#### **Admission Requirements**

This is a PDP, or progressive degree program. This means you may start graduate classes in the fall semester of your senior (fourth) year. If you want to choose this option, you should apply for the program during the spring semester of your junior (third) year.

The all-student deadline to apply for Fall 2025 admission to the progressive degree program is **Monday, March 10, 2025, 11:59pm**.

Beginning academic year 2023-2024, current seniors are also eligible to apply. Seniors wishing to apply may apply by the March 10, 2025 date or choose the **senior-only early action deadline of Monday, December 9, 2024, 11:59pm.** An early action application does not commit a student, if accepted, to enroll in the program; it merely offers an earlier notification of results.

Applicants must have a **3.3 minimum GPA** and have completed **64 units** of college course work after high school graduation.

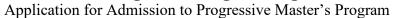
