



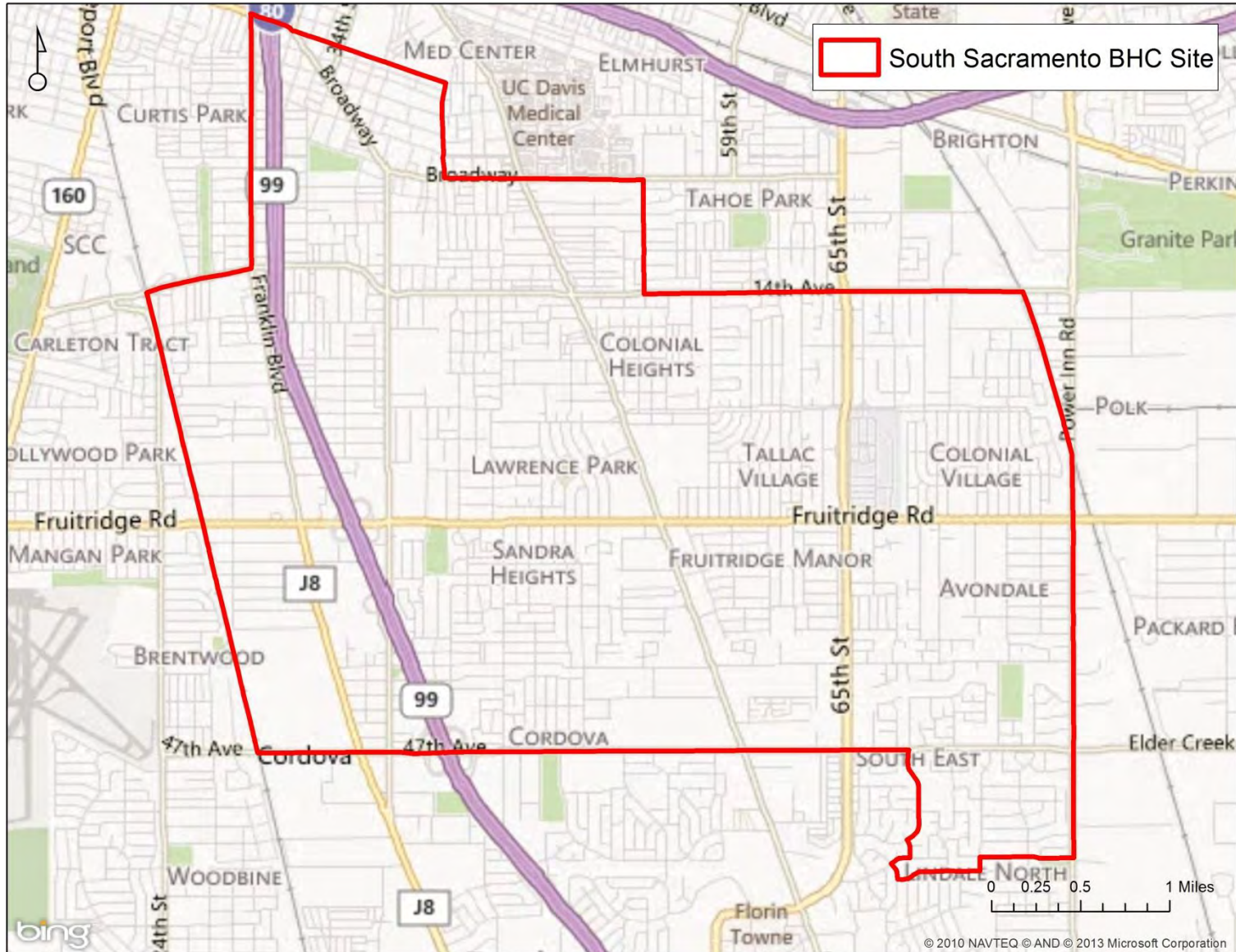

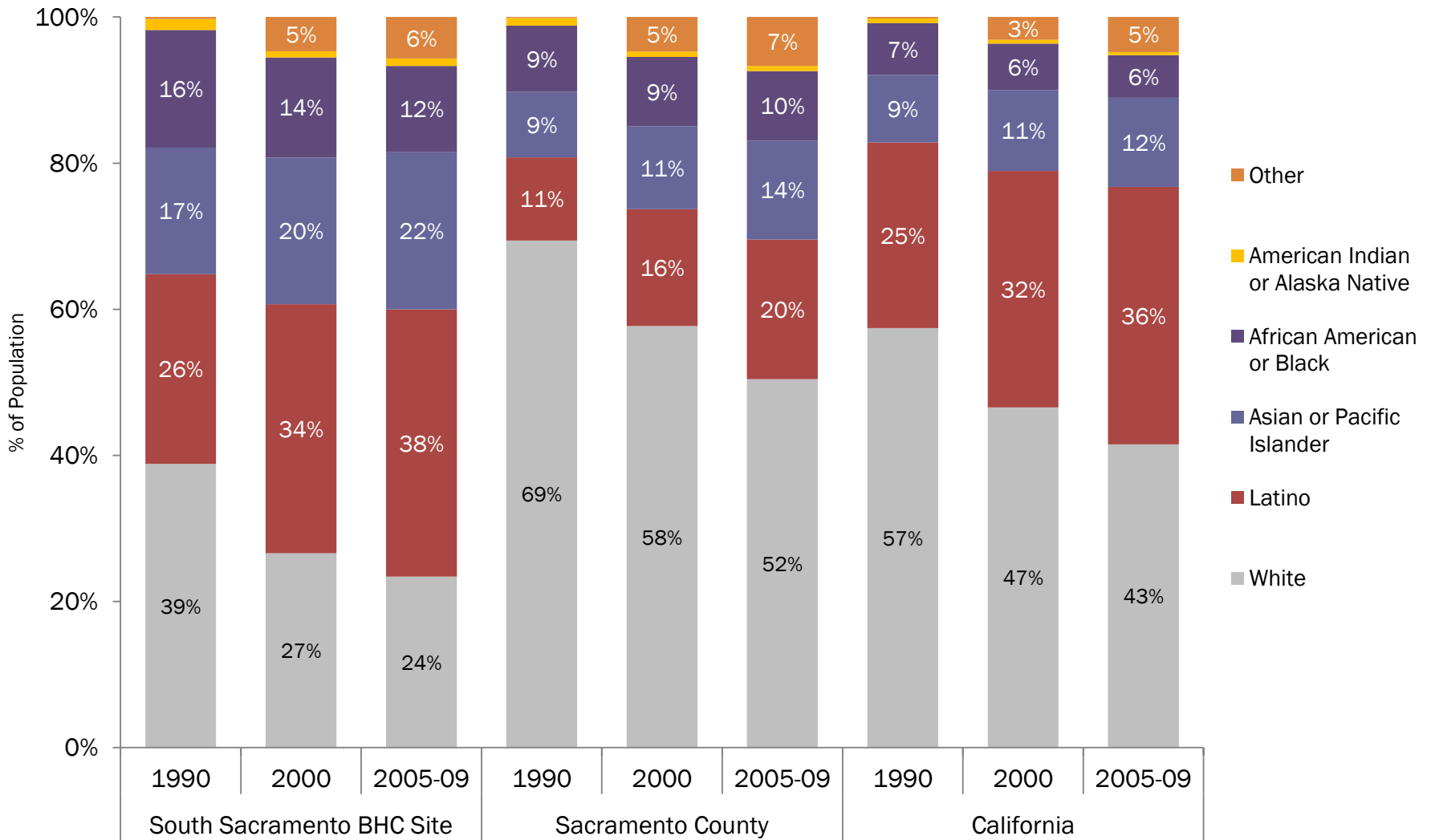

SOUTH SACRAMENTO BHC SITE BOUNDARIES



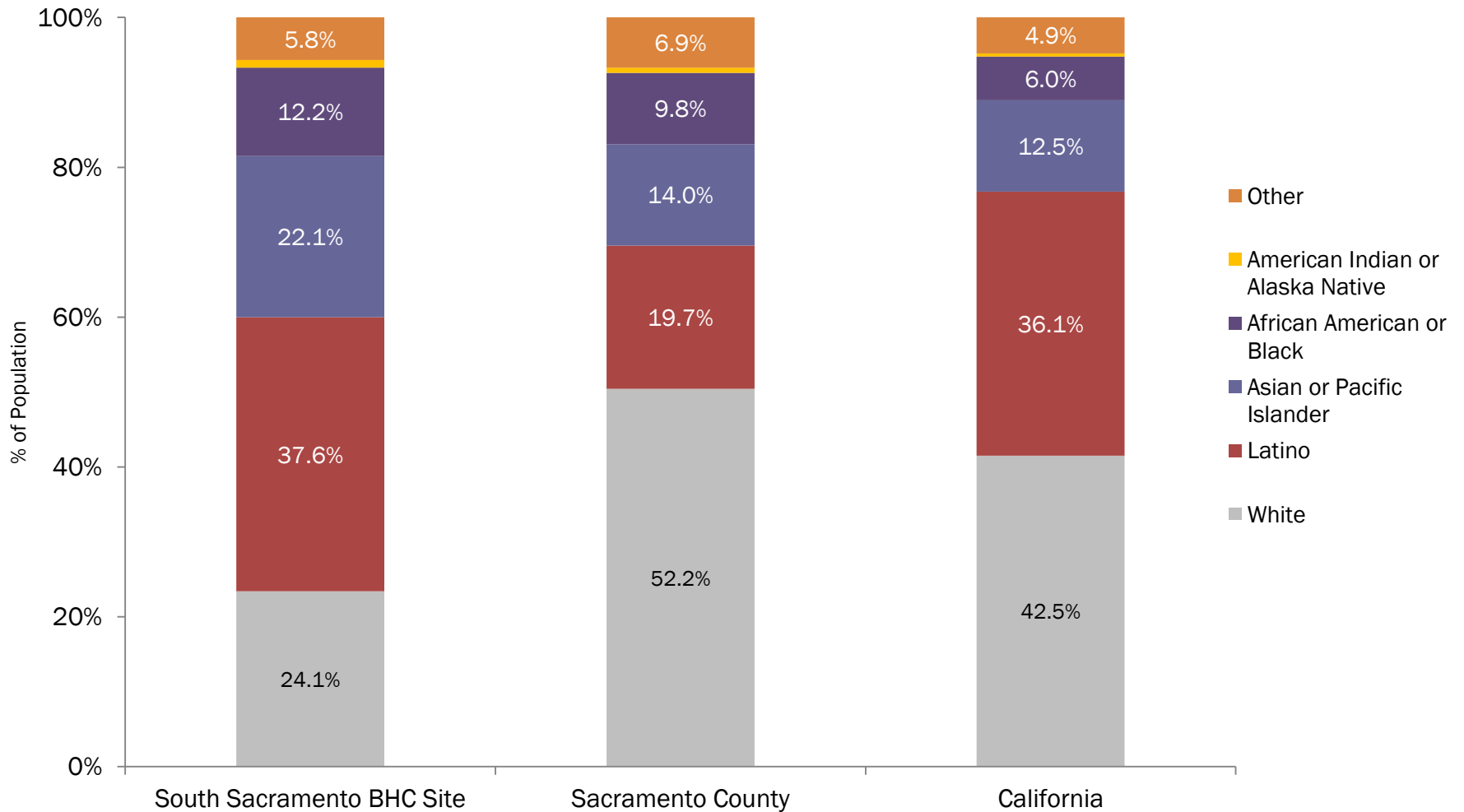

Population by Race/Ethnicity 1990 to 2005-2009



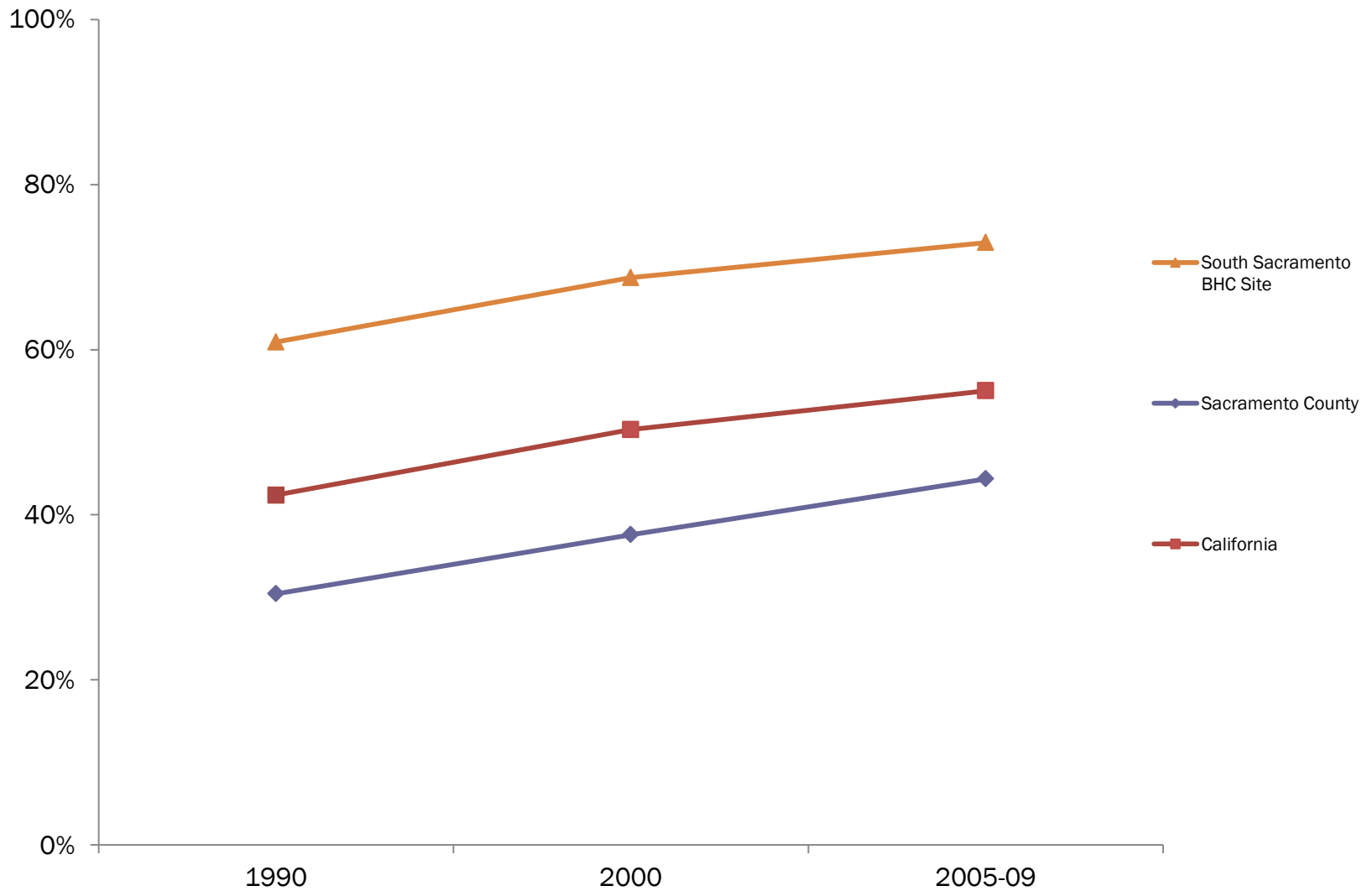

Population by Race/Ethnicity 2005-2009



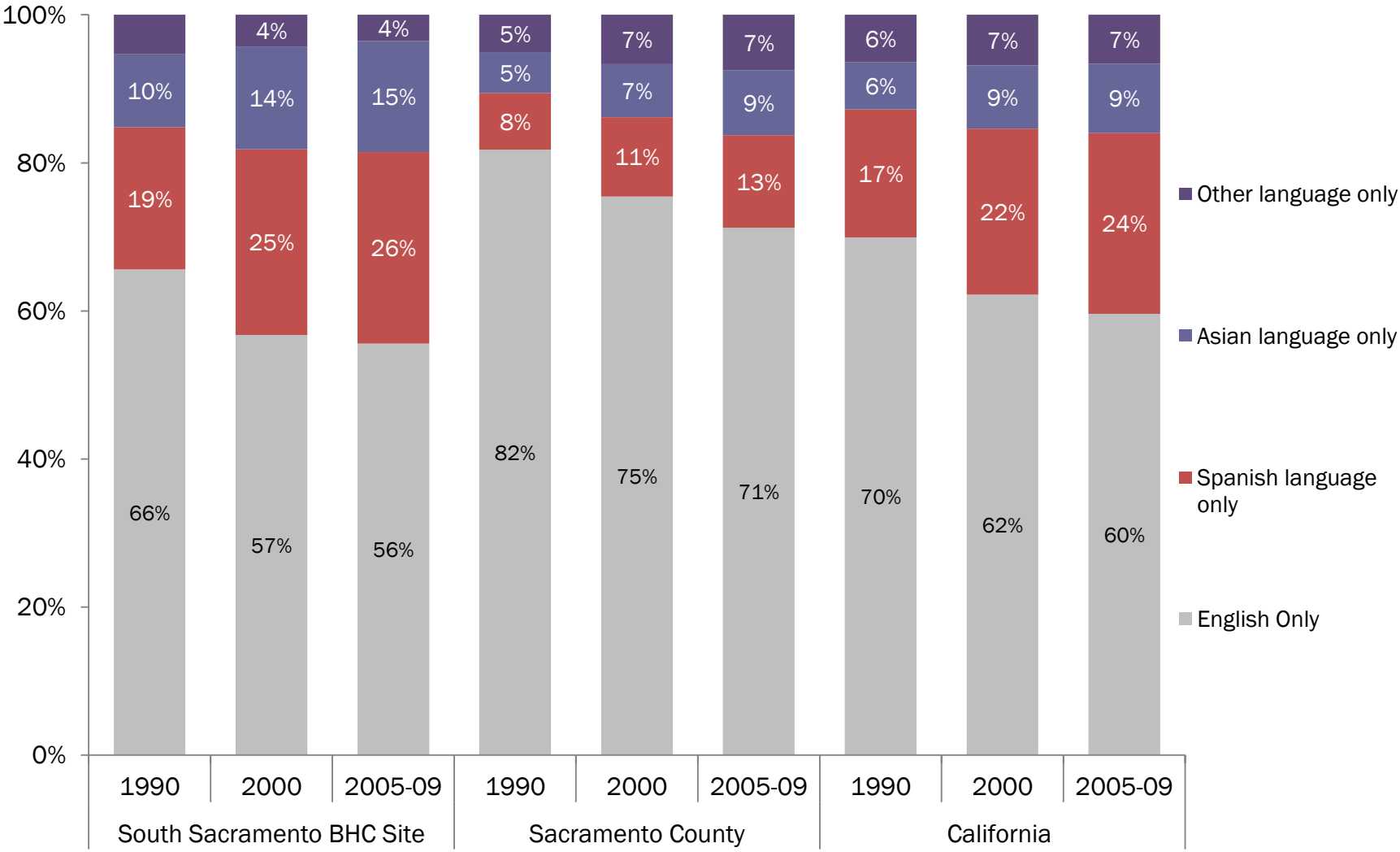

Proportion of People of Color 1990 to 2005-2009



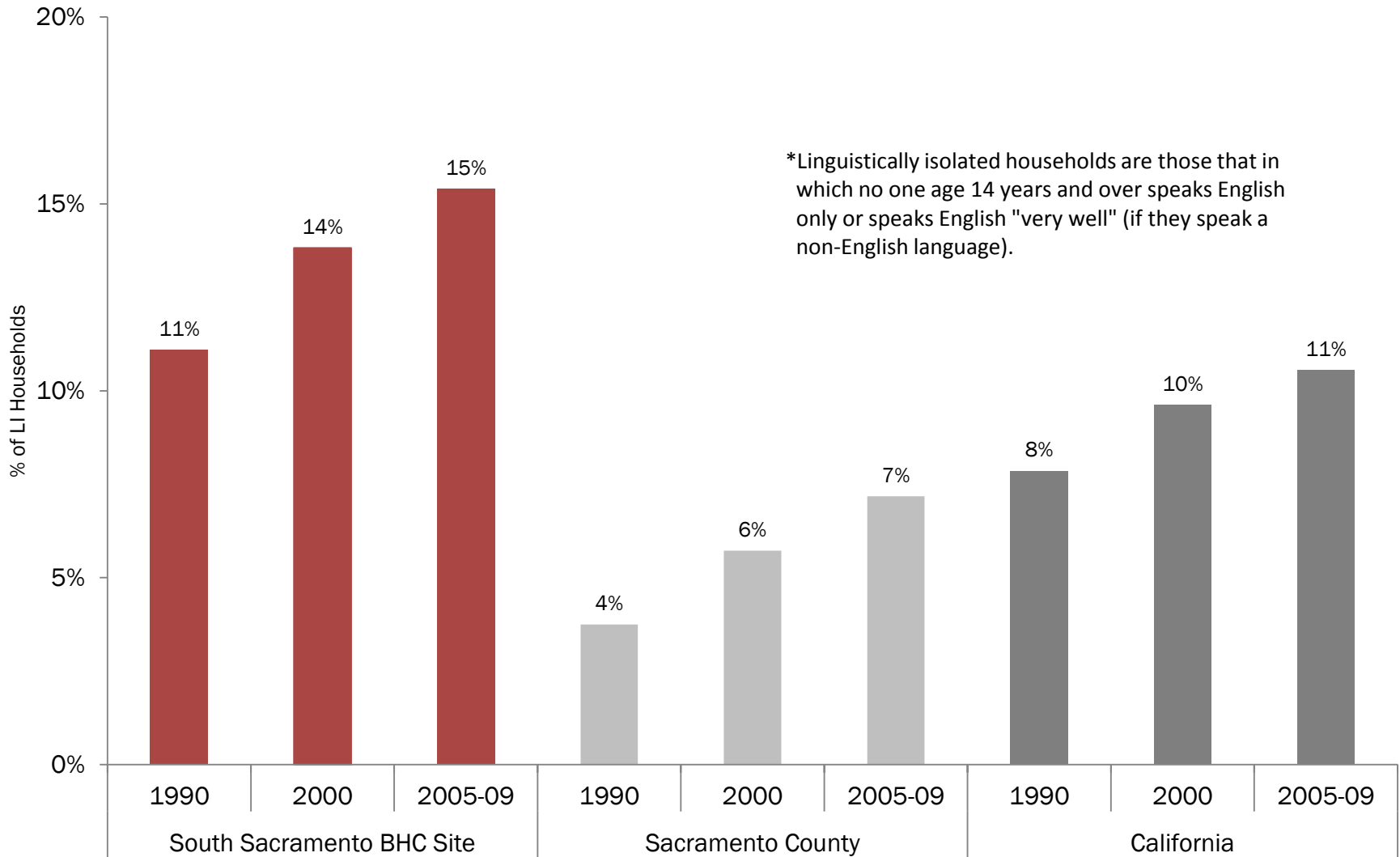

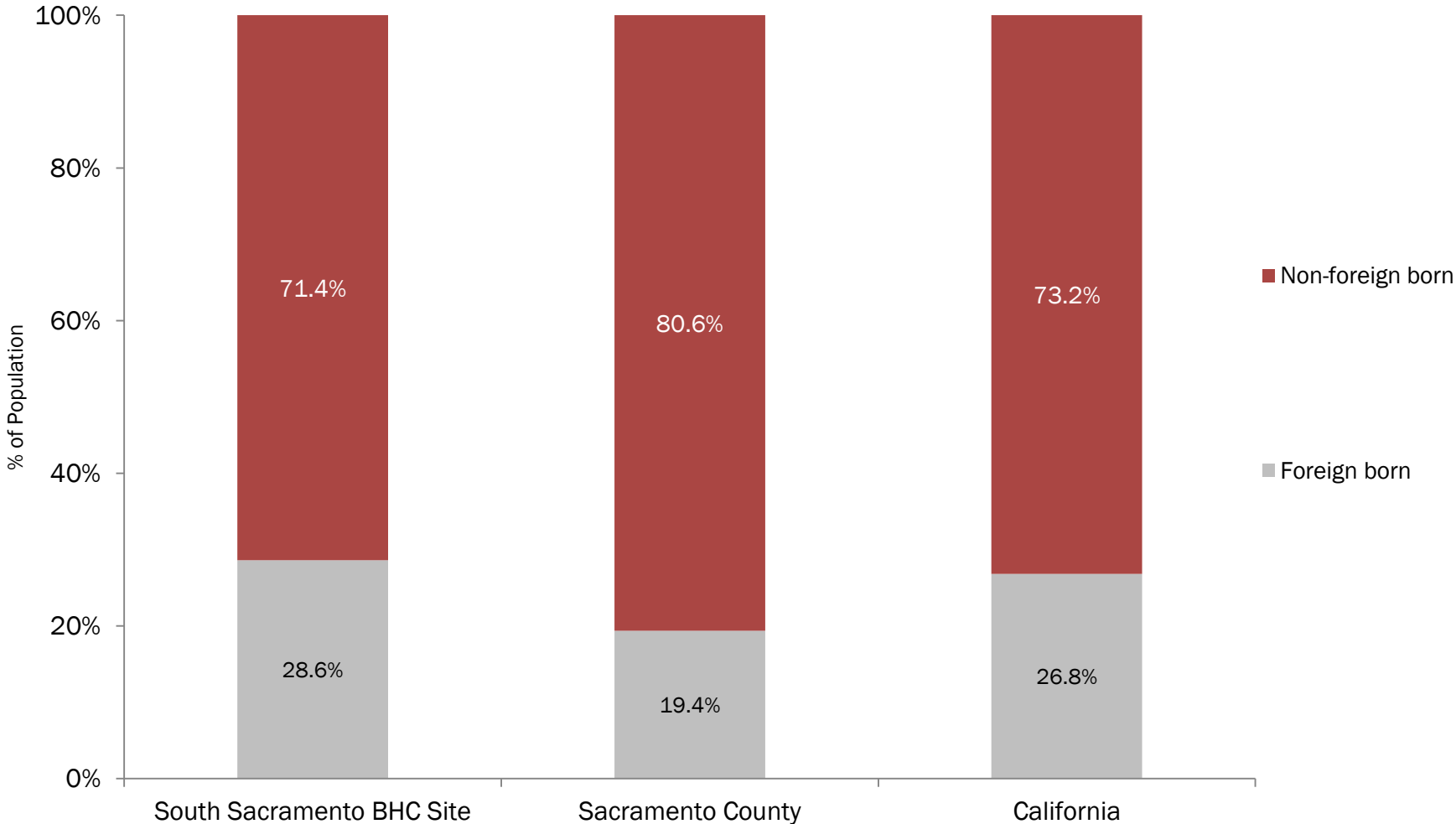
Percent of Households that are Linguistically Isolated 1990 to 2005-2009

