Research Grant for Foreign Scholars in Chinese Studies

The Center for Chinese Studies is currently accepting applications for the 2024 Research Grants for Foreign Scholars in Chinese Studies. This program for foreign professors, associate professors, assistant professors (including post-doctoral researchers) and doctoral candidates in departments related to Chinese studies at foreign universities, as well as researchers at related



foreign academic institutes. CCS provides assistance with research expenses, research materials, liaison with universities and research institutions, and use of CCS facilities. Eligibility for travel subsidies is restricted to foreign scholars who currently reside abroad; those already in Taiwan are not eligible. The research should be undertaken in Taiwan, and be focused mainly on Taiwan or Chinese studies. See more information about the application here >
