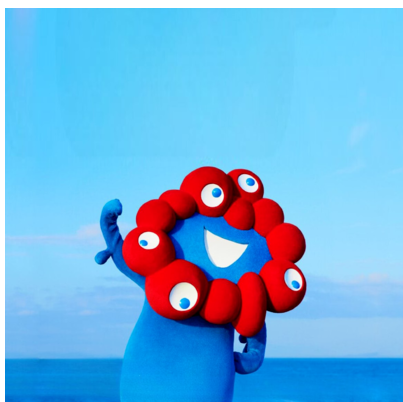

Flower Bird Wind Moon Staged Reading

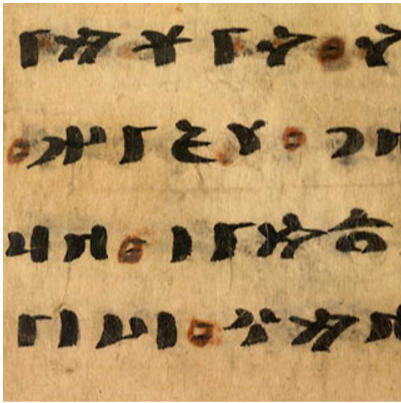