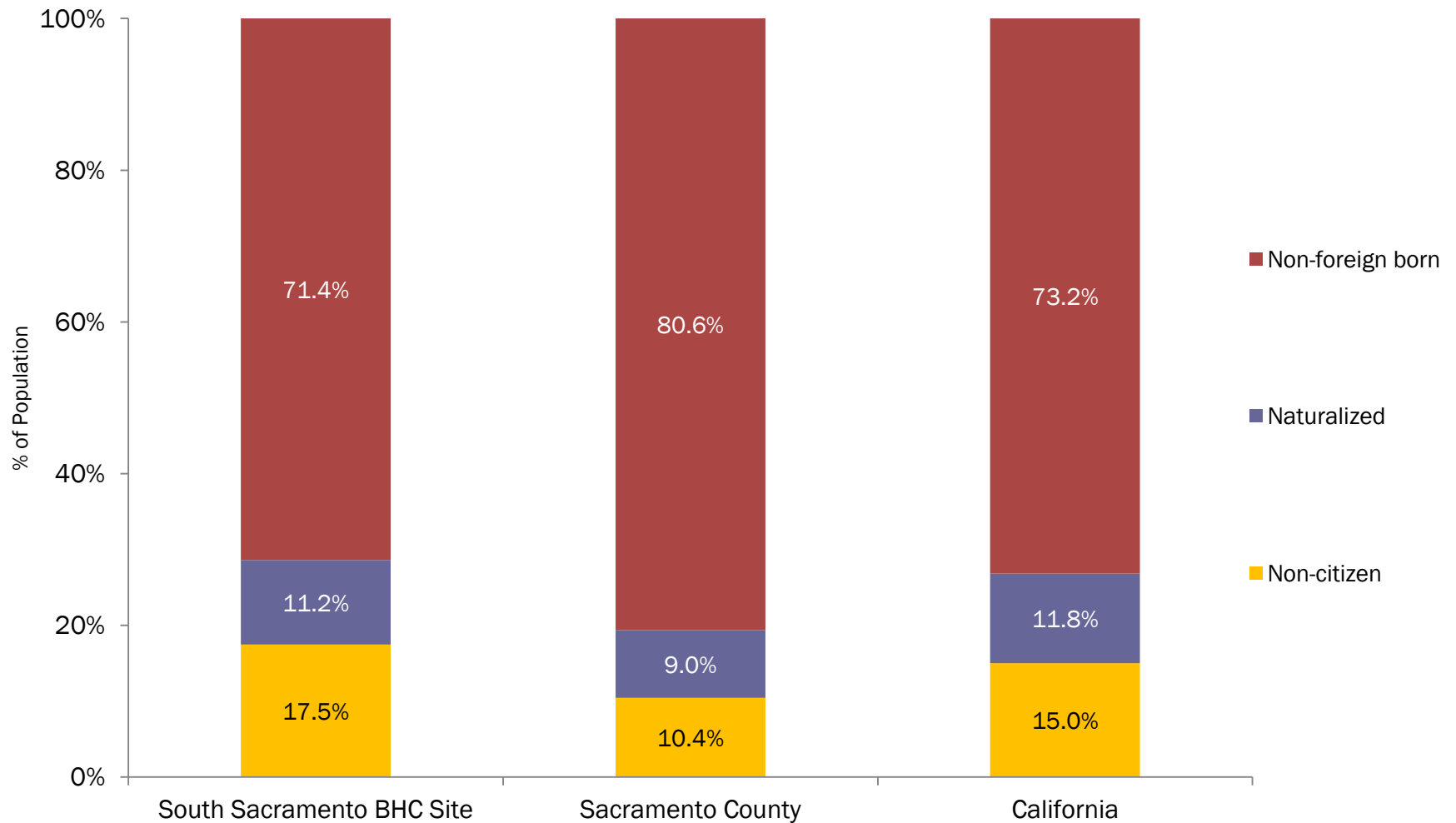

Population by Immigration Status 2005-2009



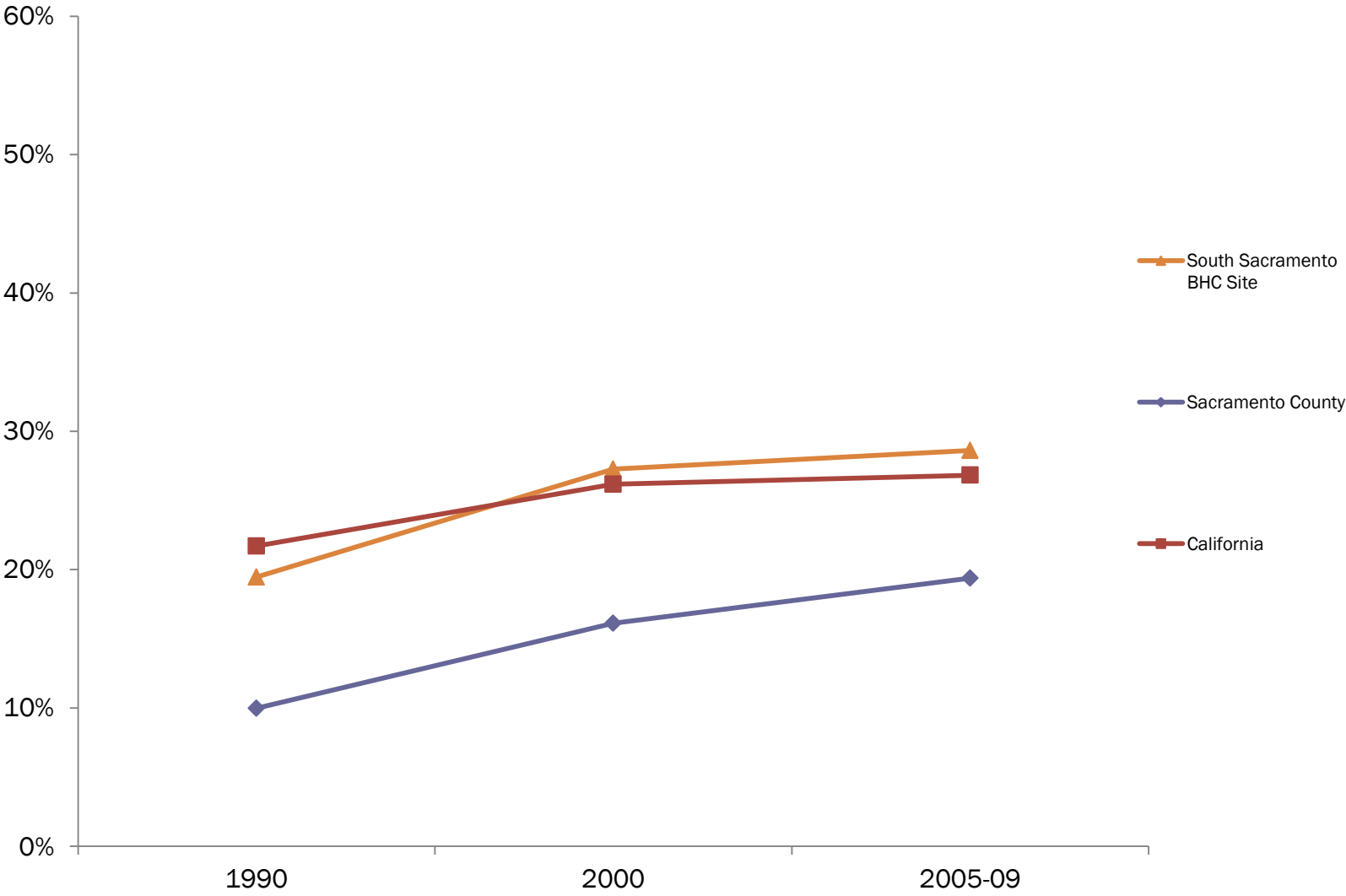

Population by Non-Foreign Born and Citizenship of Foreign Born 2005-2009



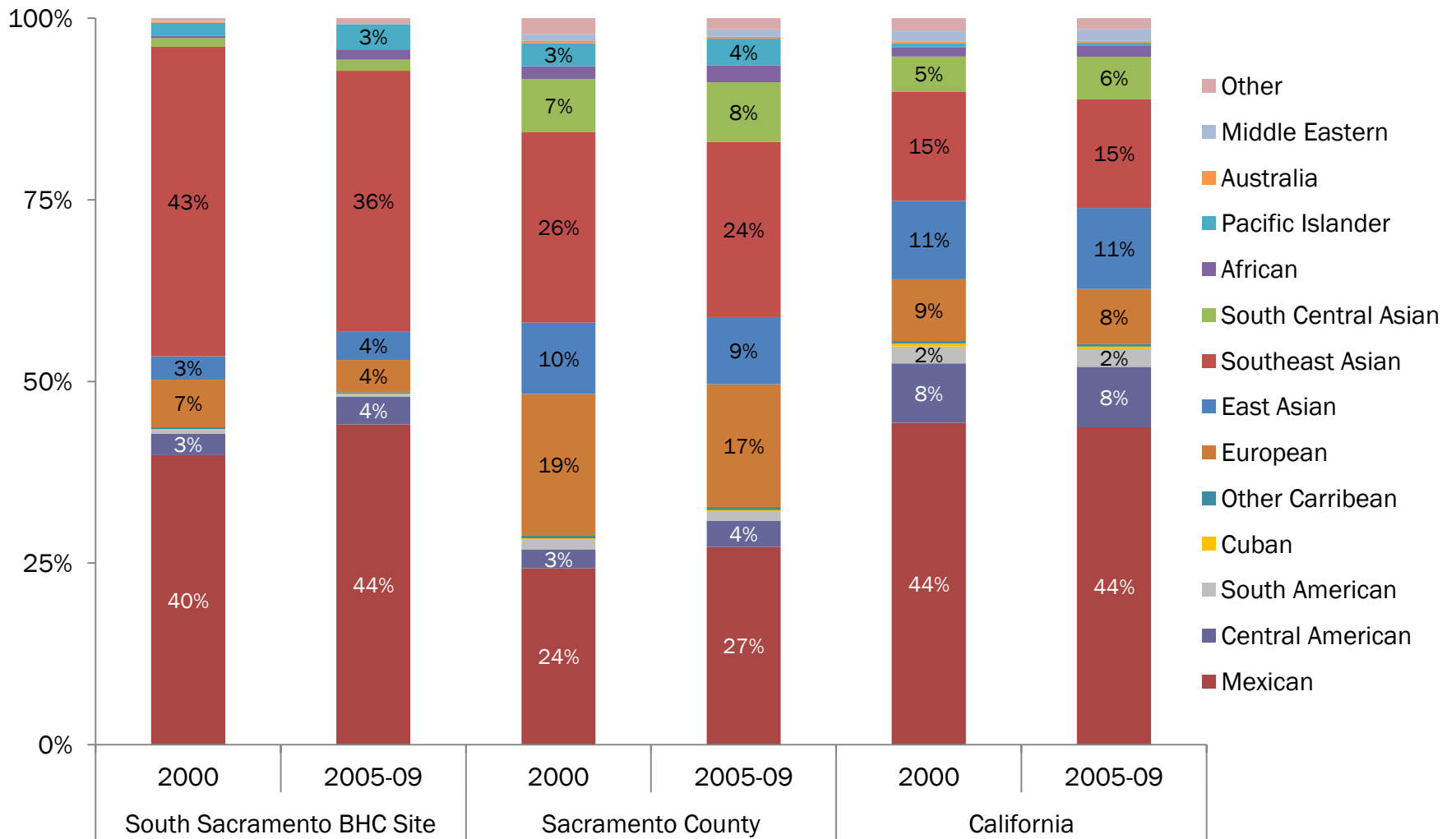

Proportion of Immigrants 1990 to 2005-2009



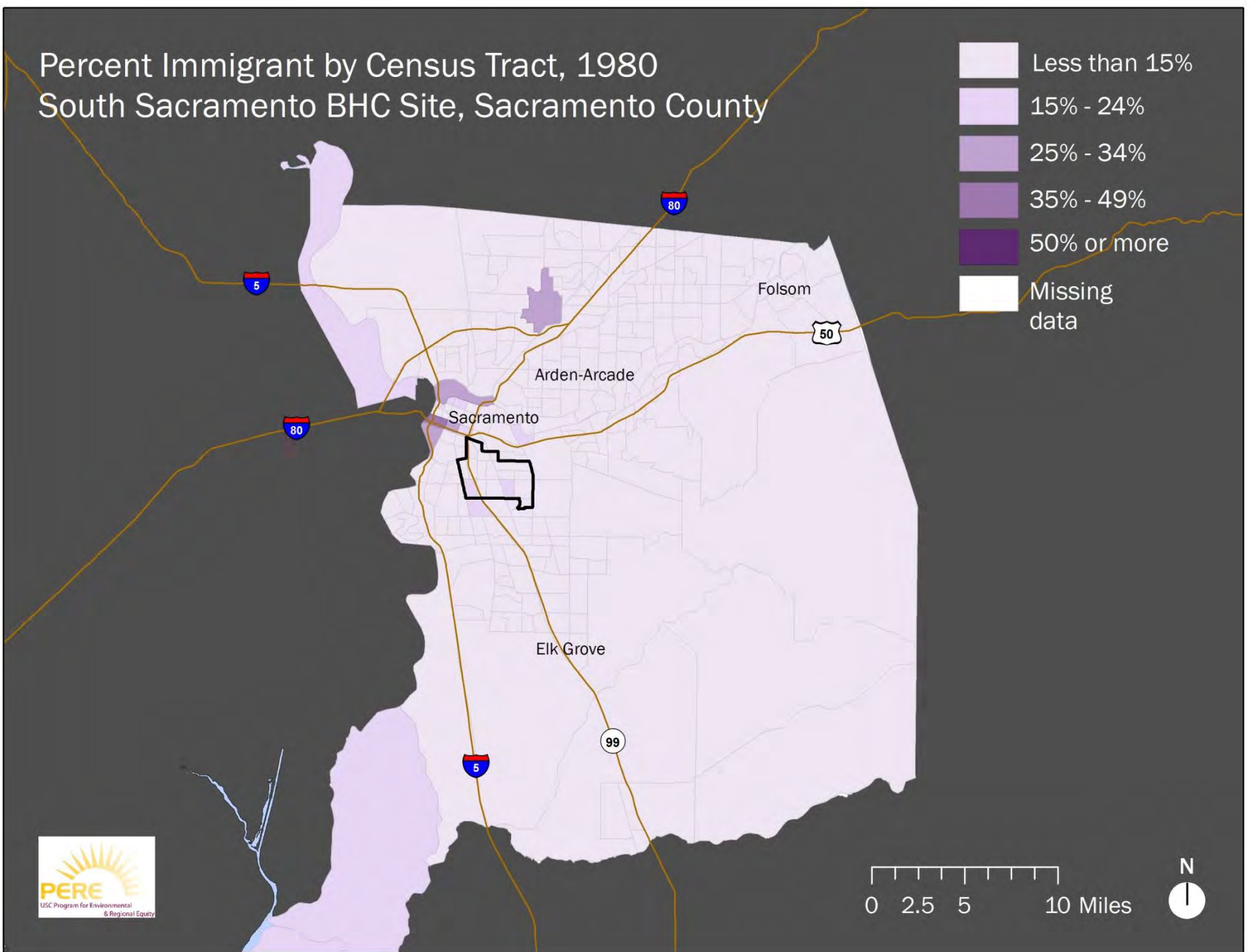
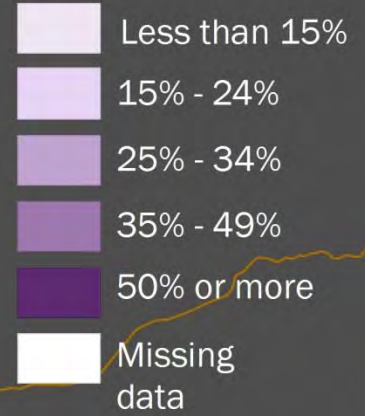

Country/Region of Origin for Immigrants 2000 & 2005-2009

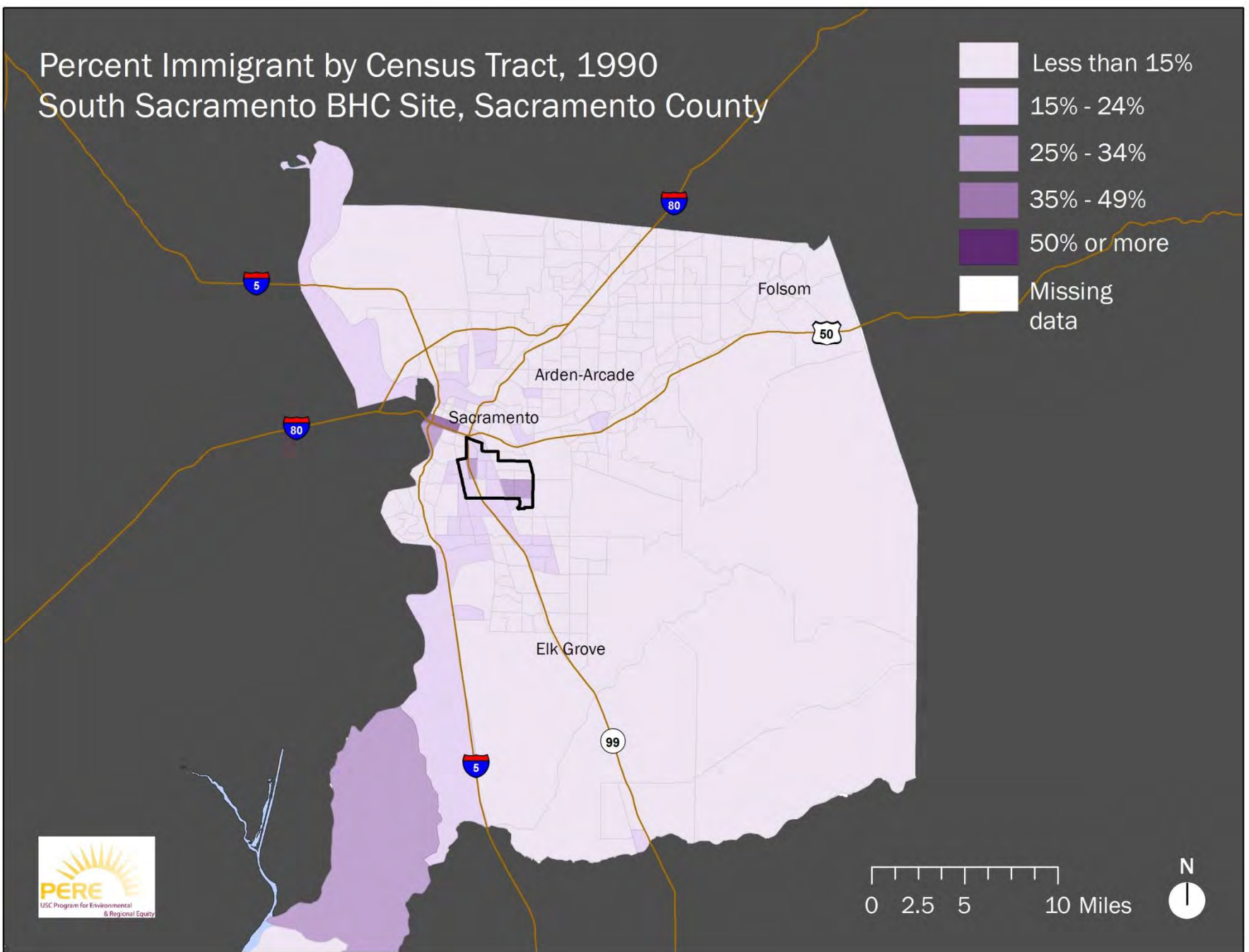
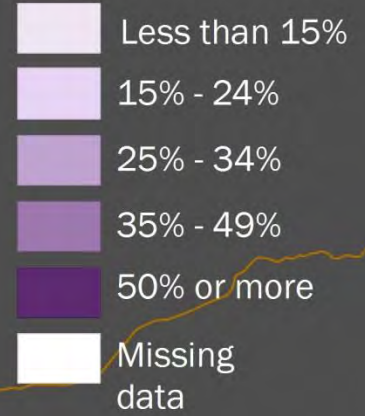

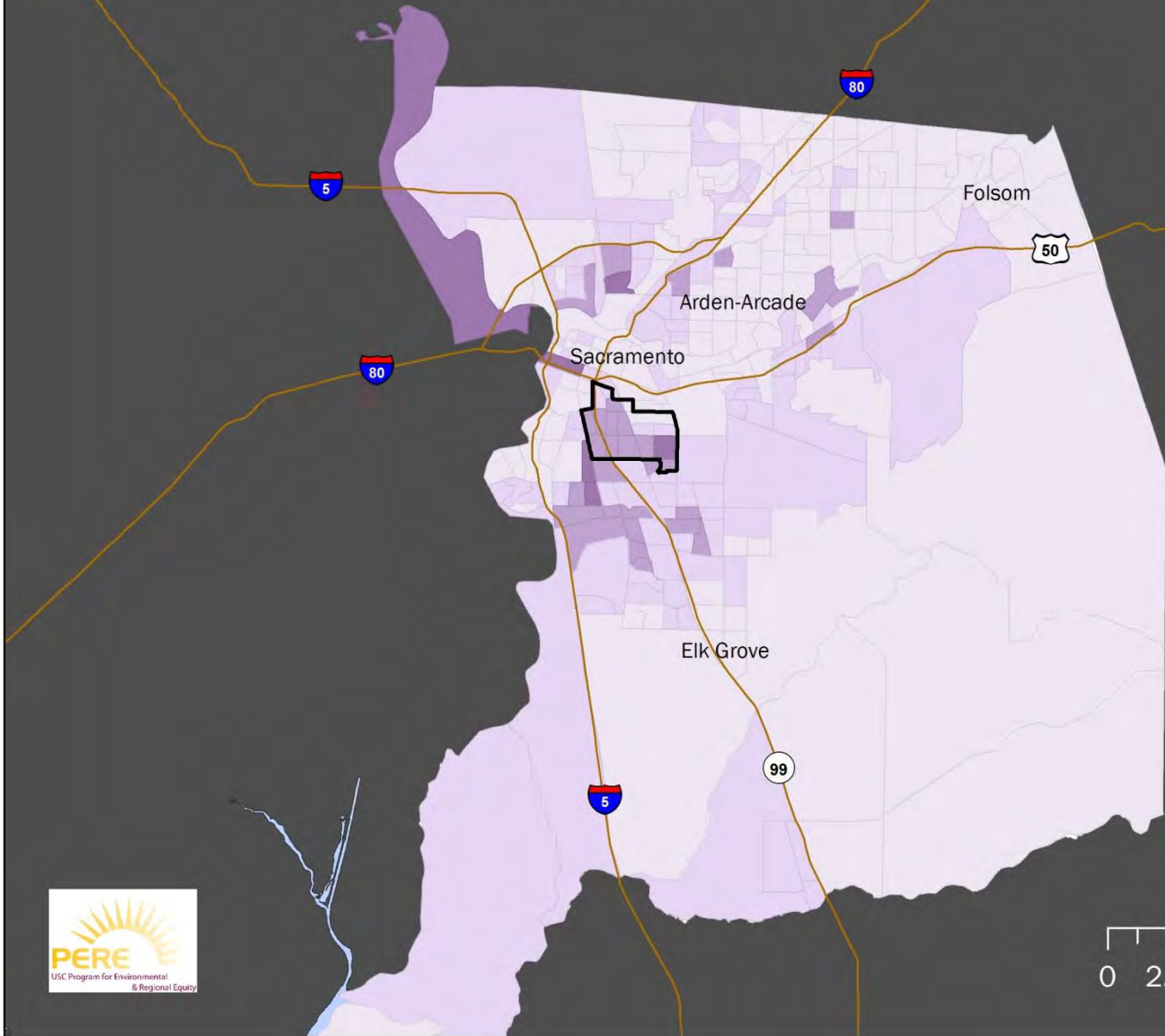
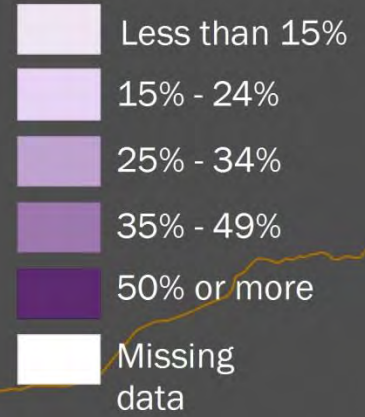
Percent Immigrant by Census Tract, 1980 South Sacramento BHC Site, Sacramento County



