$1,000 to \$3,000.

APPLICATION MATERIALS: The applicant's file must contain the following documents:

- Completed Del Amo Spain Travel Fund application form
- Written statement on the following topic: How will engaging in study in Spain relate to your academic program at USC? In addition, how will living and studying in Spain contribute to your long-term educational, career, and personal goals? (maximum 2 pages)
- Current year 2025-26 USC Financial Aid Summary from OASIS (Even if you have already submitted a financial aid summary with your study abroad application, please include another copy with this scholarship application.)
- USC unofficial transcript: Your USC Unofficial Transcript is available at no cost via ExperienceUSC under My Academics / Academic Records. There is no charge to download. Please do not submit an official transcript (which requires a fee) or a STARS report.
- (Optional) Statement of financial circumstances not reflected in financial aid award information if your family's financial situation has changed significantly in the past year (maximum 1 page)

FINANCIAL AID REPORTING: Any scholarship award received will be added to your USC fee bill and reported to the USC Financial Aid office. Scholarship funding may reduce or replace other need-based financial aid items such as grants and loans.
