
EASC Guest Speaker Series

Mimicry, Cultural Ban, and Transplantation: Localization of Korean Screen Culture in Postsocialist China

Thursday, October 31, 2024 | 2:00PM-3:20PM | RSVP

Prof. Raymond Tsang invites the wider community to an event with **Dr. Tian** Li (Yale University). The Korean Wave, or Hallyu, has been a major cultural trend in China since the 1990s, thriving despite political conflicts and cultural boycotts. Dr. Li's research focuses on how Korean screen culture is adapted in China, using a concept she calls "screen capitalism." This idea looks at how people experience and share media across cultural boundaries even though the Chinese government has banned Korean popular culture as a response to political tensions.