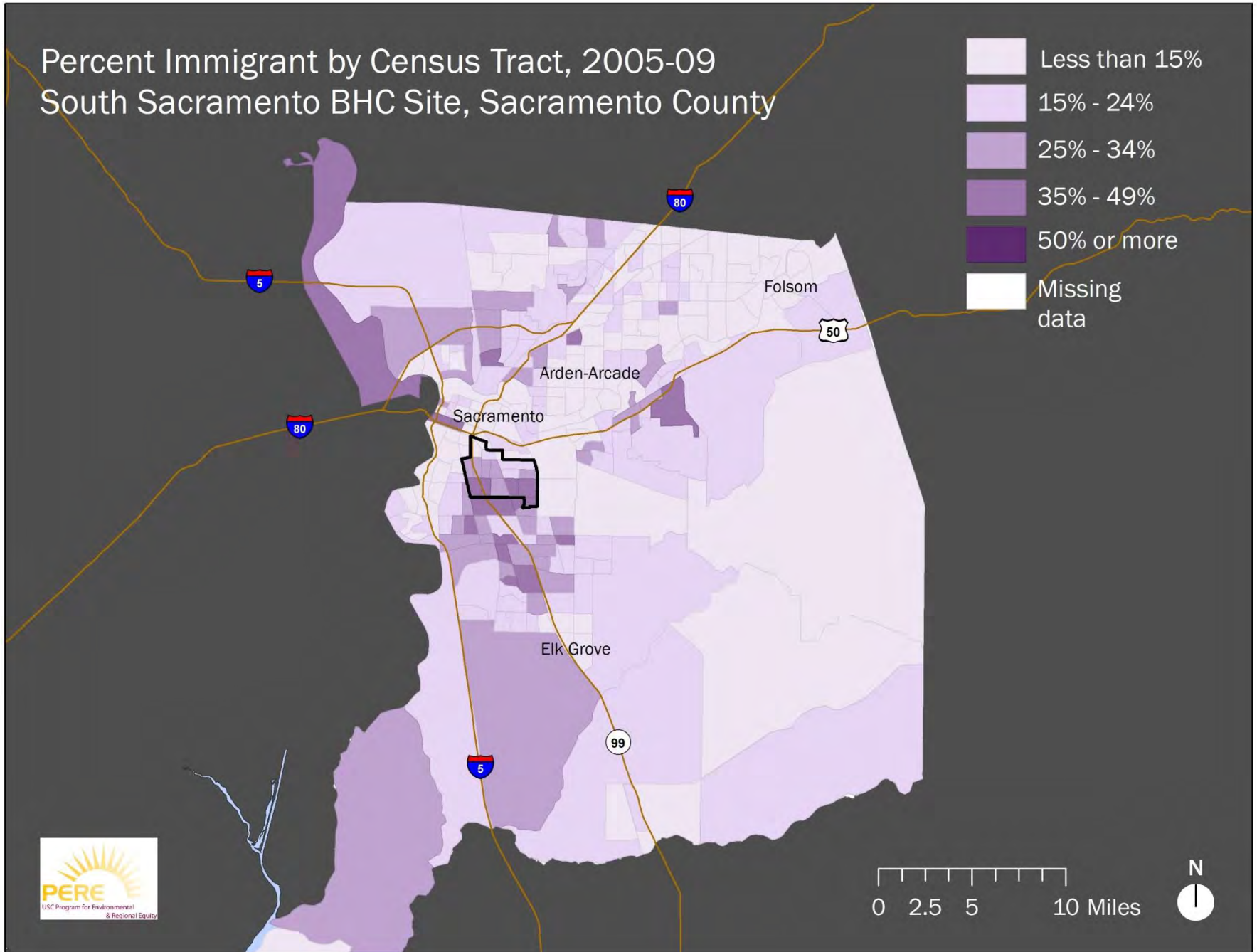
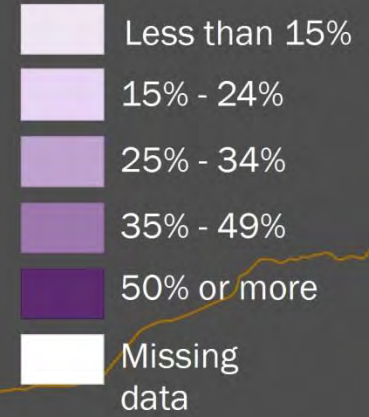
Percent Immigrant by Census Tract, 1990 South Sacramento BHC Site, Sacramento County



Percent Immigrant by Census Tract, 2000 South Sacramento BHC Site, Sacramento County

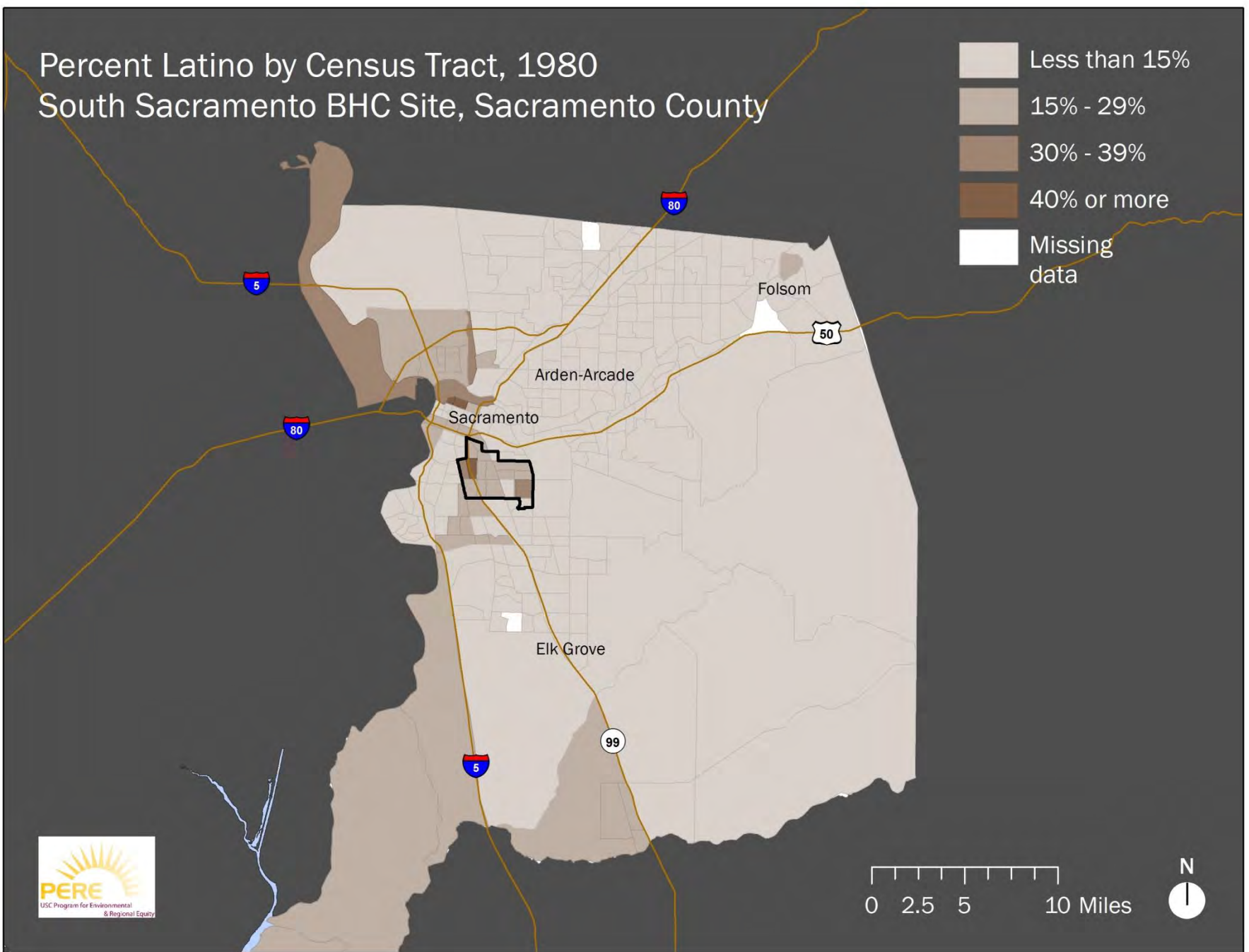
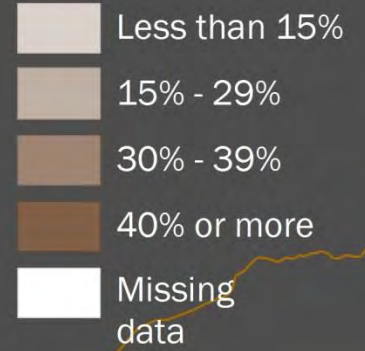


Percent Immigrant by Census Tract, 2005-09 South Sacramento BHC Site, Sacramento County

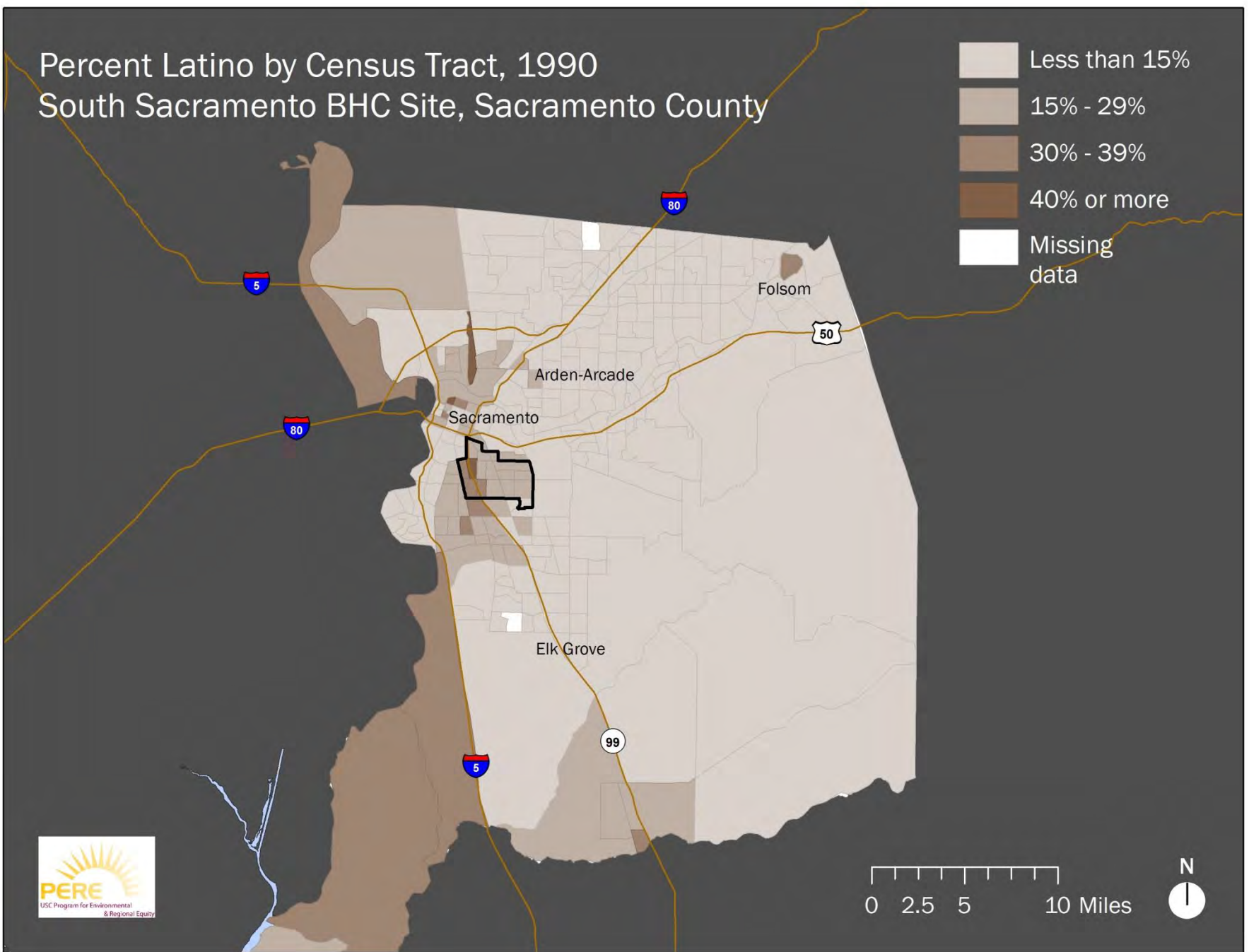
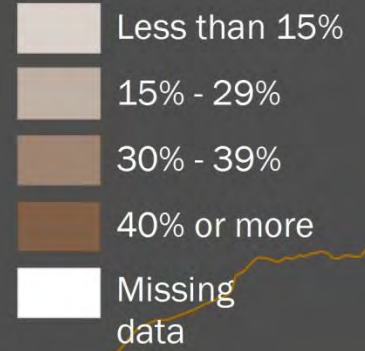

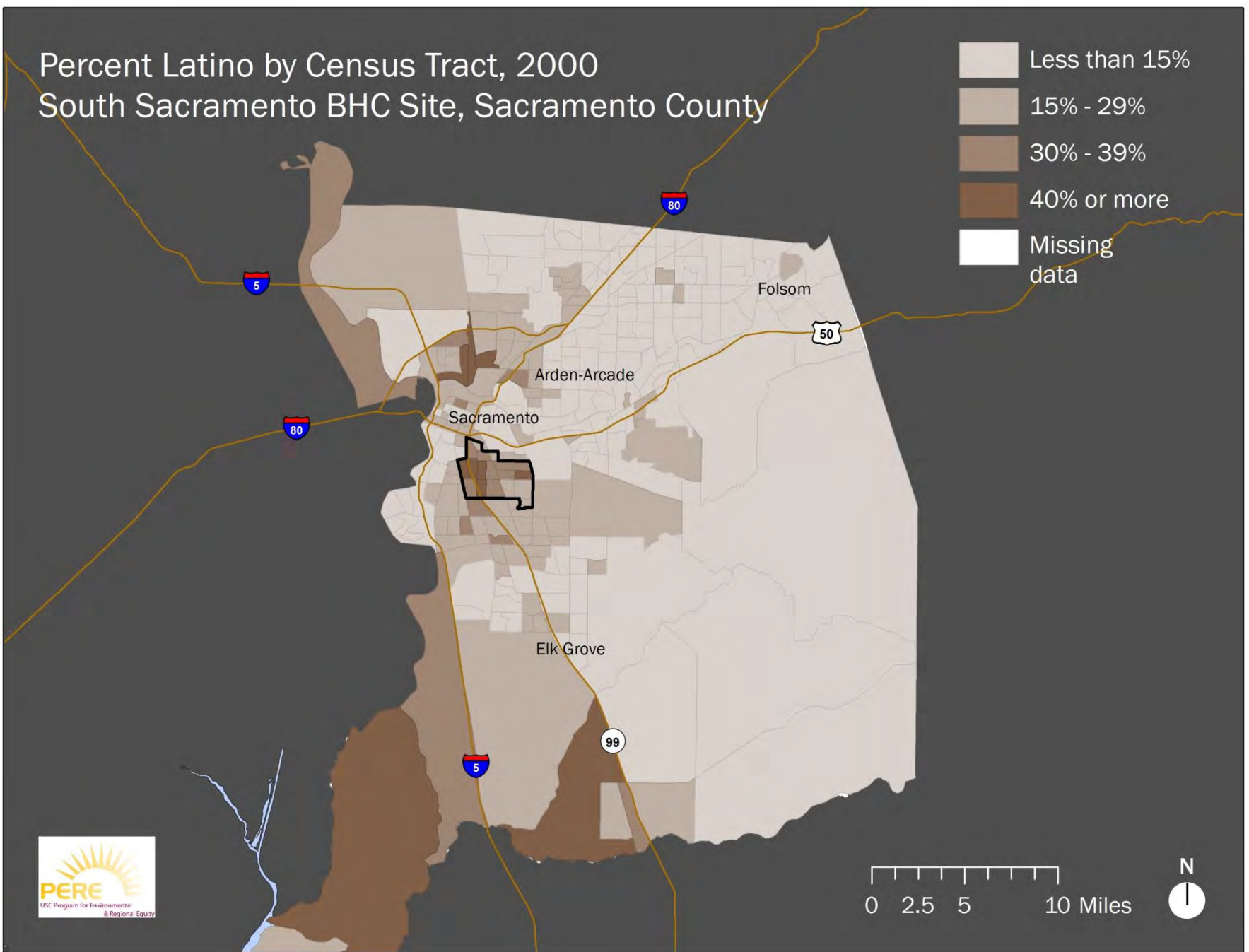
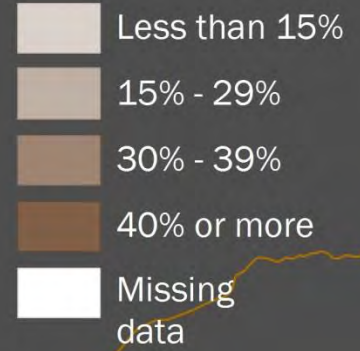
Percent Latino by Census Tract, 1980 South Sacramento BHC Site, Sacramento County



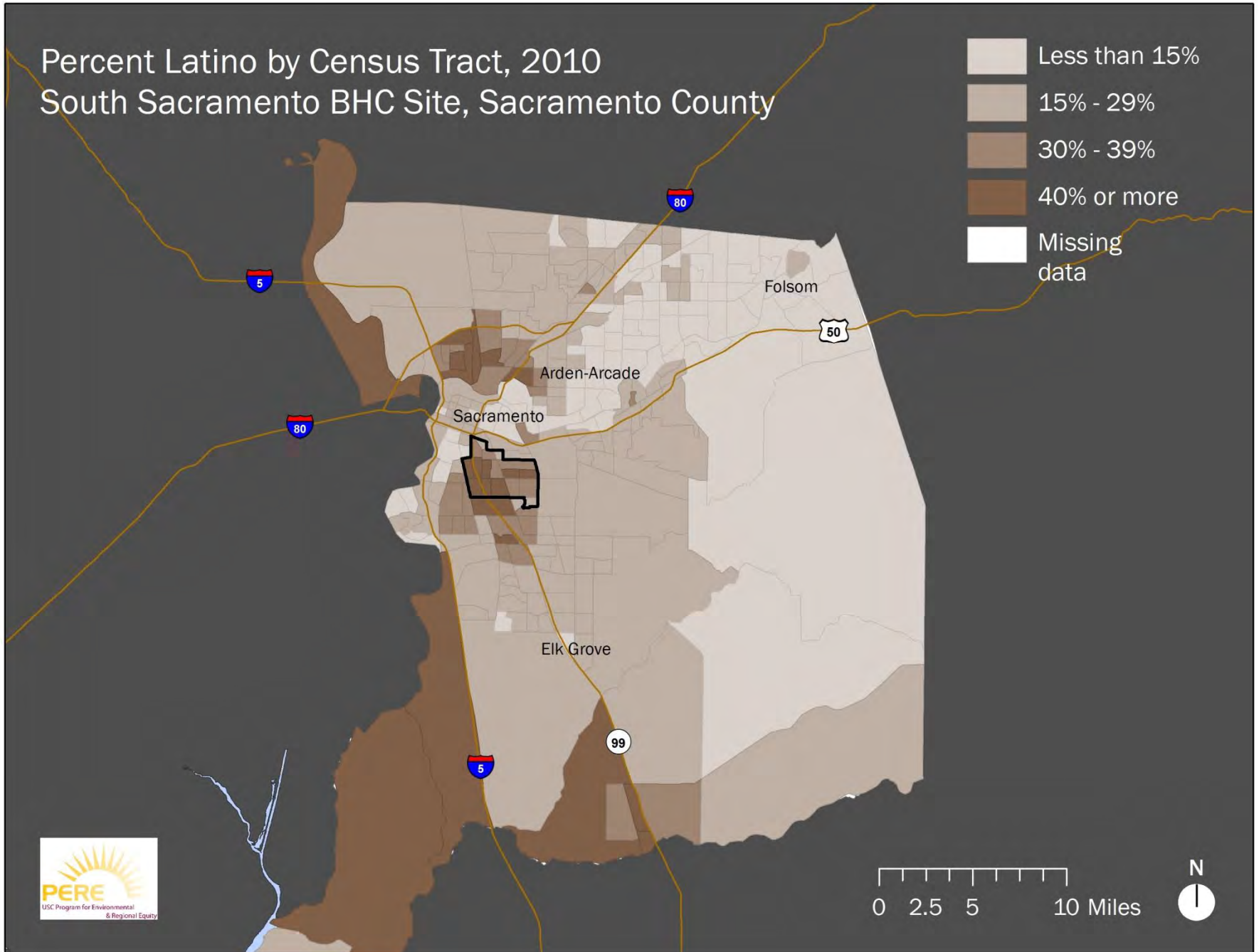
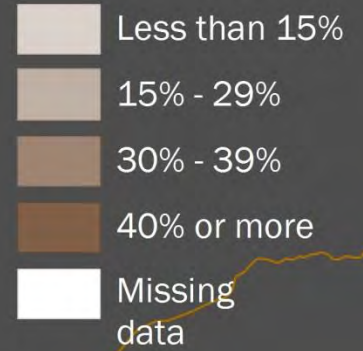
Percent Latino by Census Tract, 1990 South Sacramento BHC Site, Sacramento County



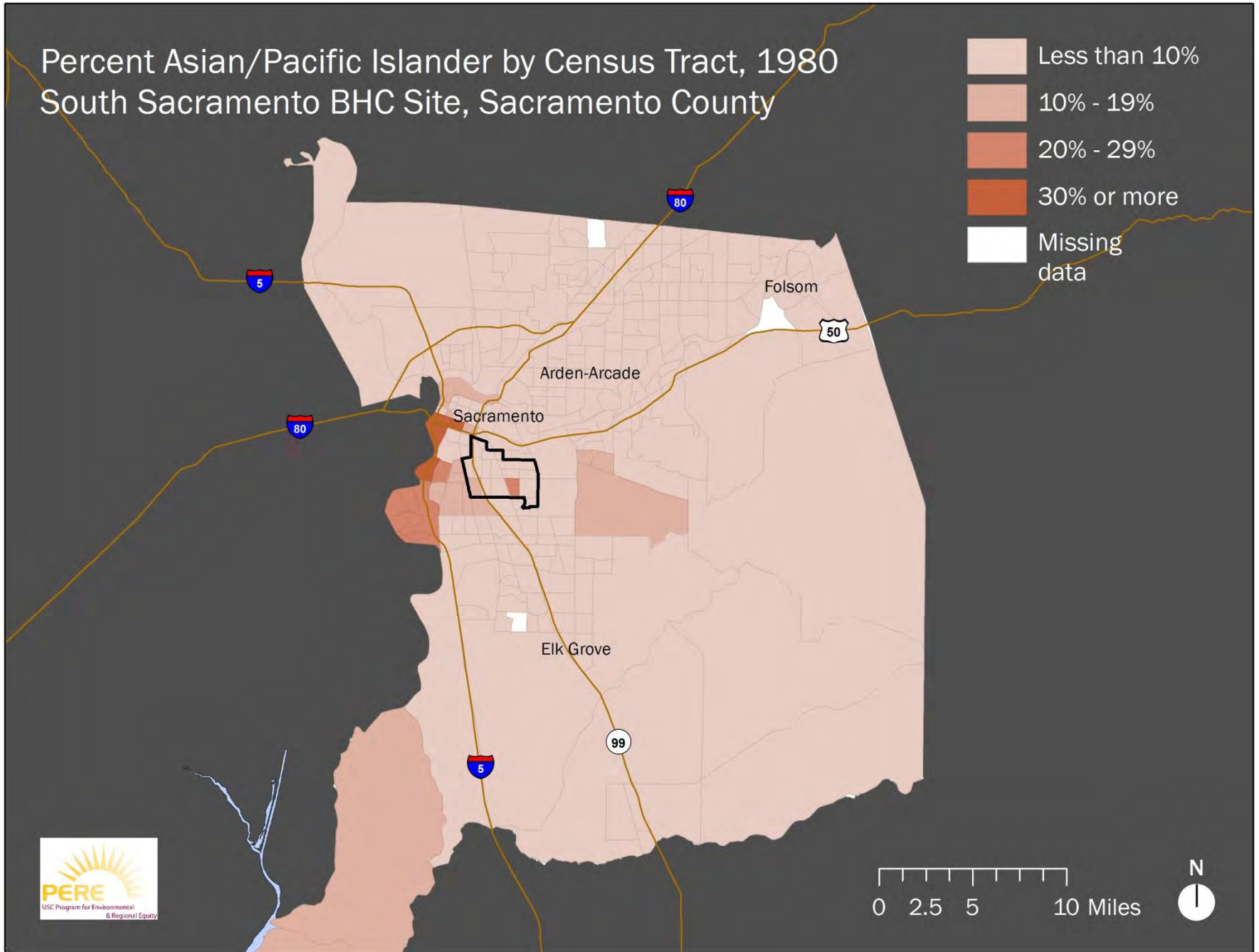
Percent Latino by Census Tract, 2000 South Sacramento BHC Site, Sacramento County



