2024 Summer Wrap!

The EASC community had a busy summer this year! We kicked off the start of summer with a reception to celebrate the Bruce and Francis Kaji Family Endowed Fund which enabled us to cover the lodging for our 2024 Global East Asia Tokyo cohort. In addition to the Tokyo program, we sent a group of students to Kyoto with support from the Cressant Foundation. Thanks to **Miya Desjardins** (Art History and EALC) and **Jason Webb** (Comparative Literature and EALC) for designing such engaging research study abroad courses for our undergraduate scholars! While abroad, our students researched diverse topics such as themed entertainment in Japan, informal fashion runways, and the use of Ryukyuan seashells in Buddhist architecture.

Our affiliated faculty have also been busy outside of the classroom with **Brian Bernards** (EALC and Comparative Literature) being awarded a 2024 Global Grant
Fellowship from the Asian Cultural Council and **Jenny Lin** (Roski) being awarded
the 2024-2025 Rome Prize from the American Academy in Rome. We also had

twenty-three EASC graduate fellowship awardees travel around the world for research, conferences, and language study. Stay tuned to see EASC grad fellowship awardee features later this semester! Our EAAS majors were also quite productive this summer with many working abroad on paid internships. A couple of our students had the opportunity to intern at the Santec Corporation in Aichi, Japan including **Cooper Brown**, a double major in East Asian Area Studies and Communications. Noriaki Tsuchimoto Research Grant

Deadline: Friday, August 30

The Council on East Asian Studies at Yale University invites applications for grants to support research utilizing the Noriaki Tsuchimoto Papers housed in Manuscripts and Archives in the Yale University Library. The collection is currently comprised of 83 boxes containing materials related to the filmmaking and other activities of the Japanese

documentary filmmaker Noriaki Tsuchimoto. The Council will offer up to four grants in FY 2024-2025 to support research utilizing the collection at the level of up to \$1200 for researchers traveling from North America and \$2200 for those coming from outside North America. Grant funds will be disbursed in the form of reimbursement for travel, lodging, meals, reproductions, and related research expenses while on campus. **Apply Here** >