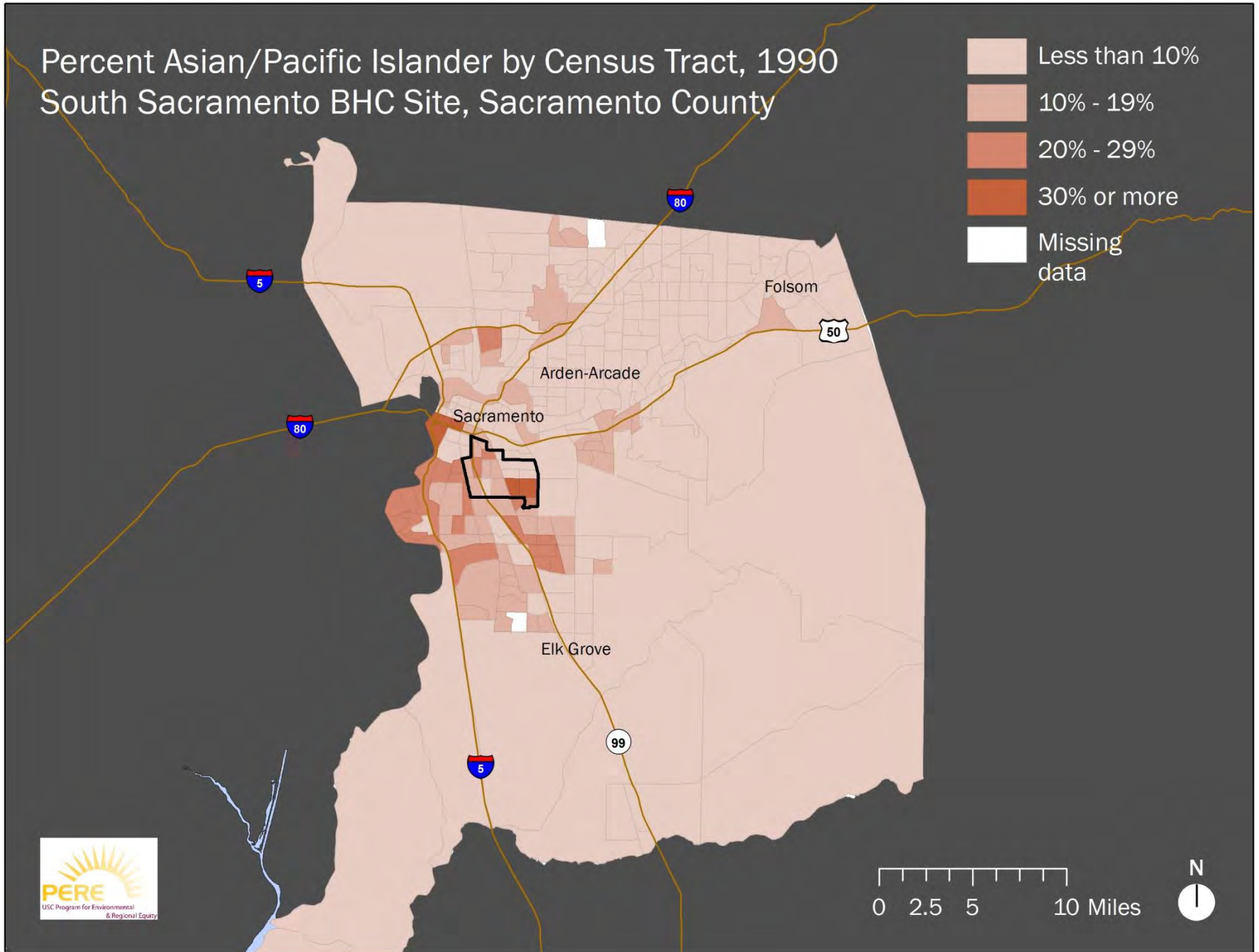
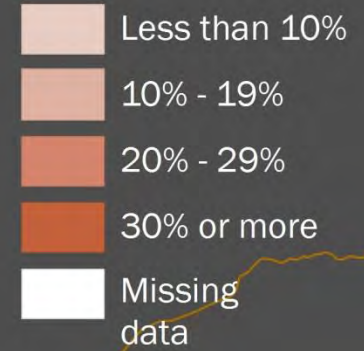

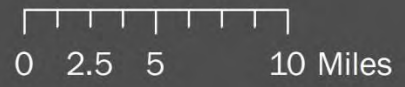
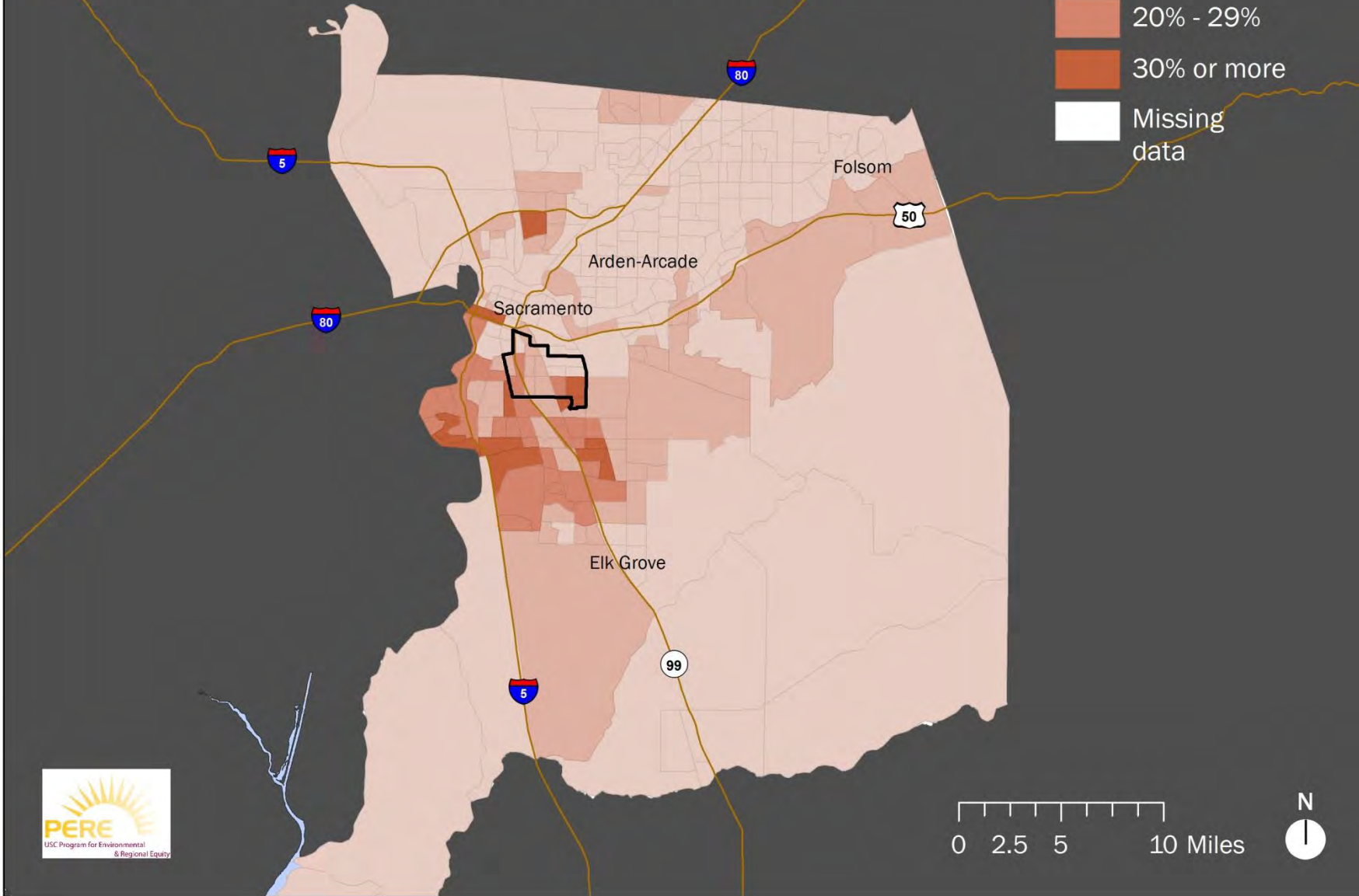
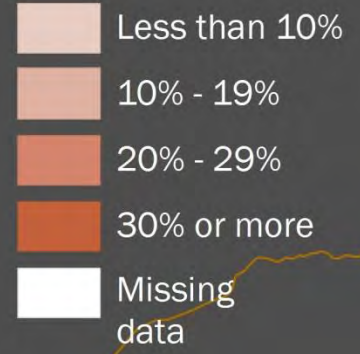
Percent Asian/Pacific Islander by Census Tract, 1980 South Sacramento BHC Site, Sacramento County



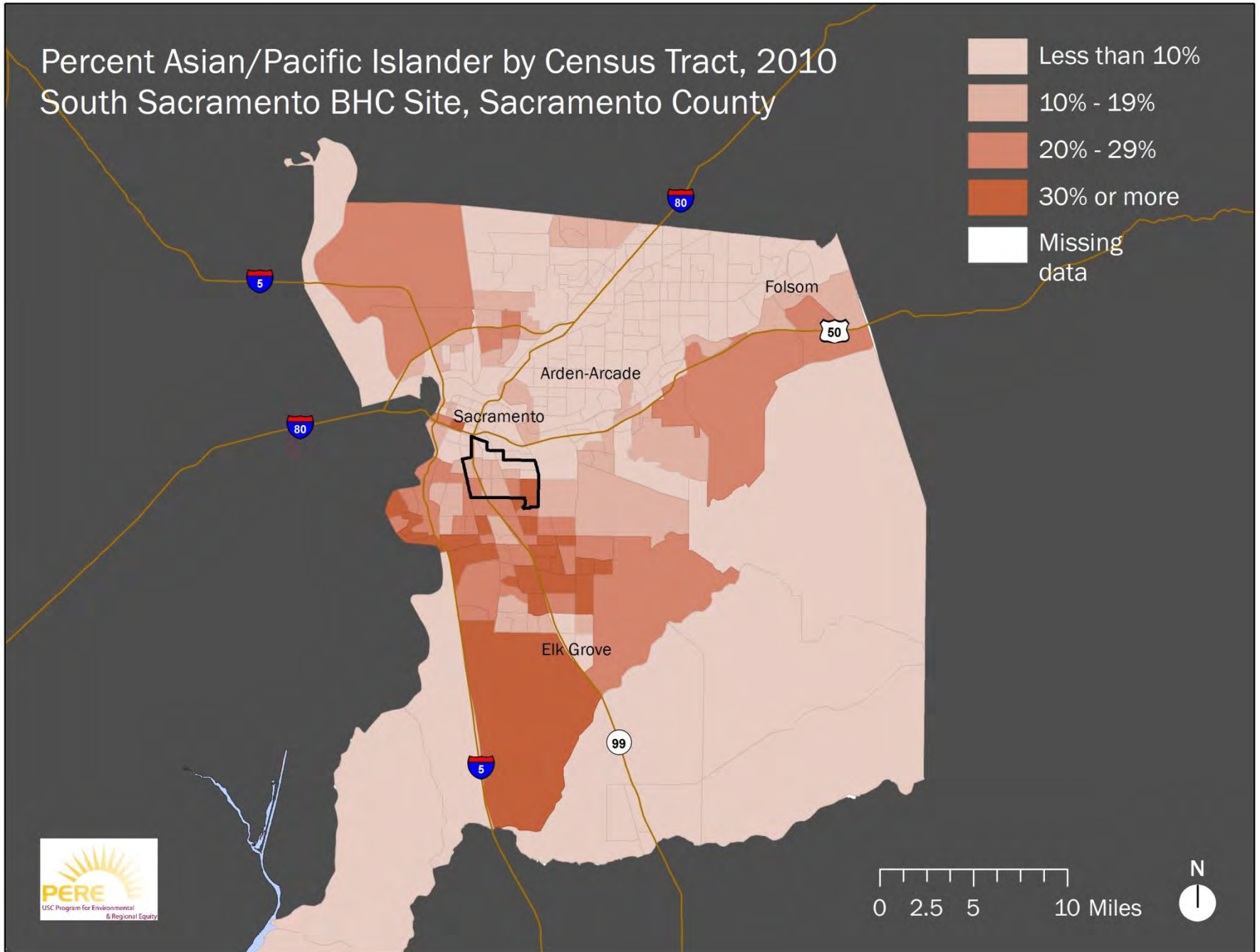
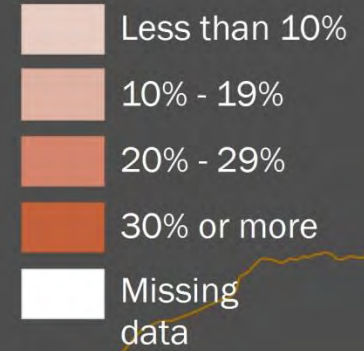
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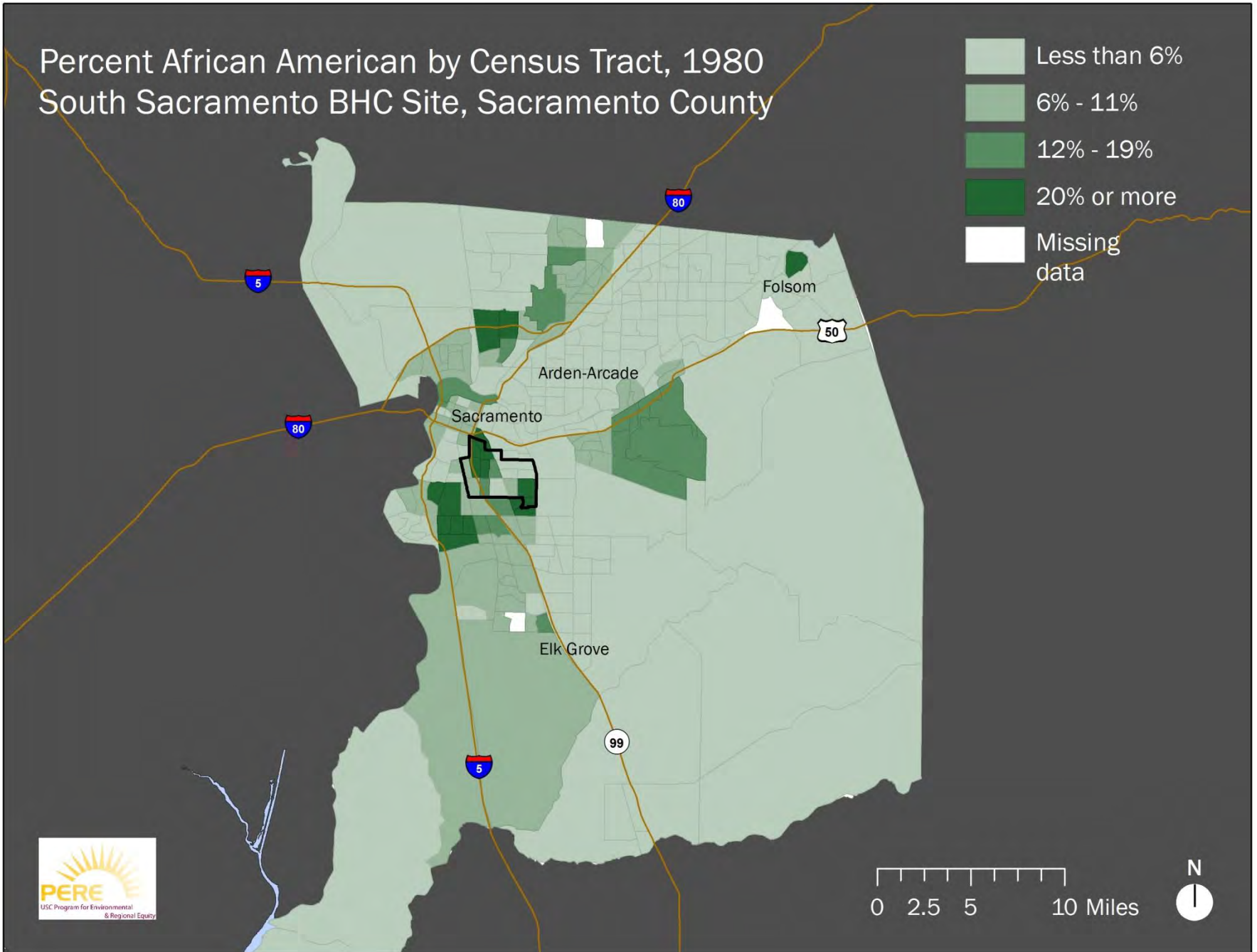
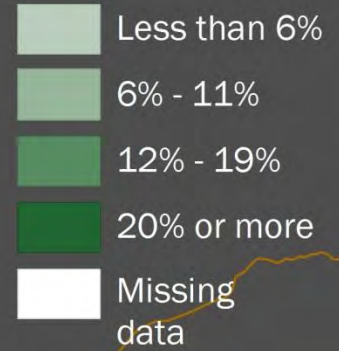
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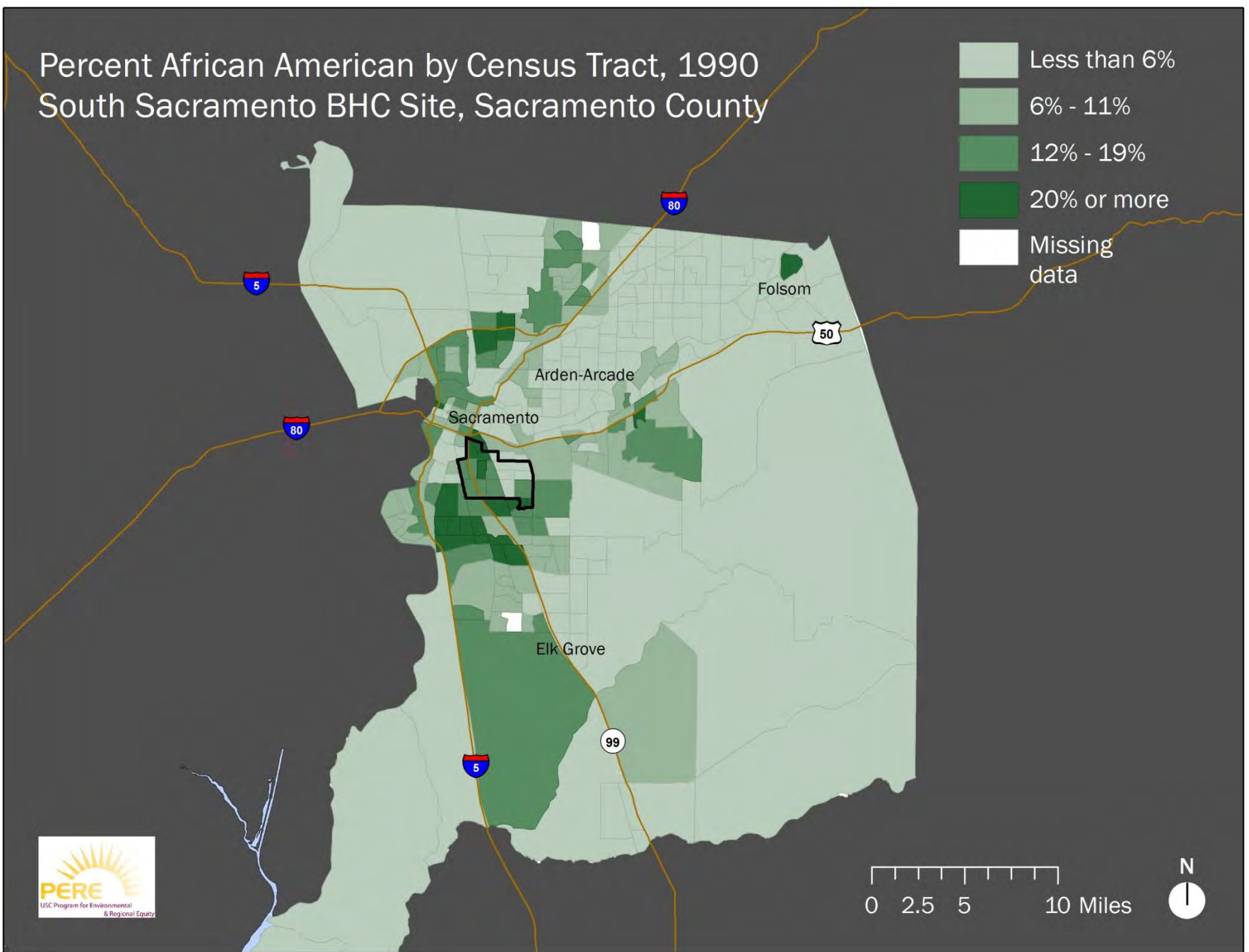
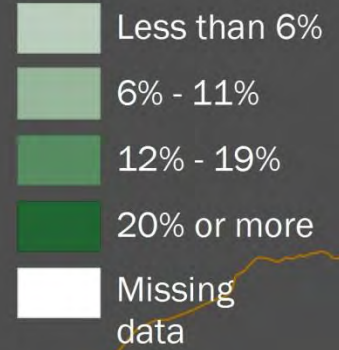
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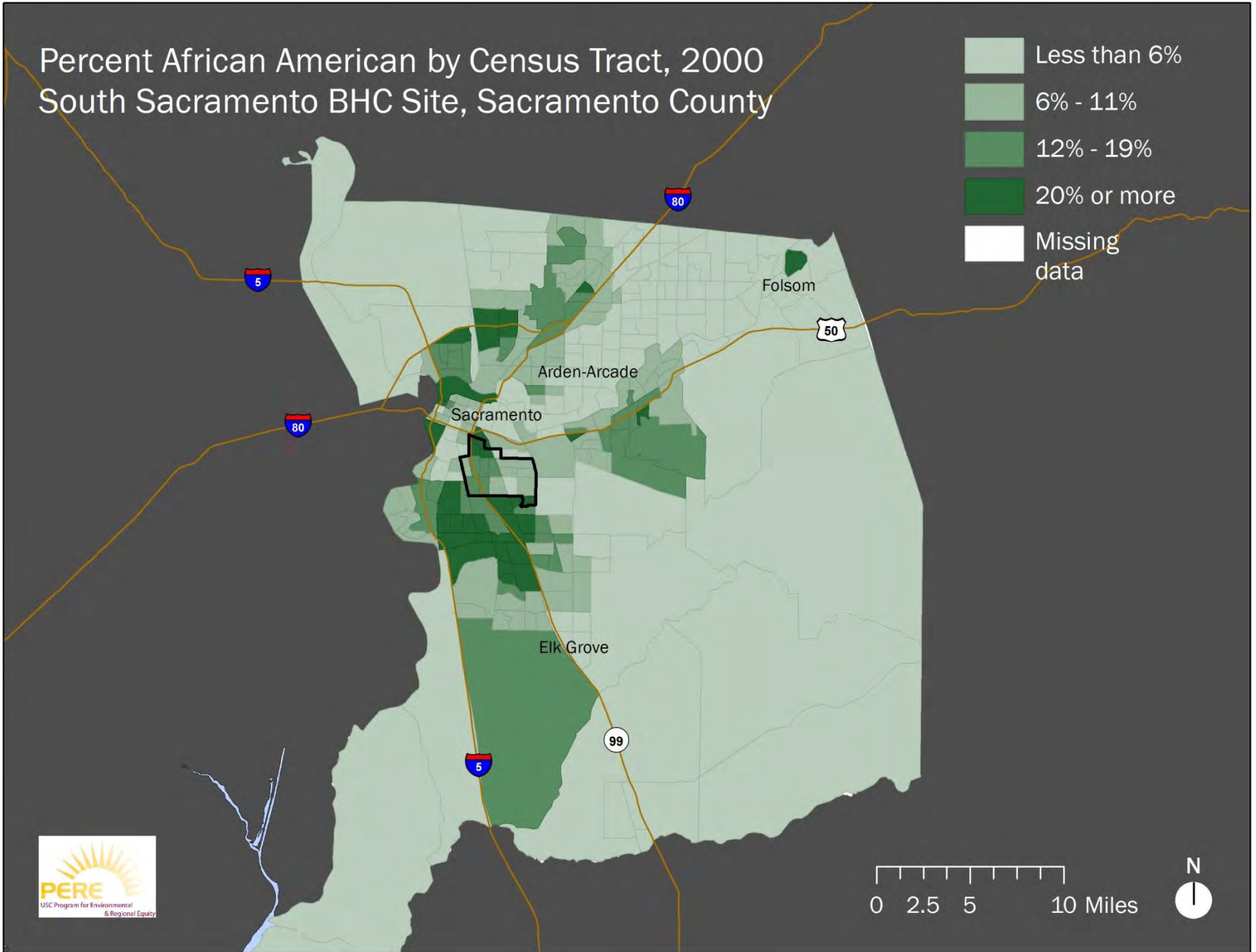
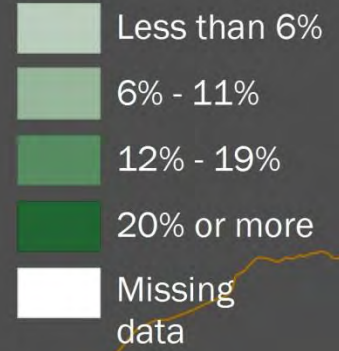
Percent African American by Census Tract, 1980 South Sacramento BHC Site, Sacramento County



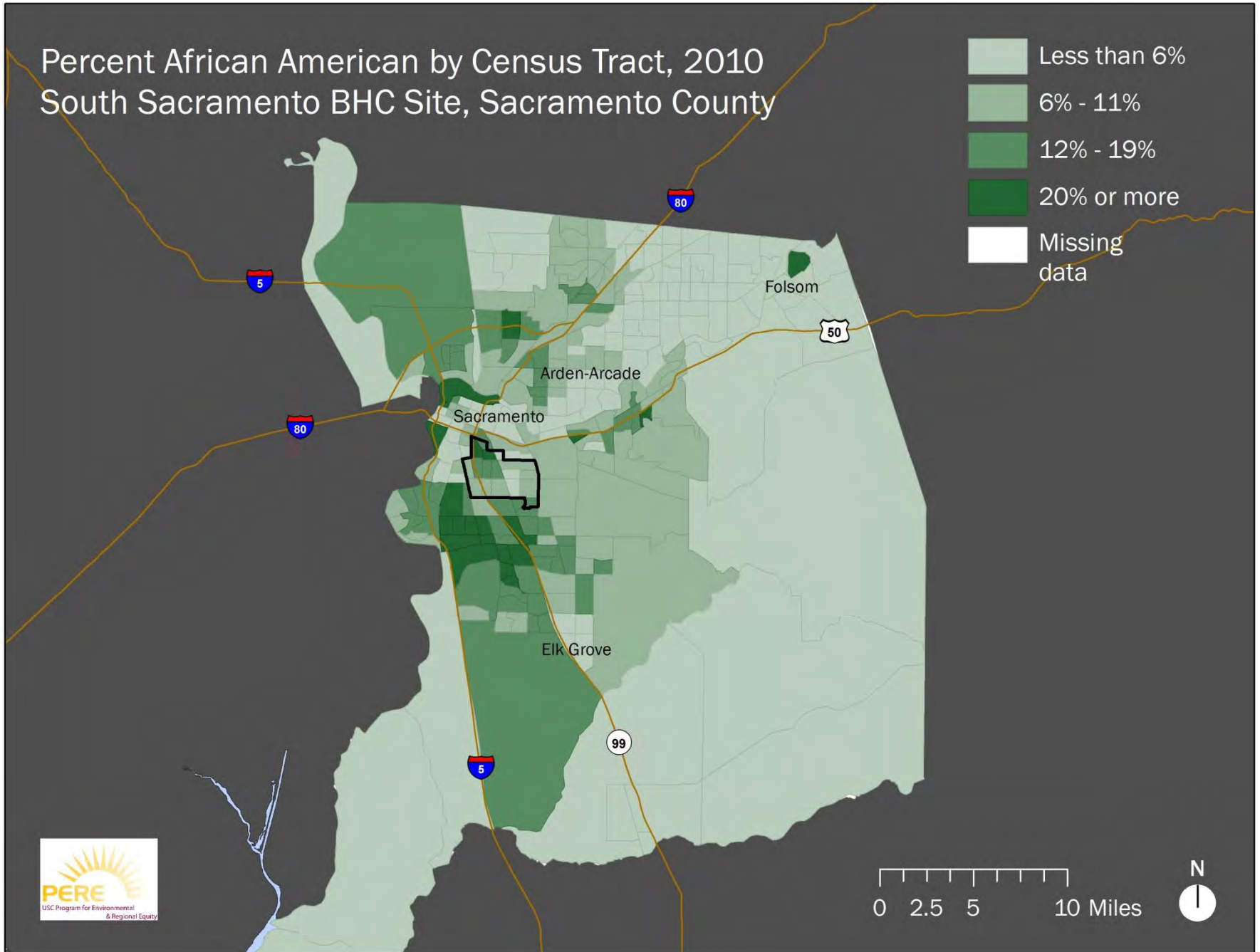
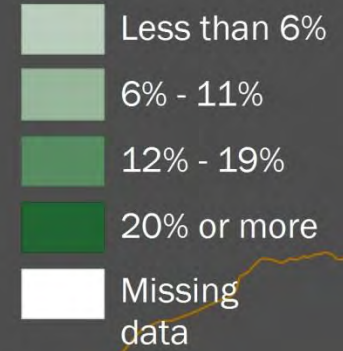
Percent African American by Census Tract, 1990 South Sacramento BHC Site, Sacramento County



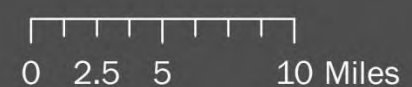
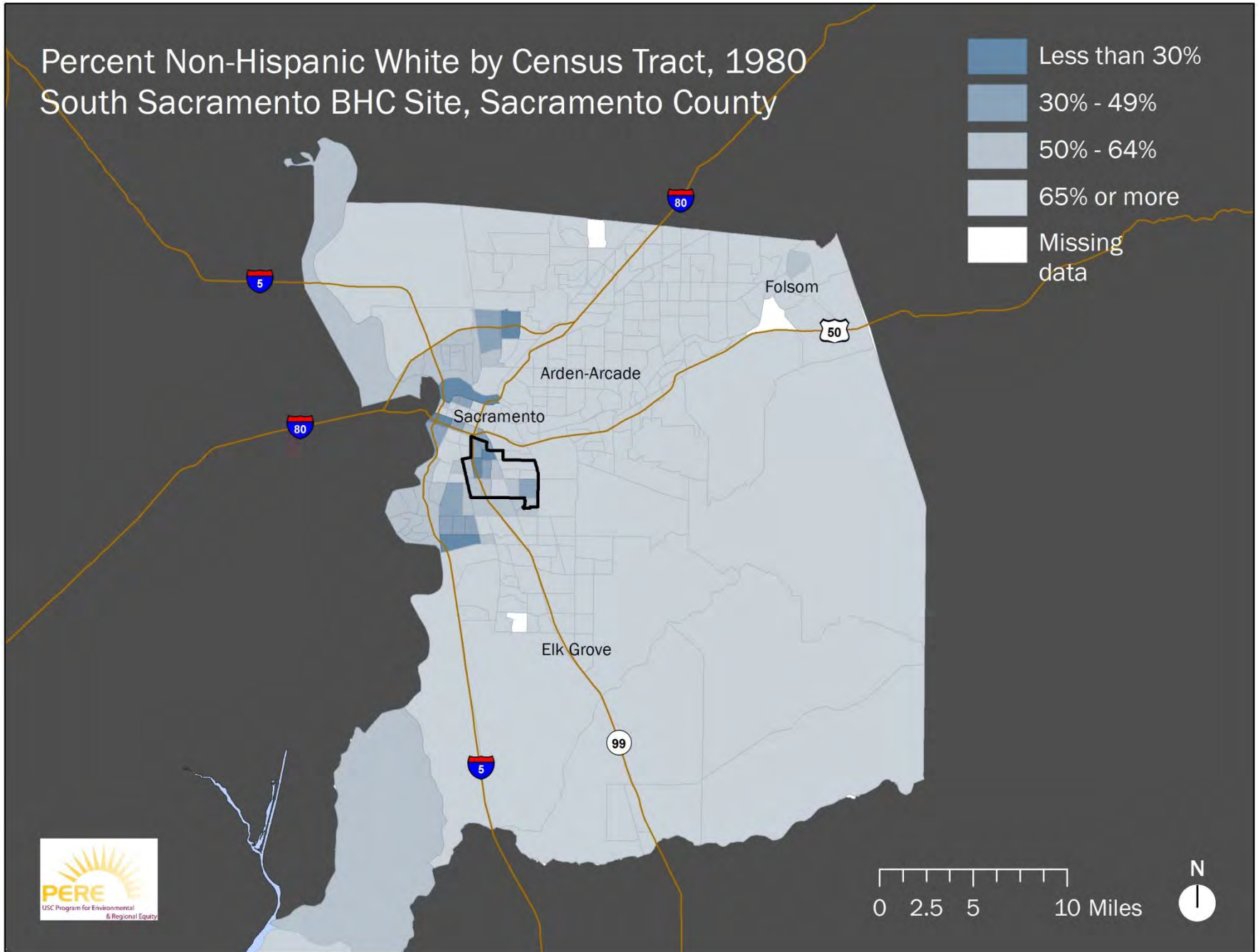
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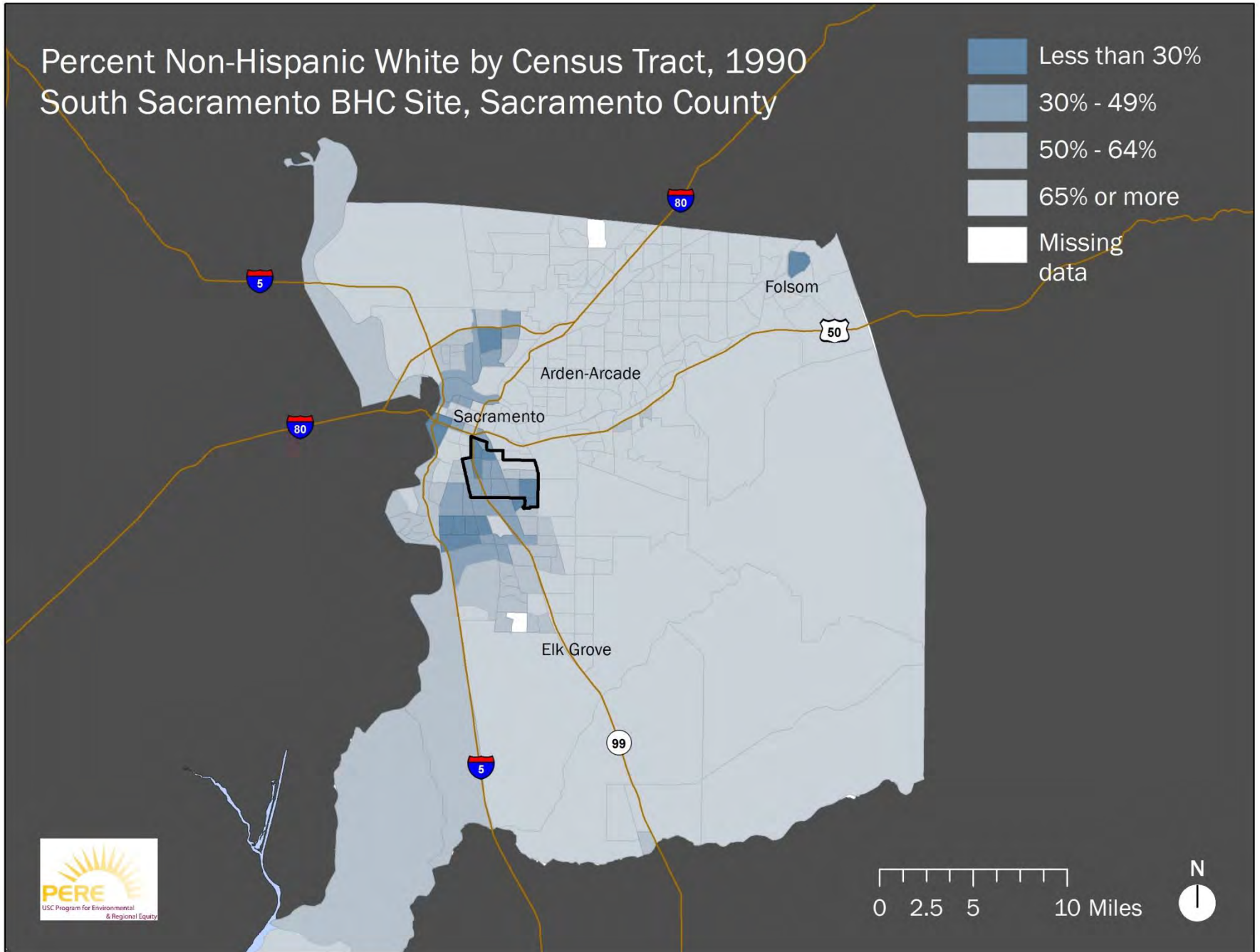
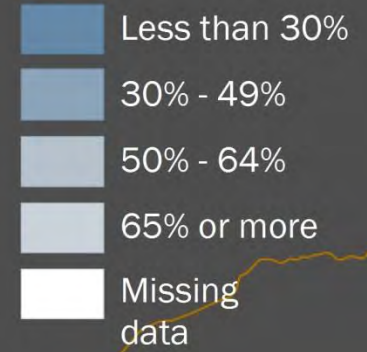
Percent African American by Census Tract, 2010 South Sacramento BHC Site, Sacramento County



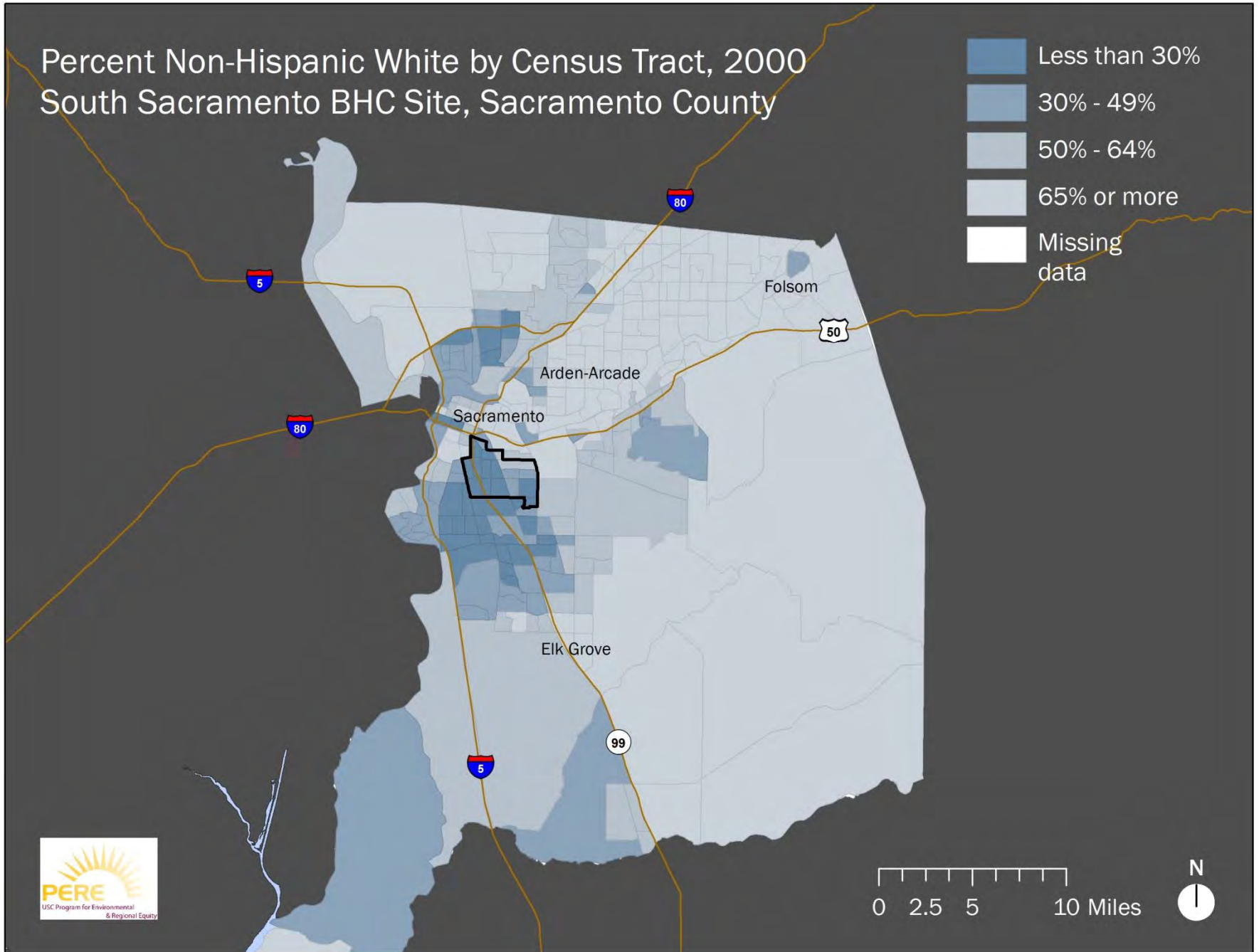
Percent Non-Hispanic White by Census Tract, 1980 South Sacramento BHC Site, Sacramento County



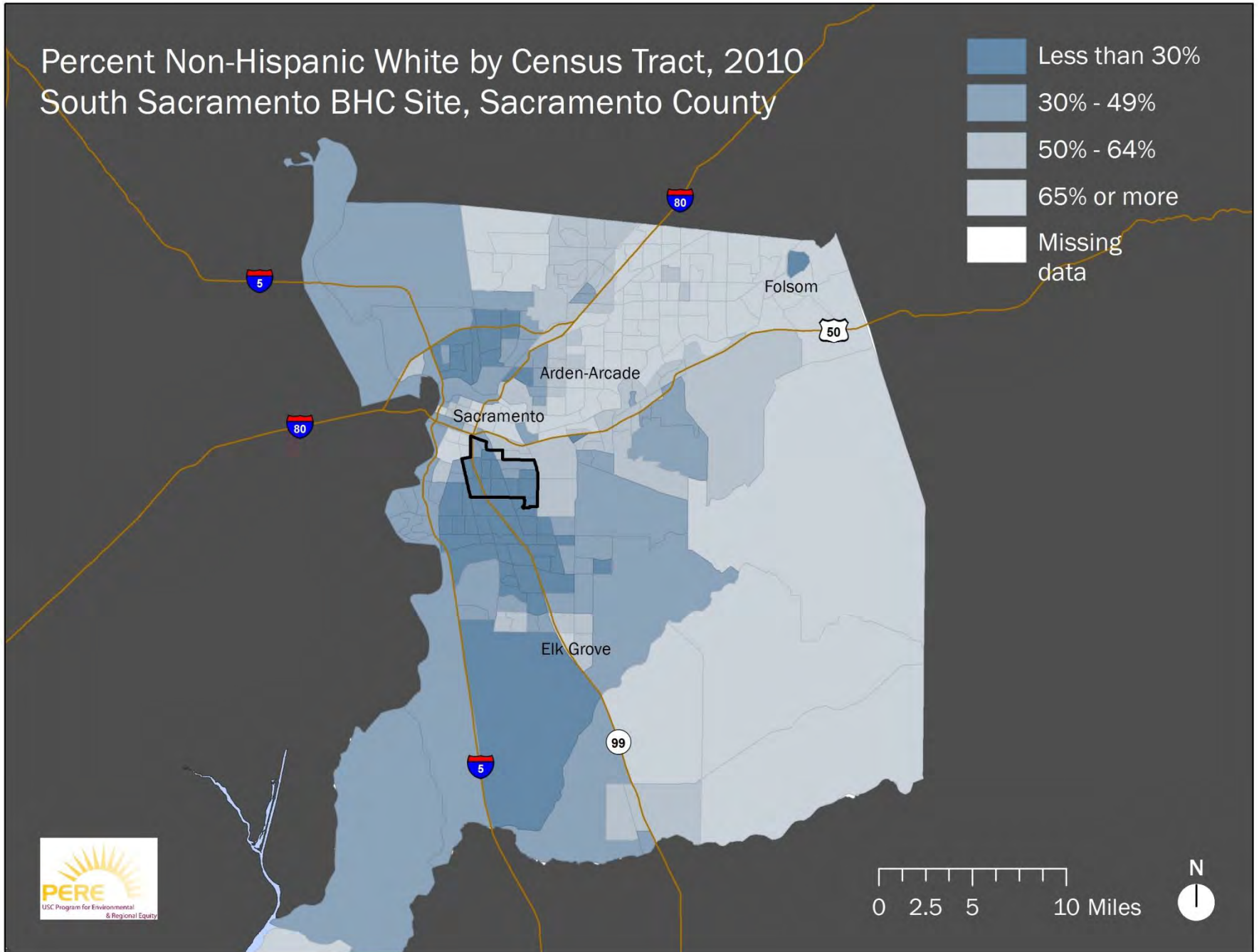
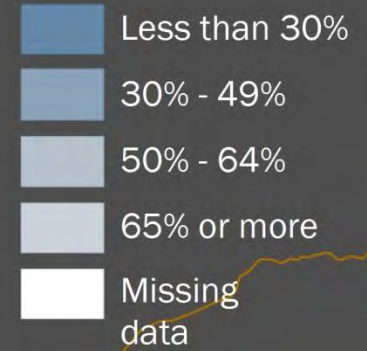
Percent Non-Hispanic White by Census Tract, 1990 South Sacramento BHC Site, Sacramento County



Percent Non-Hispanic White by Census Tract, 2000 South Sacramento BHC Site, Sacramento County

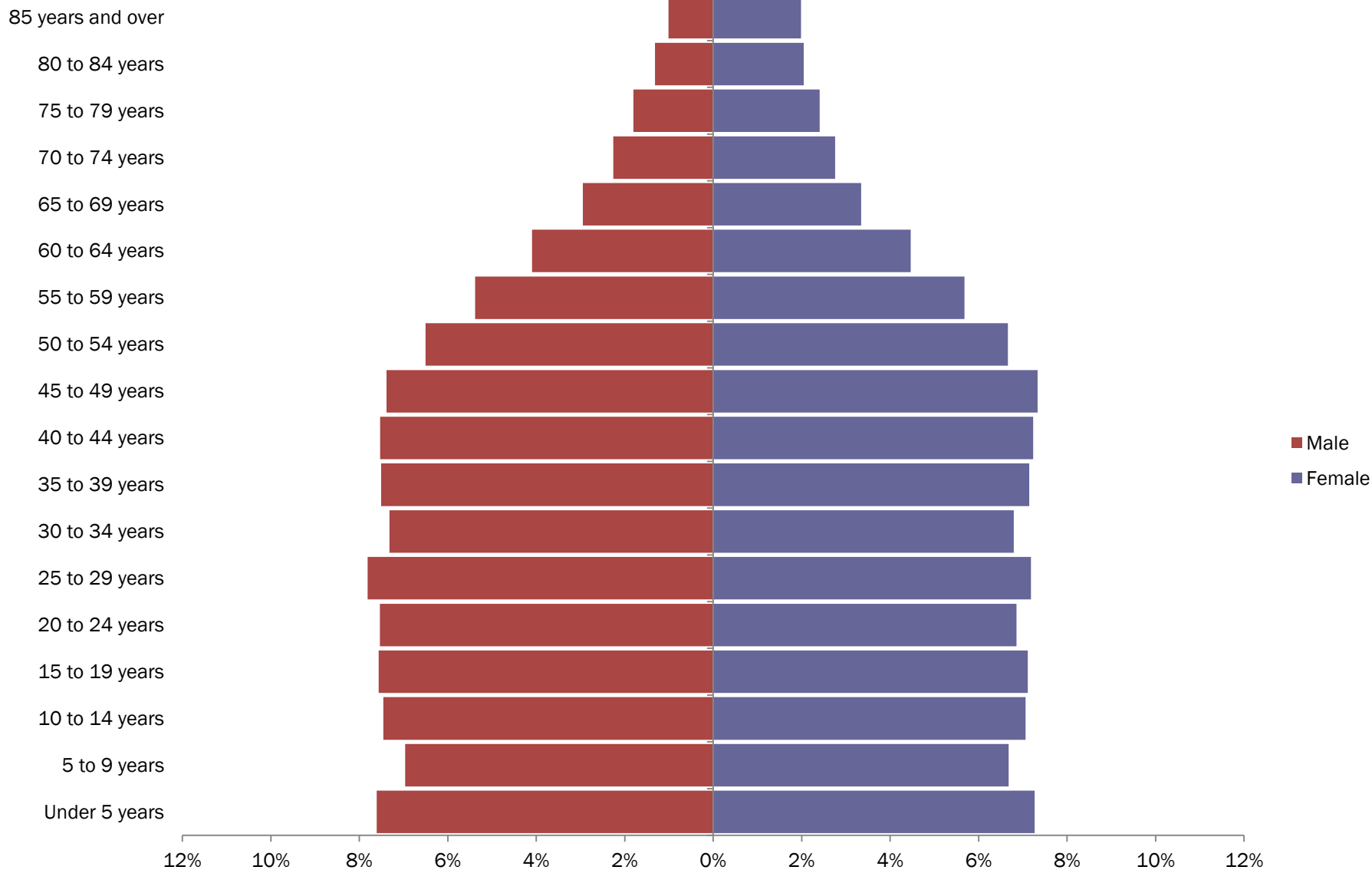


Percent Non-Hispanic White by Census Tract, 2010 South Sacramento BHC Site, Sacramento County



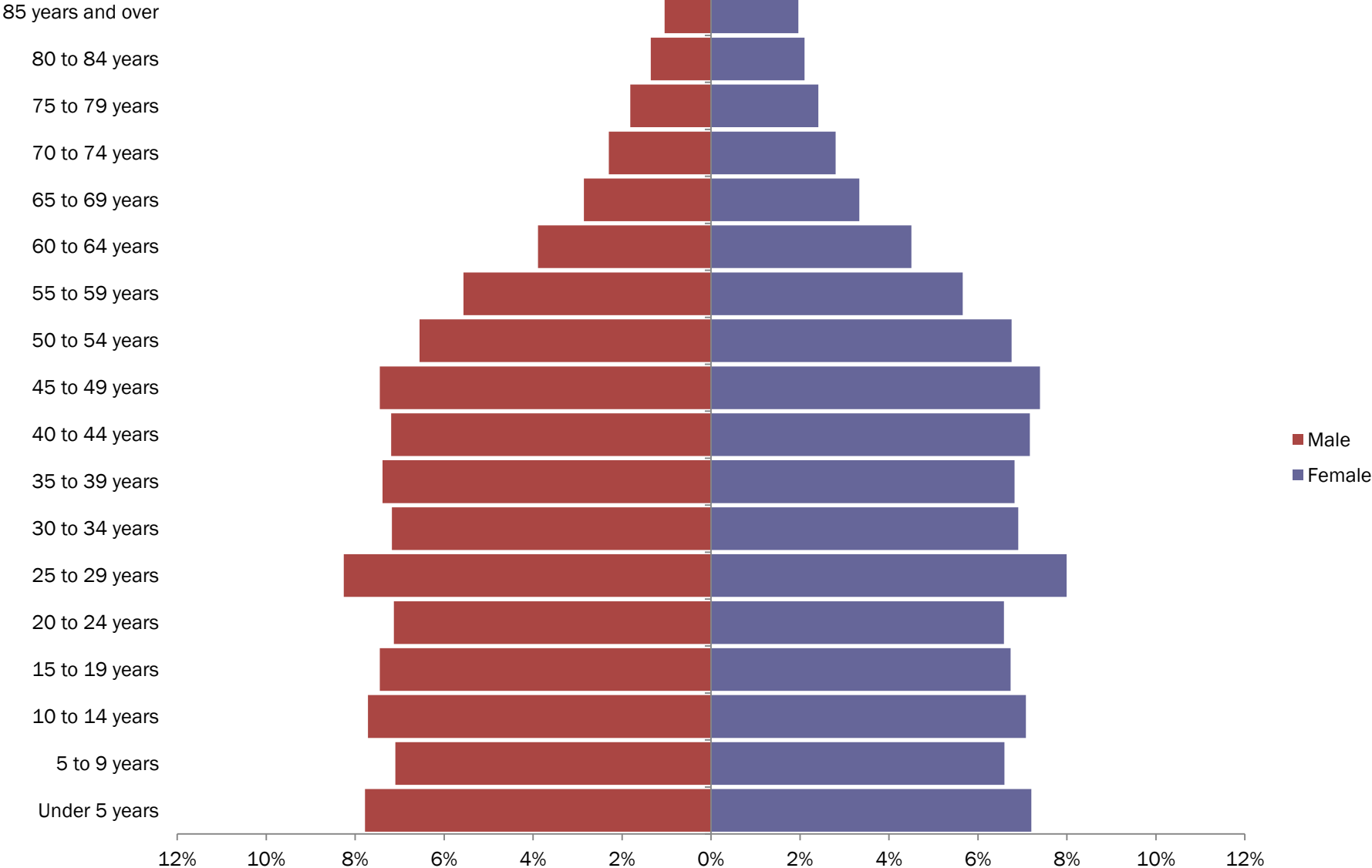

Age by Sex, California, 2005-09



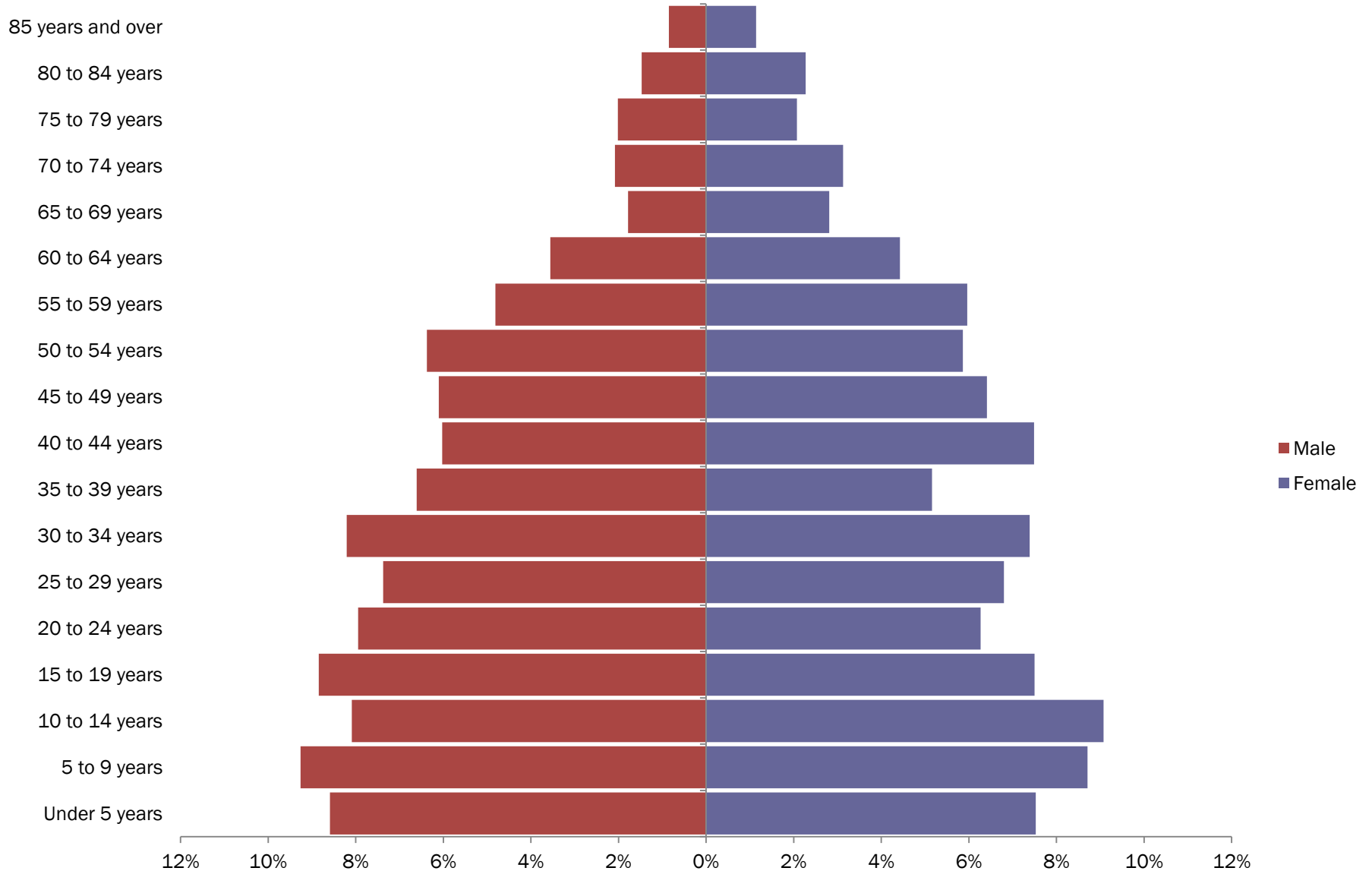

Age by Sex, Sacramento County, 2005-09



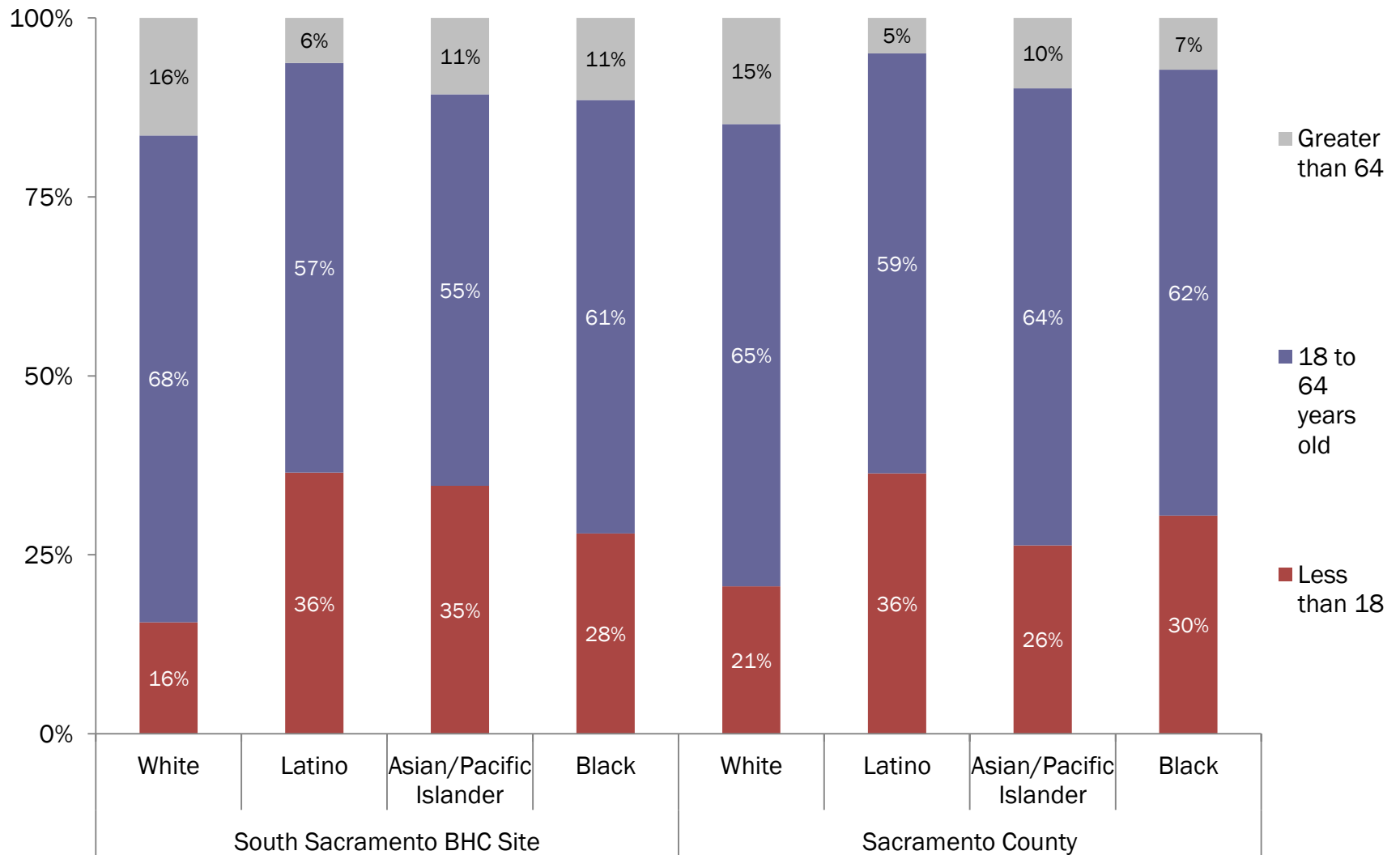

Age by Sex, South Sacramento BHC Site, 2005-09



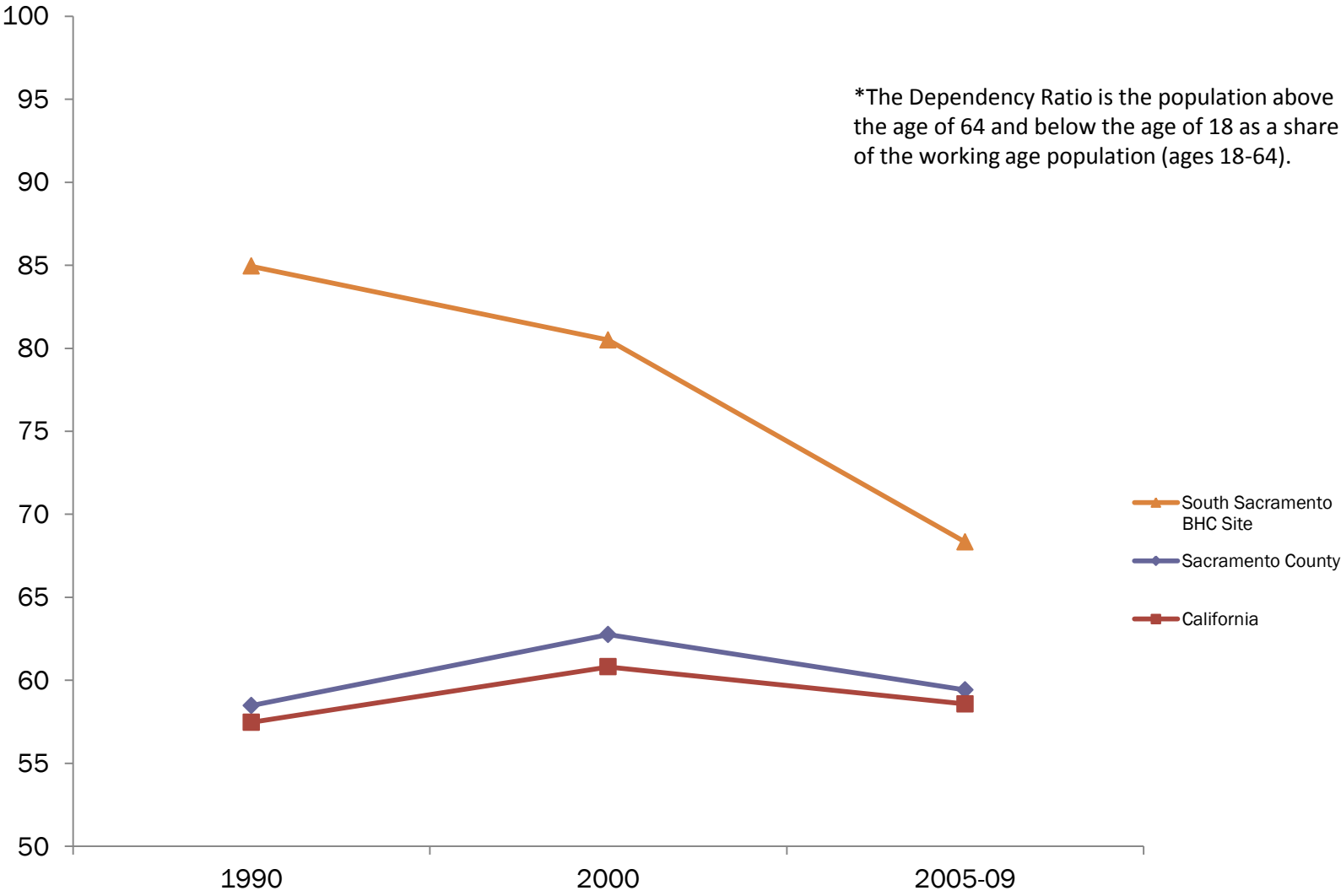

Age Distribution by Race/Ethnicity 2005-2009



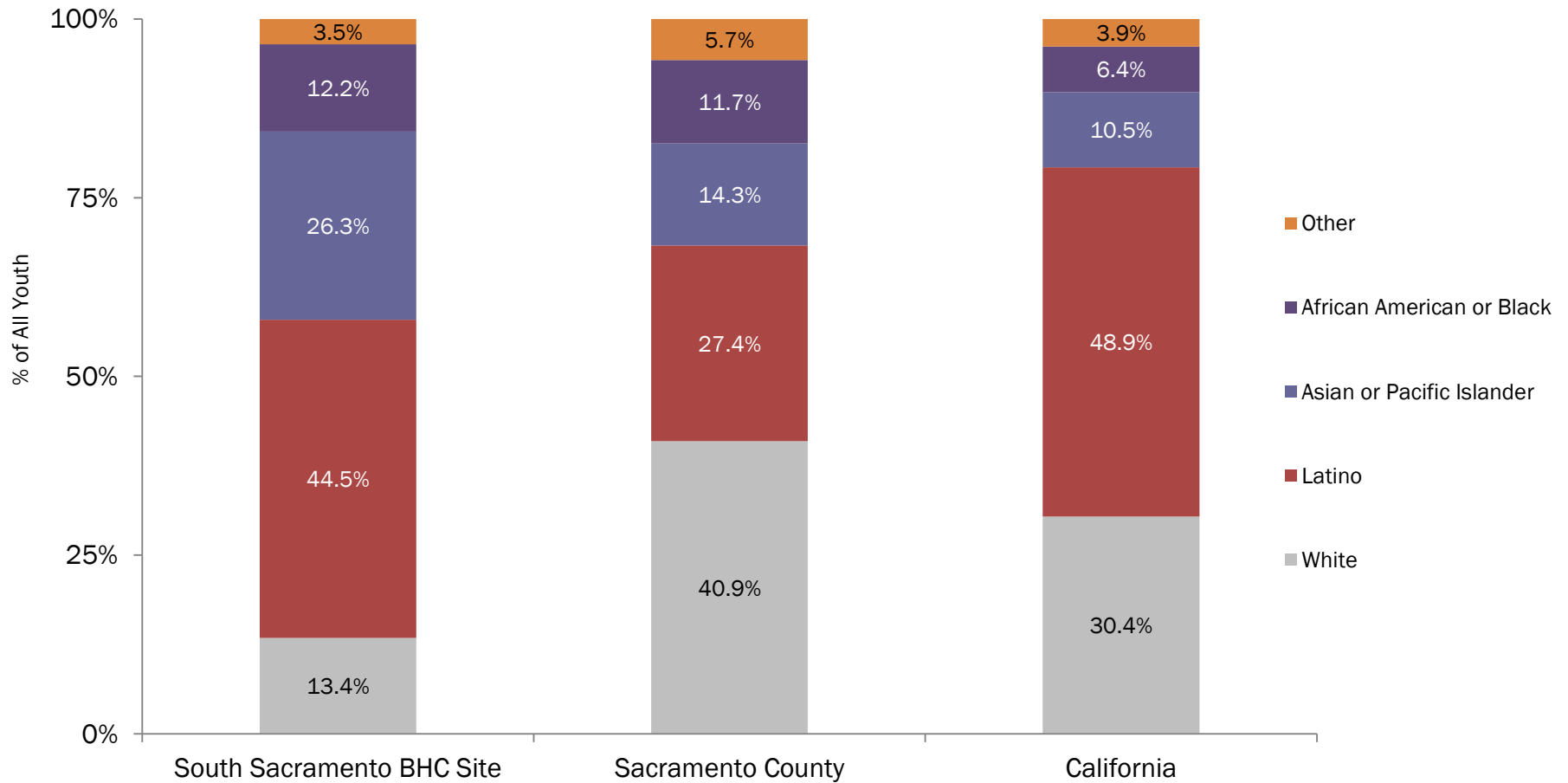

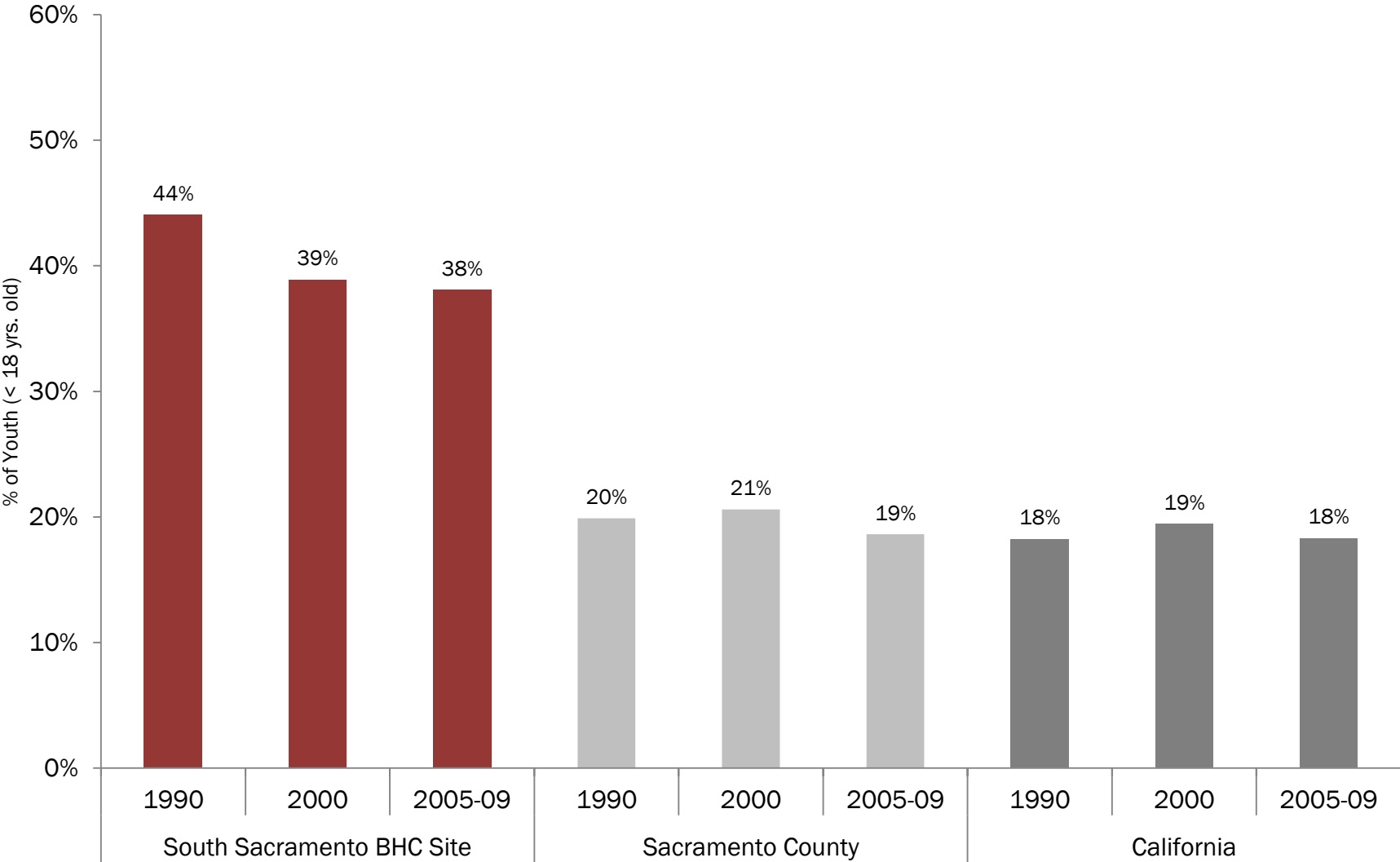
Youth by Race/Ethnicity* 2005-2009

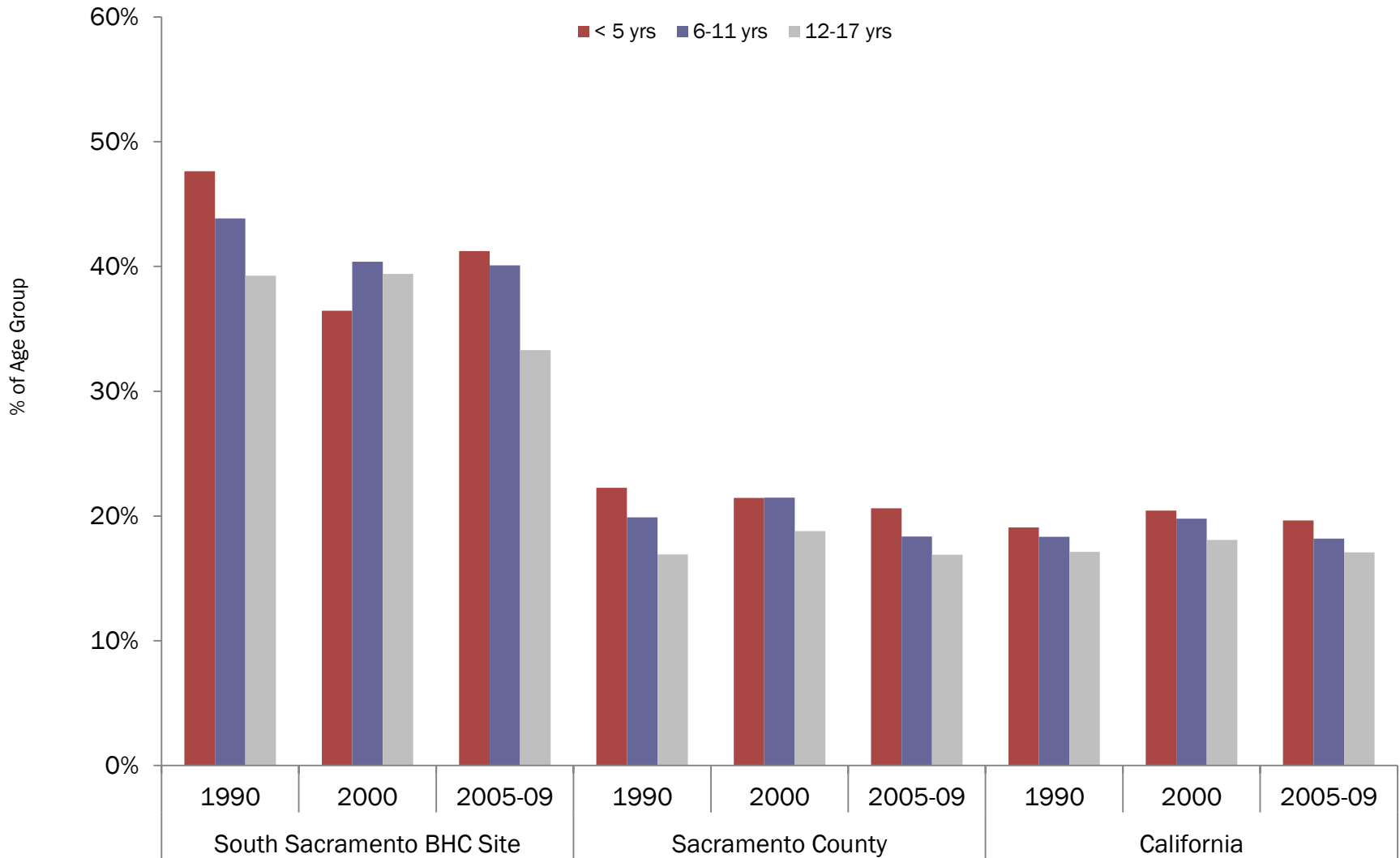

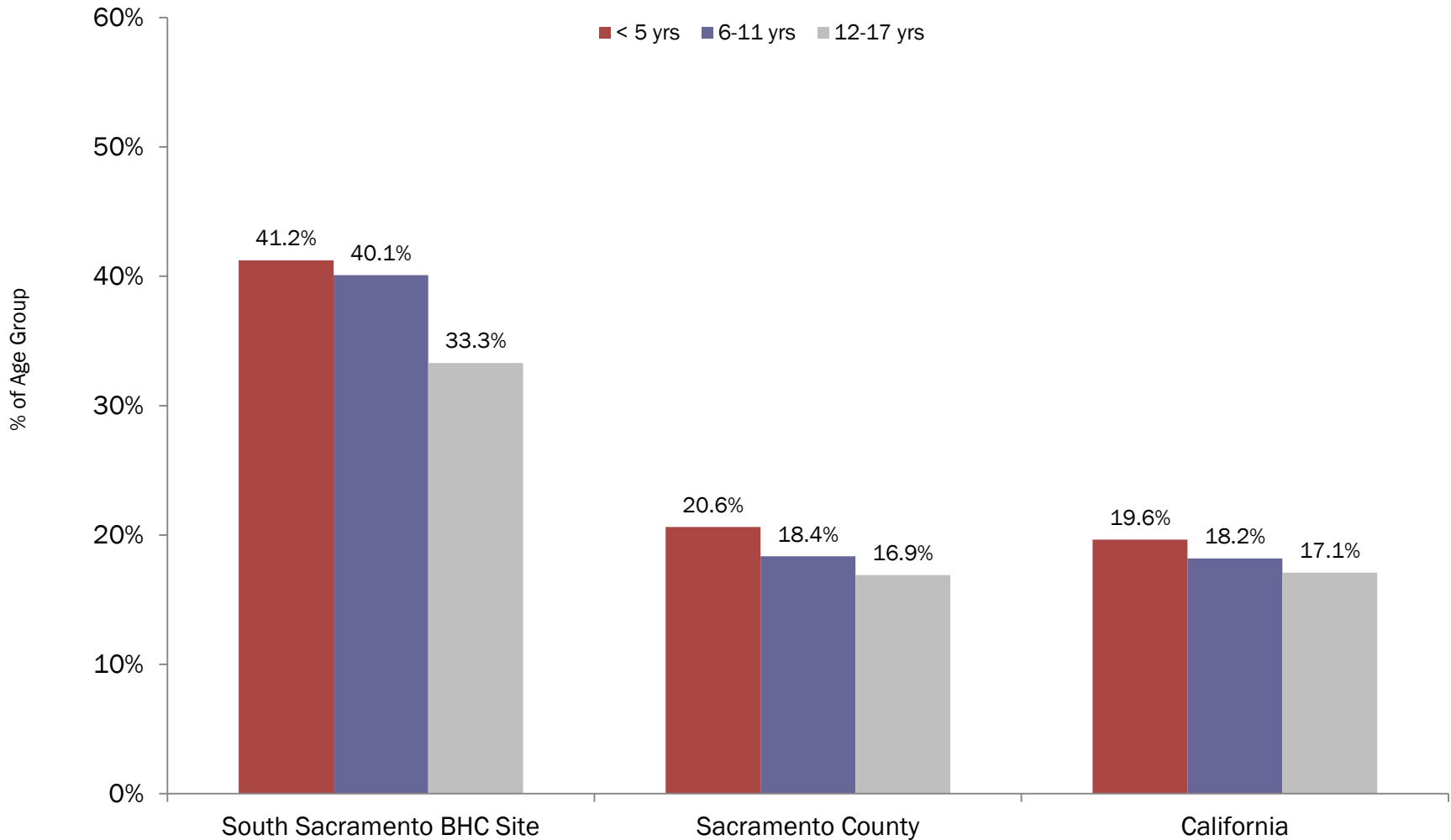
Percent of Youth in Poverty by Age Group* 1990 to 2005-2009

Percent of Youth in Poverty by Age Group* 2005-2009

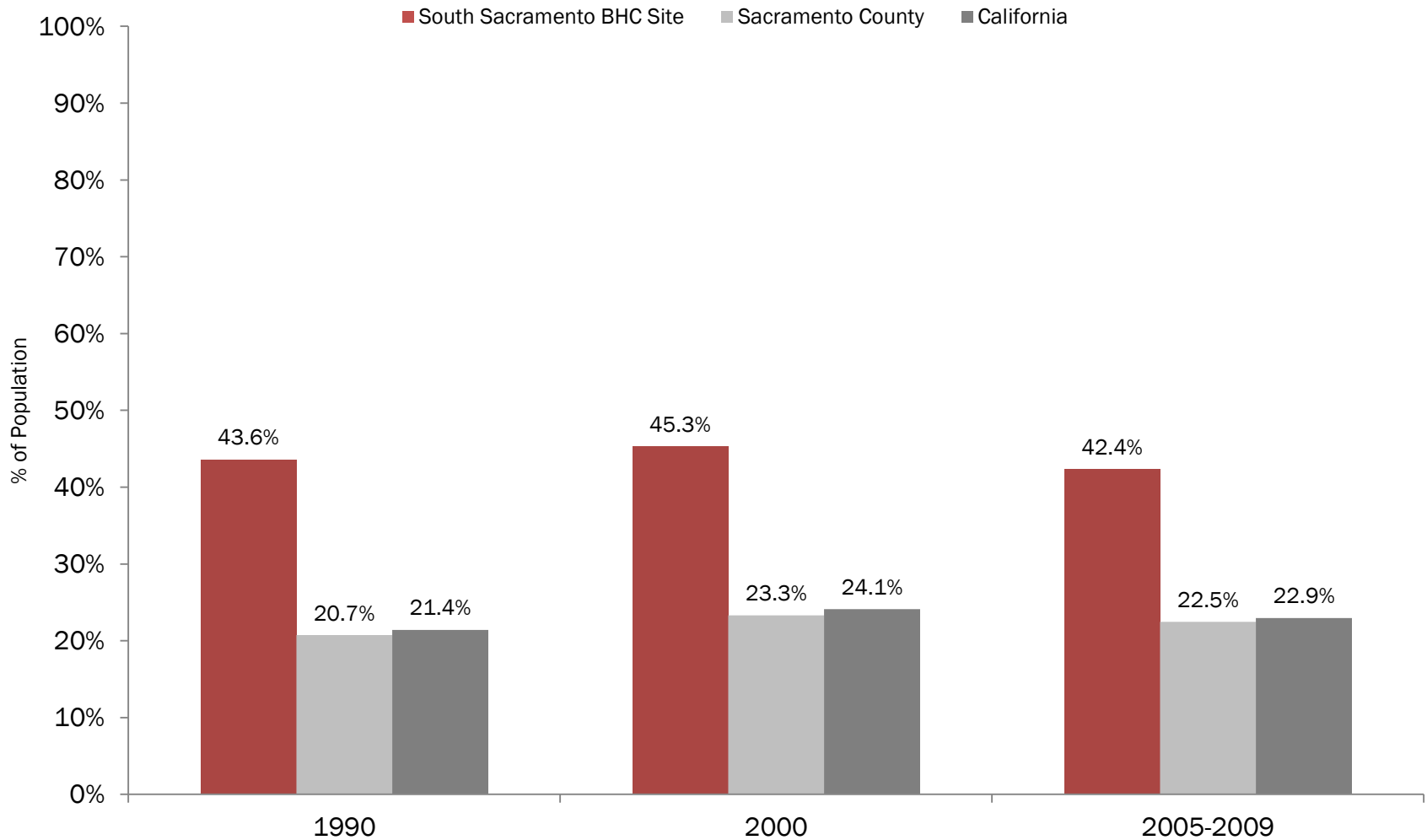

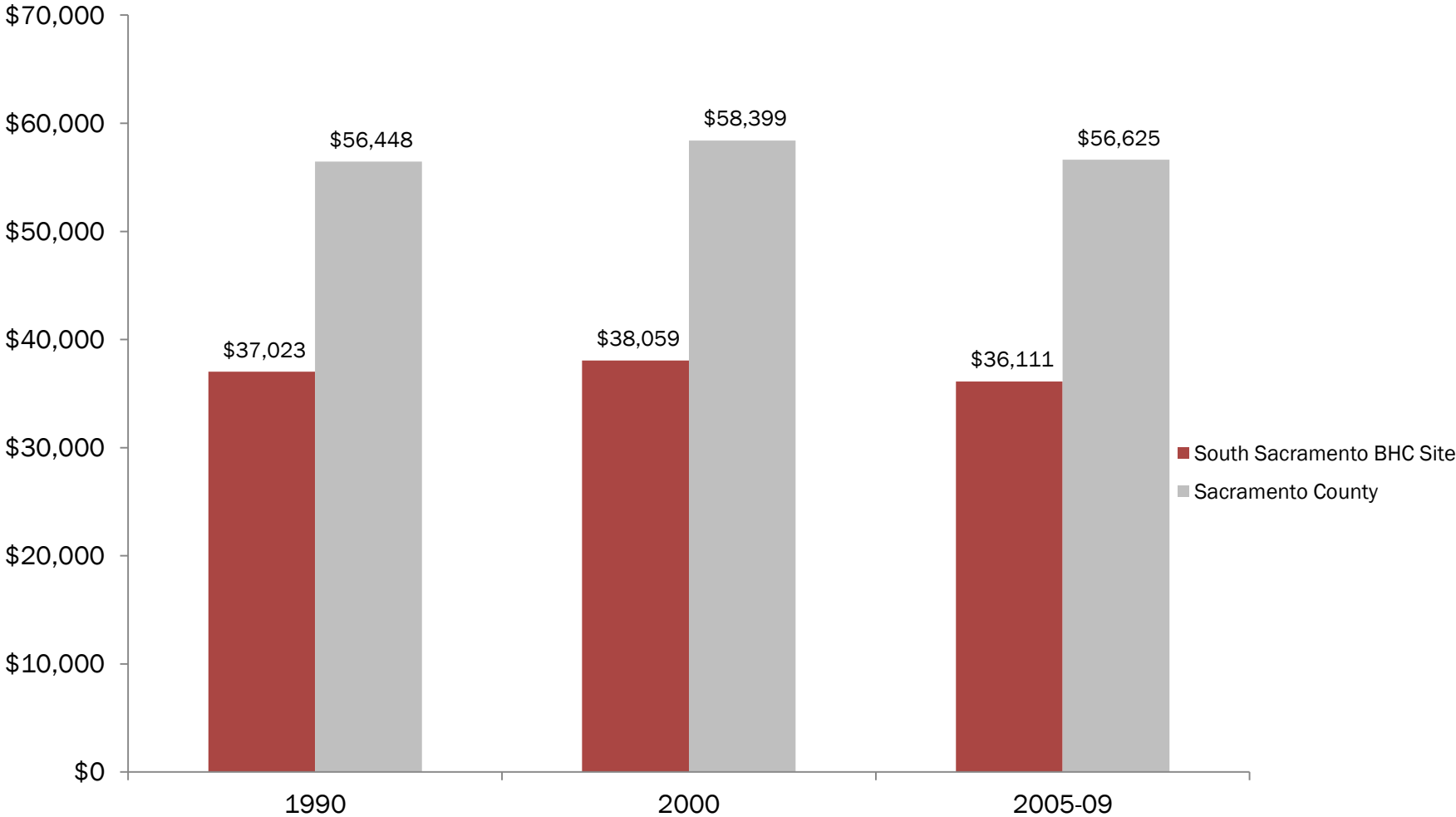

Percent of Population Below 150 Percent Federal Poverty Line (FPL)* 1990 to 2005-2009



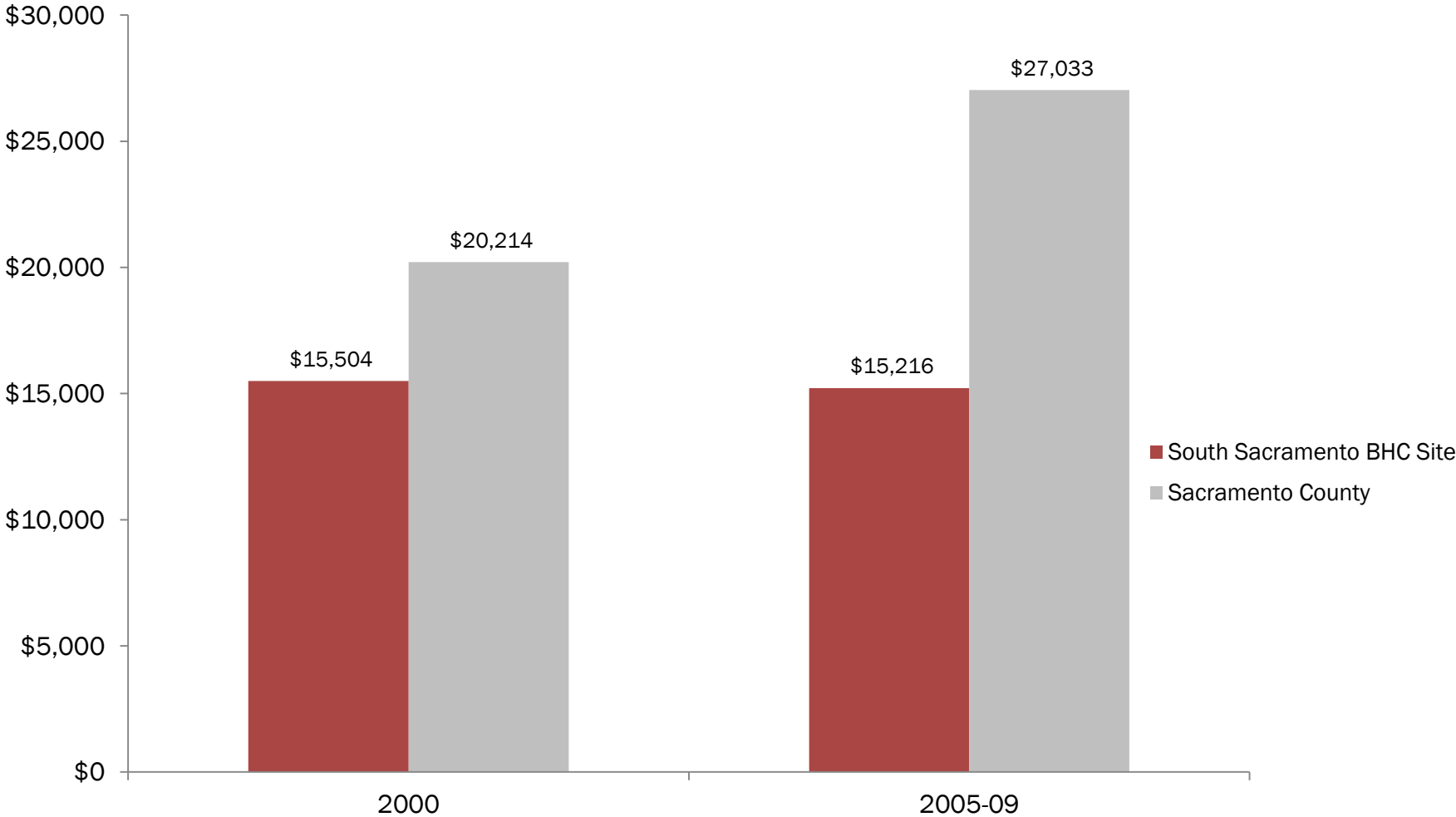

Median Household Income 1990 to 2005-2009



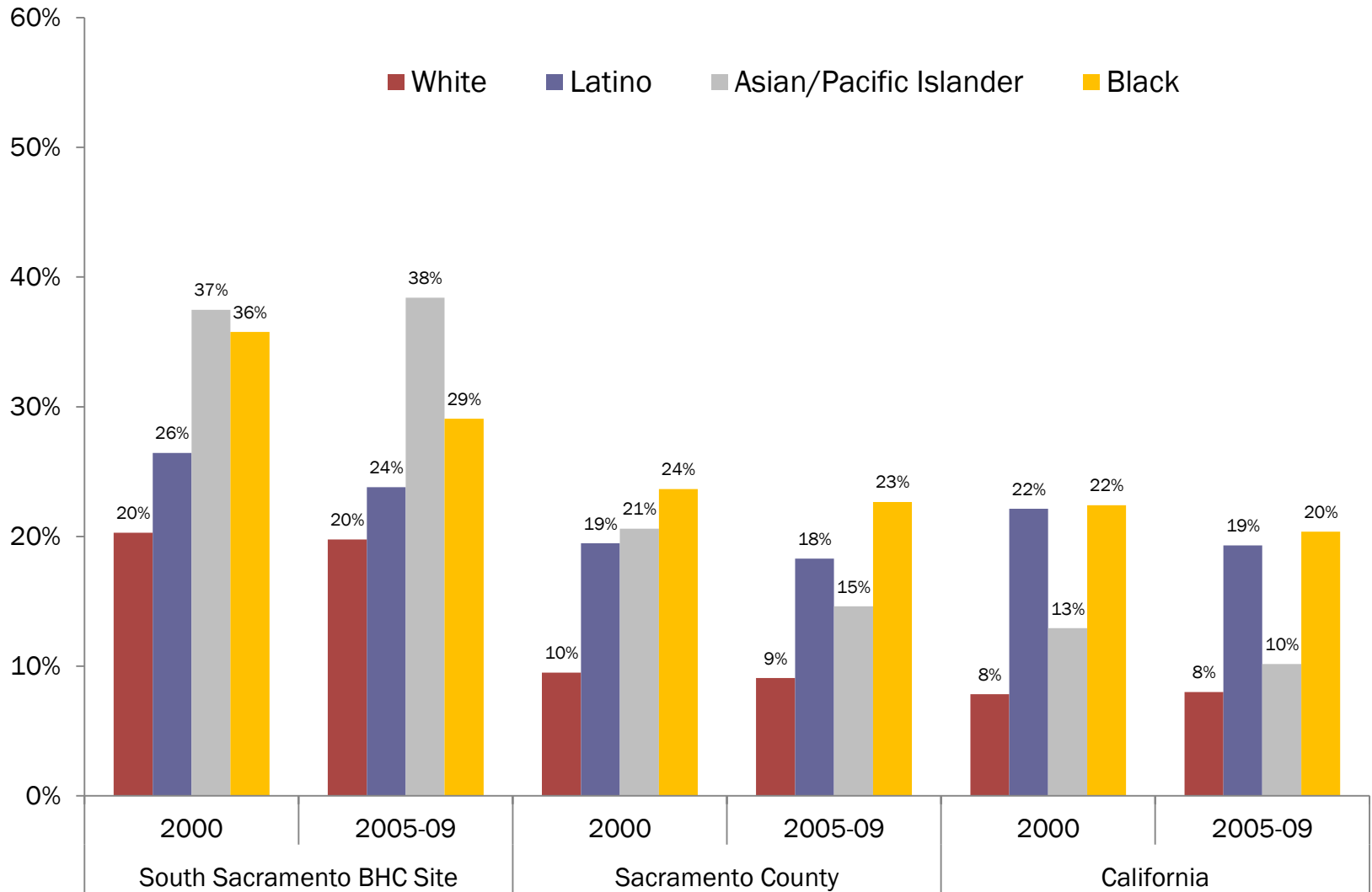

Average Per Capita Income 1990 to 2005-2009



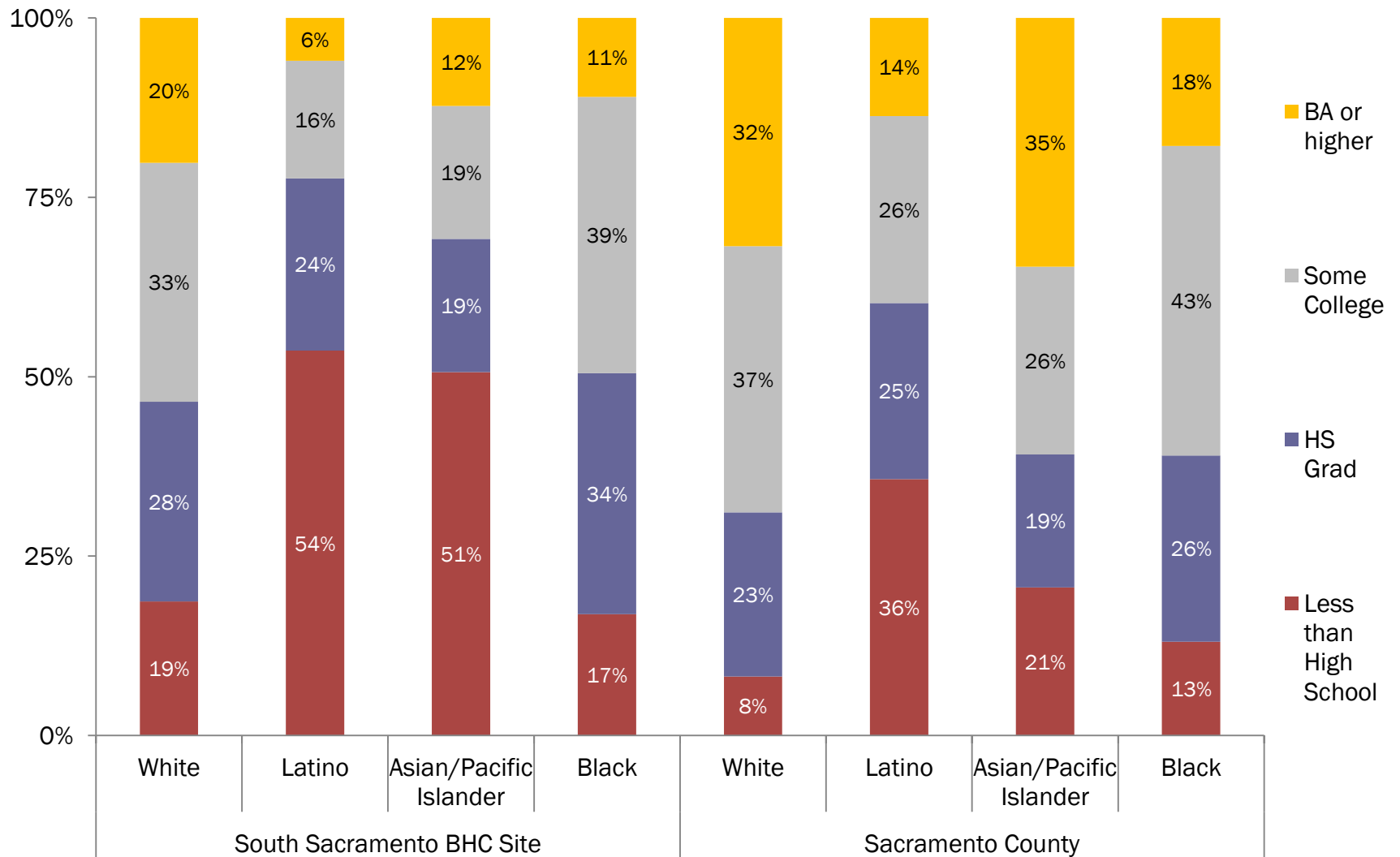

Percent Poverty by Race/Ethnicity 2000 & 2005-2009



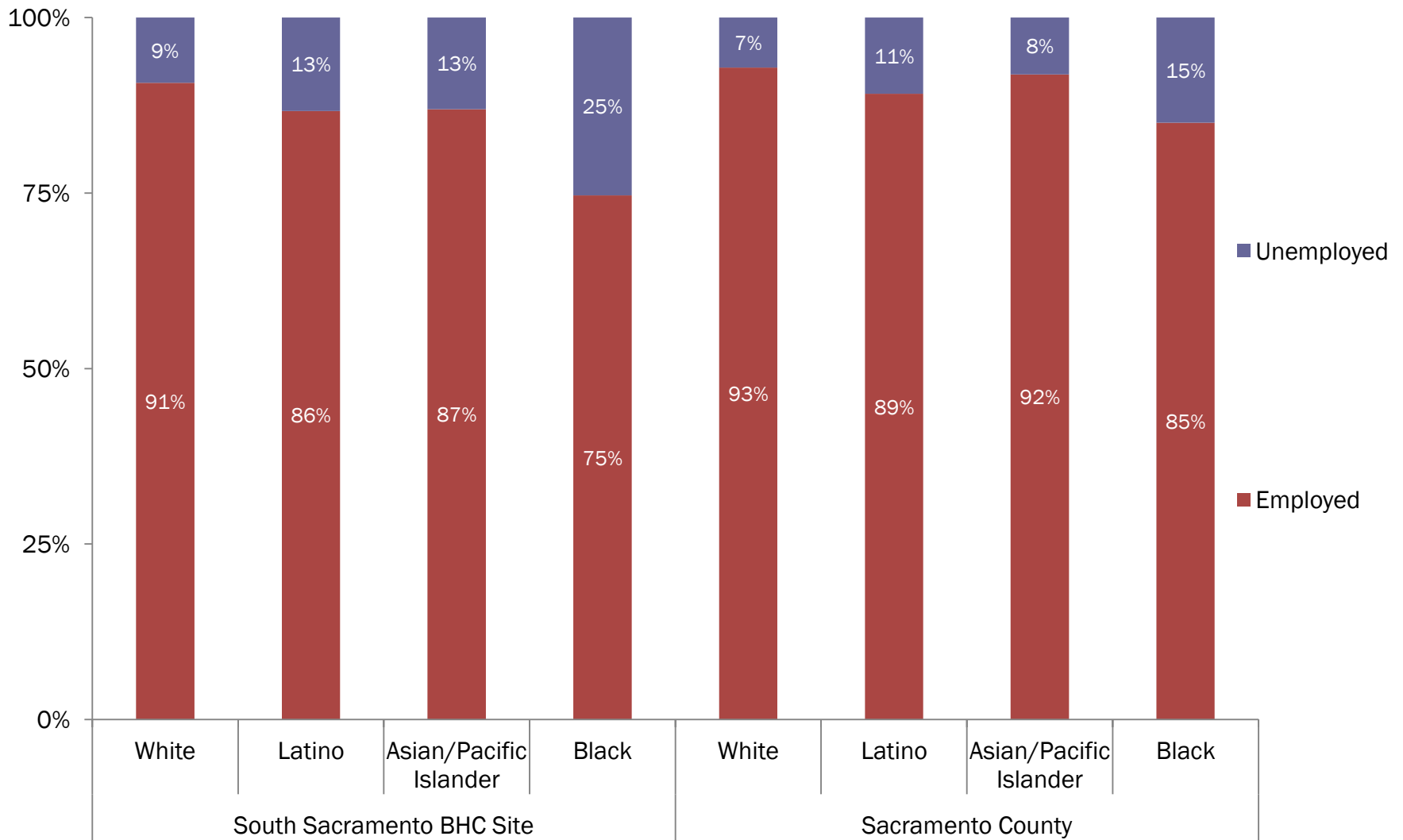

Educational Attainment by Race/Ethnicity 2005-2009



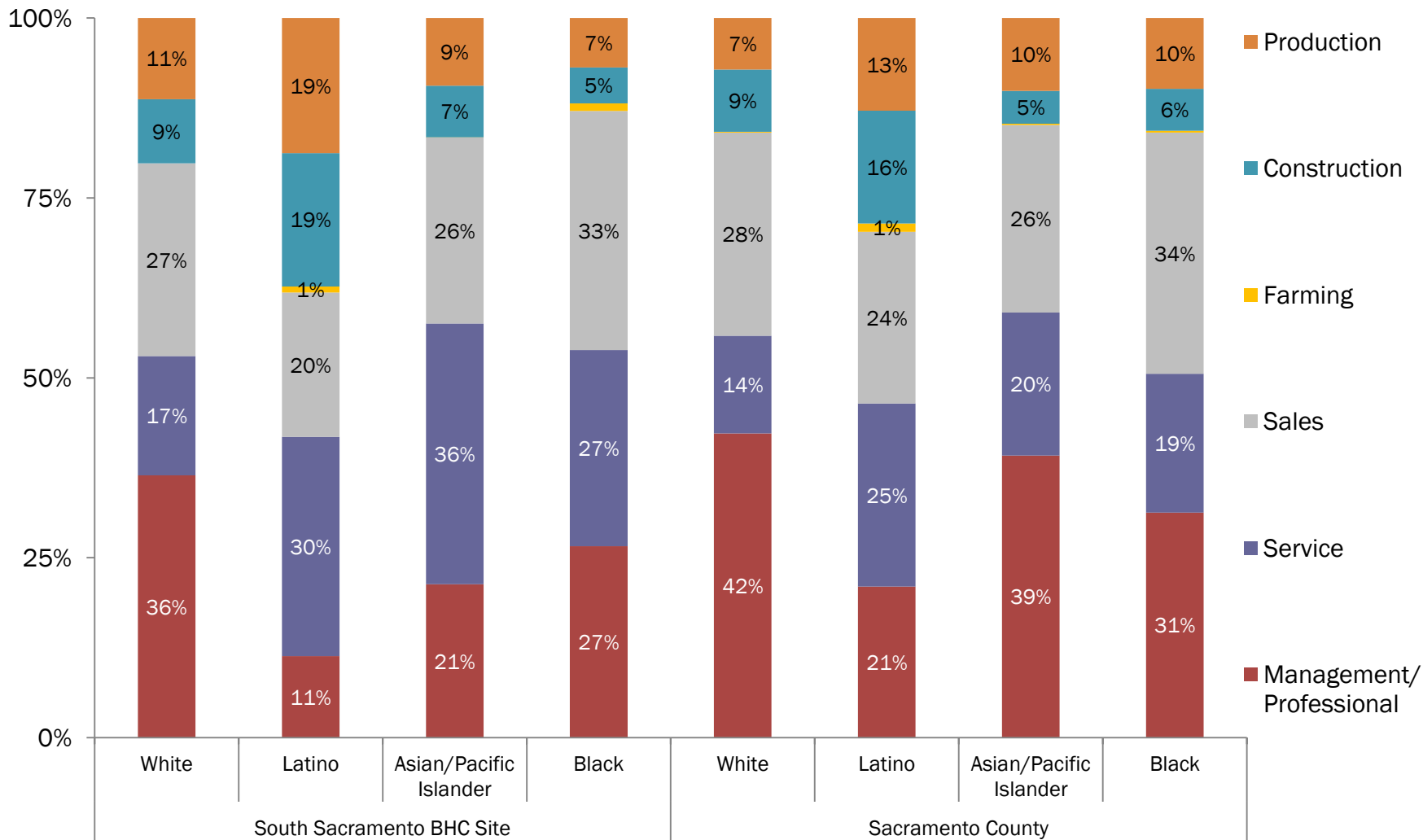

Employment Status by Race/Ethnicity 2005-2009



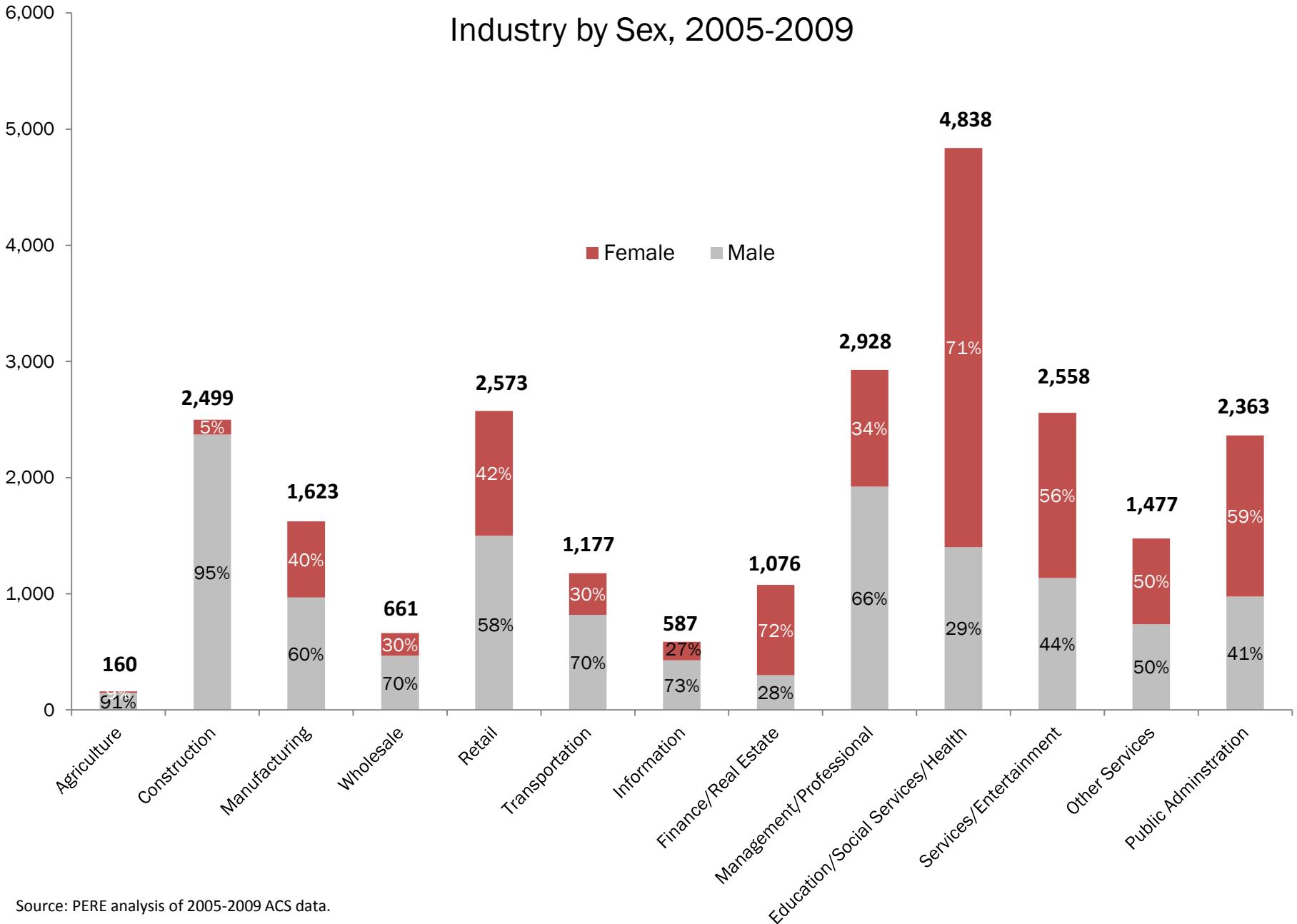

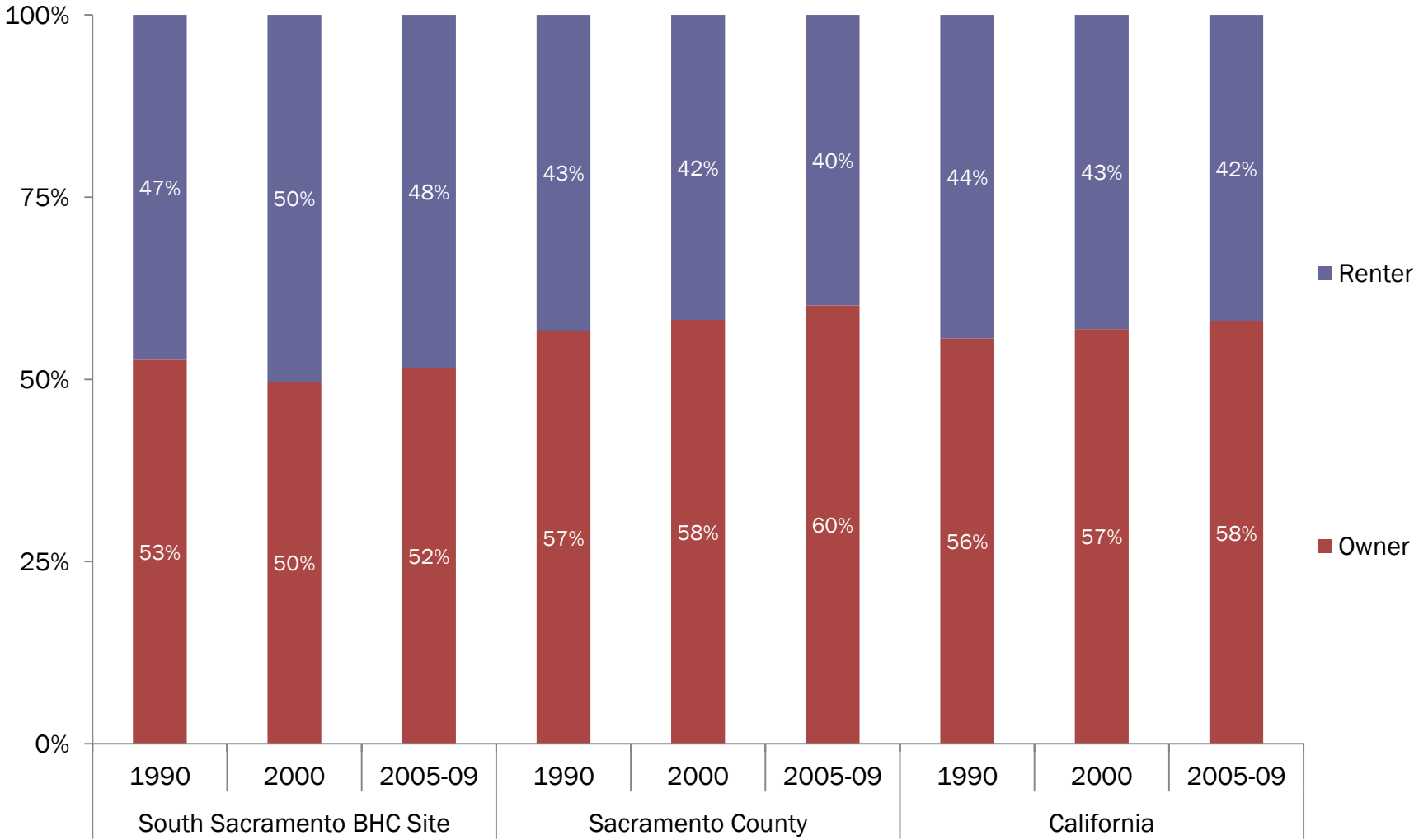
Industry by Sex, 2005-2009

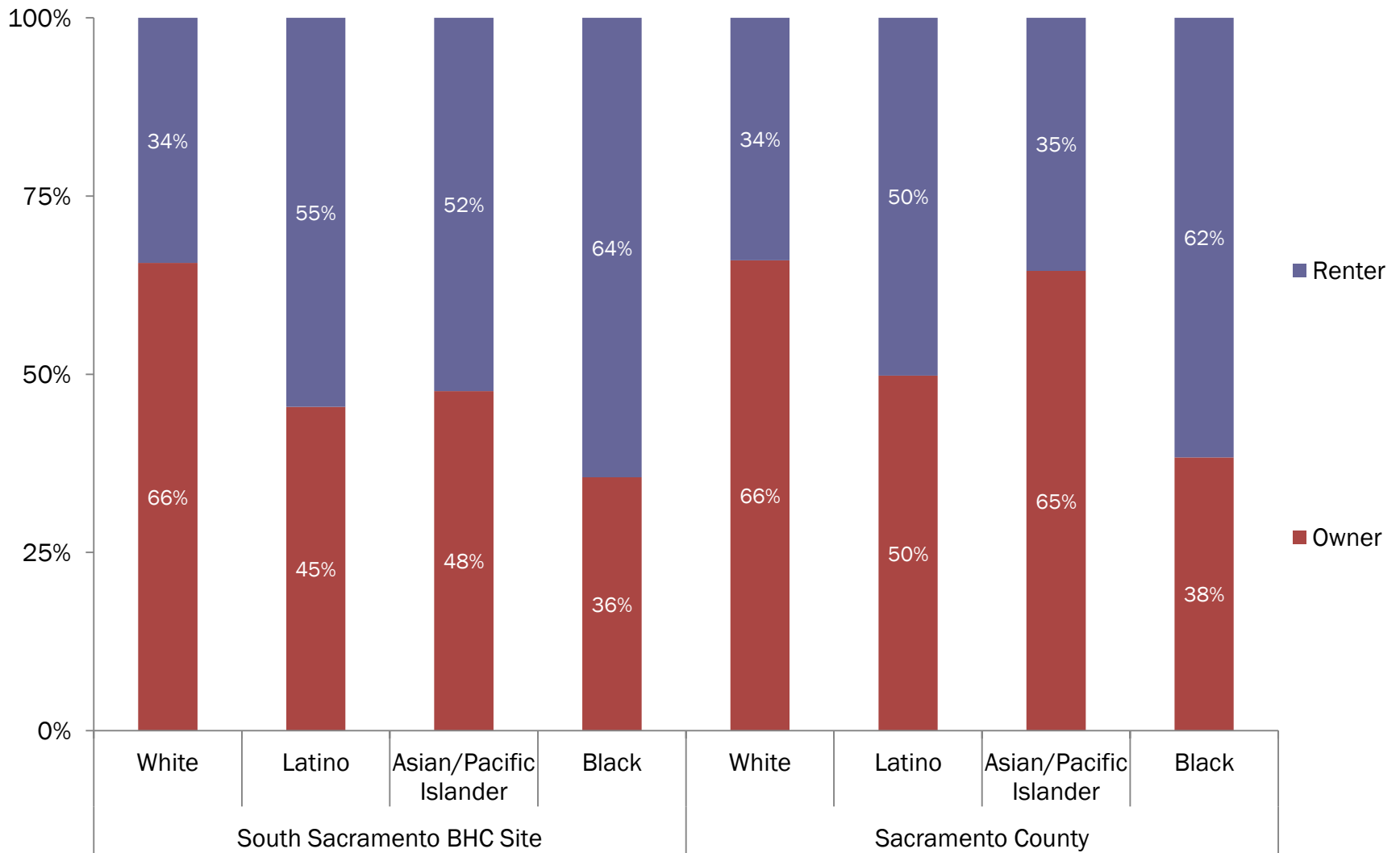

Housing Tenure 1990, 2000 & 2005-2009



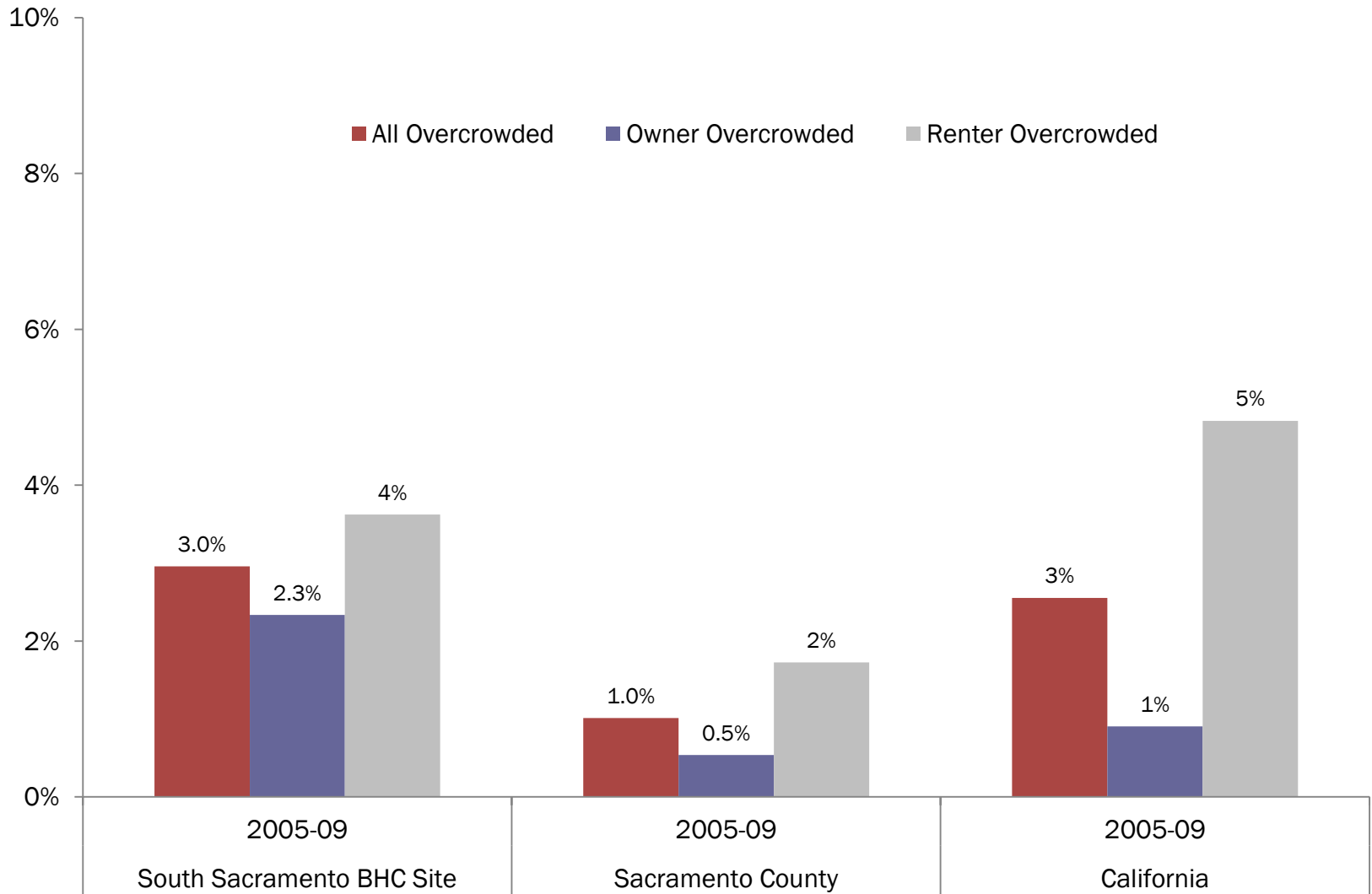

Health Equity Indicators

SOUTH SACRAMENTO BHC



Understanding the health of your community can start with understanding the numbers. How many children have access to a safe park? How many adults have health insurance? To answer these questions, hundreds of residents in South Sacramento participated in the California Health Interview Survey (CHIS). The survey was conducted to support *Building Healthy Communities (BHC)*, a 10-year plan of The California Endowment (TCE) to help 14 communities develop into places where children are healthy, safe, and ready to learn.

This Health Profile describes the health of adults, teens, and children living in South Sacramento, one of the 14 *BHC* sites. It provides a snapshot of key survey findings prior to implementing the *BHC* plan and can be used to mobilize friends and neighbors, advocate for community change, secure greater resources, and guide community planning. Selected Highlights

- Adults in South Sacramento are more likely than adults in California (14%) to have asthma (25%).
- Adults in South Sacramento are less likely to feel safe in their neighborhood than their county and state counterparts.
- 77% of children (age 1-17) in South Sacramento feel safe in a nearby park or playground compared to 95% of children in Sacramento County and 90% in California.
- The prevalence of serious psychological distress, a proxy for mental illness, in South Sacramento (19%) is nearly twice the estimate for Sacramento County (9%) and California (7%).

- 2% of children are uninsured versus 3%* in Sacramento County & 5%* in CA

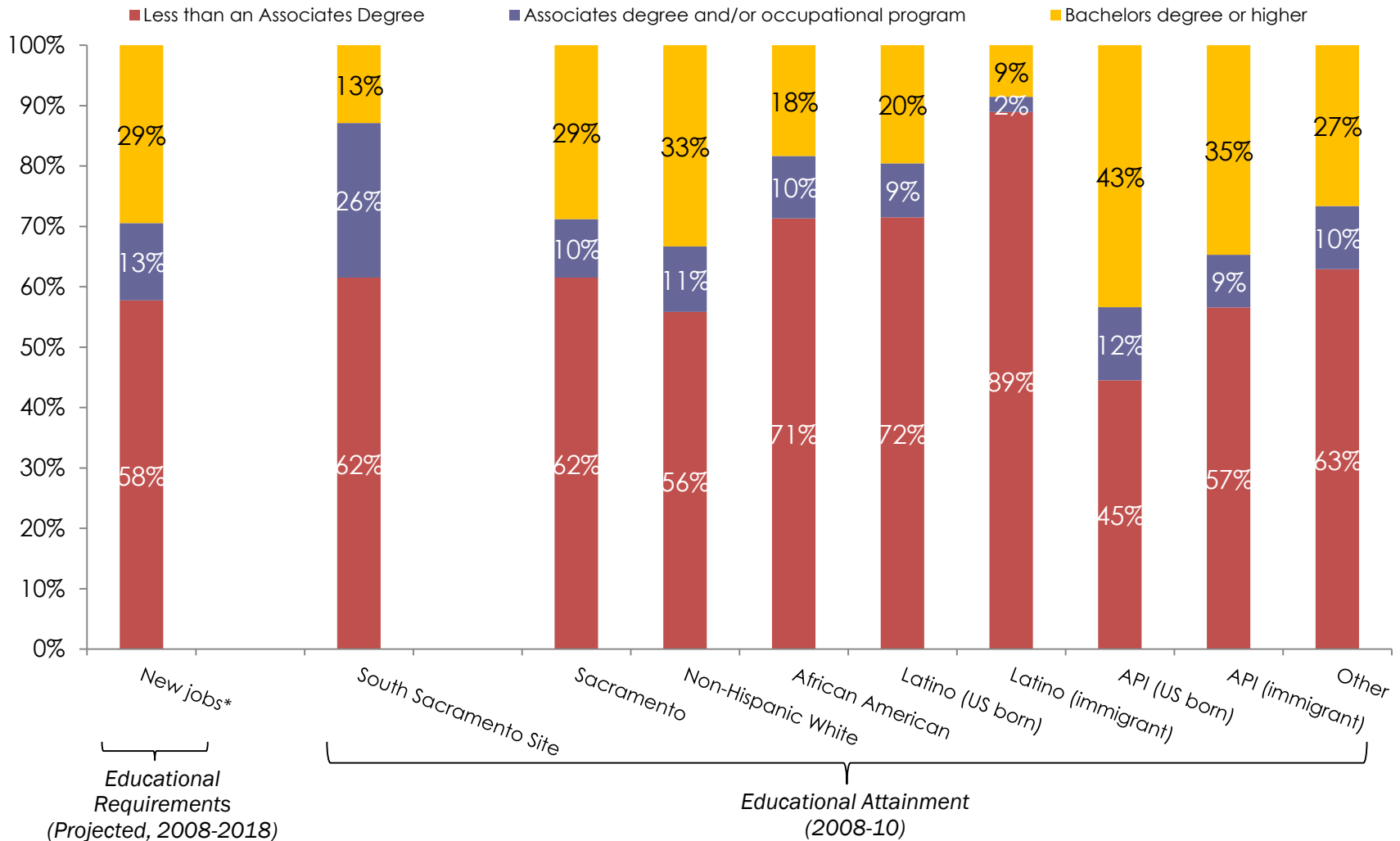

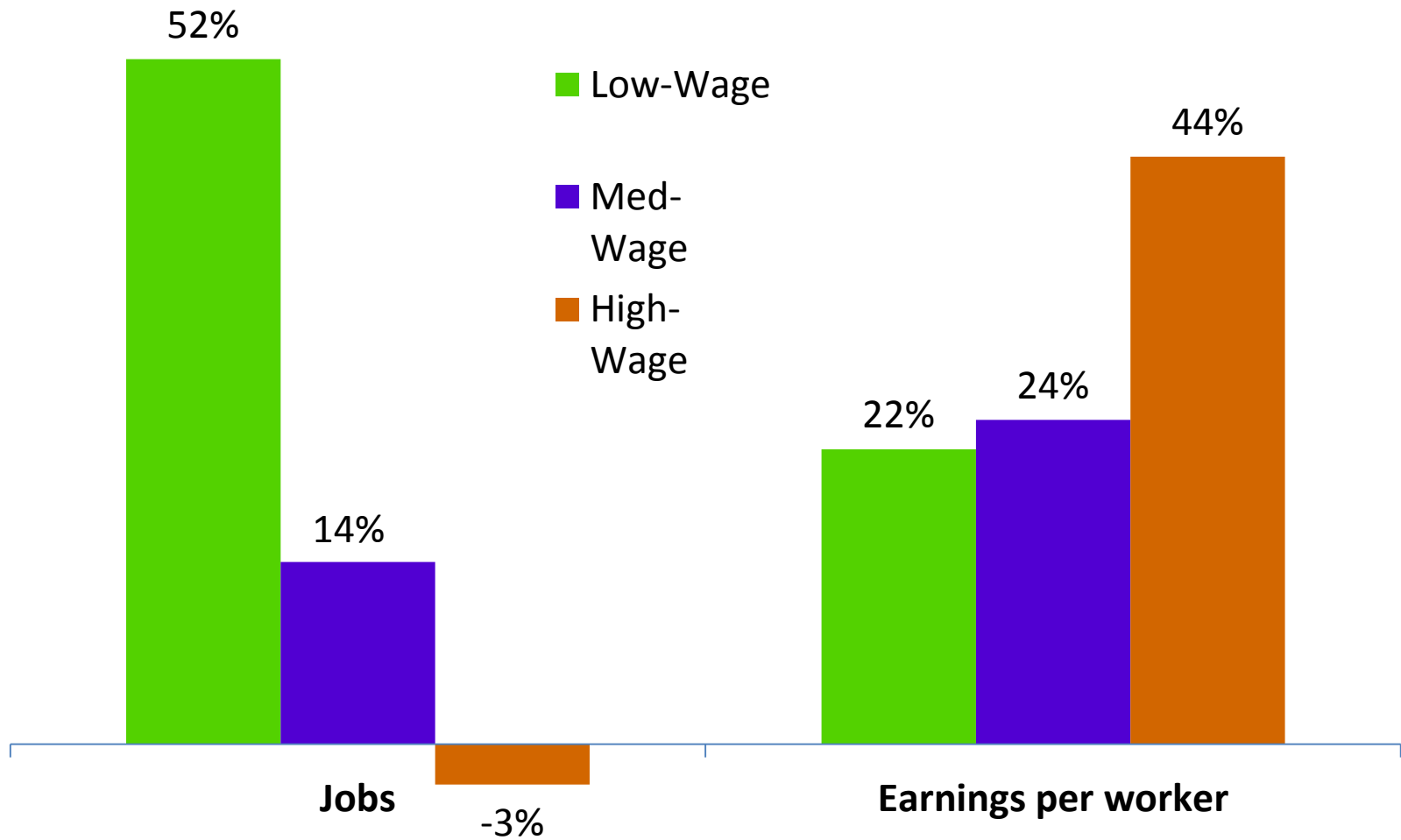
Sacramento County & South Sacramento BHC Site Educational Requirements for New Jobs in the Region & Educational Attainment by Race/Ethnicity

Growth in Jobs and Earnings by Wage Level, 1990-2010



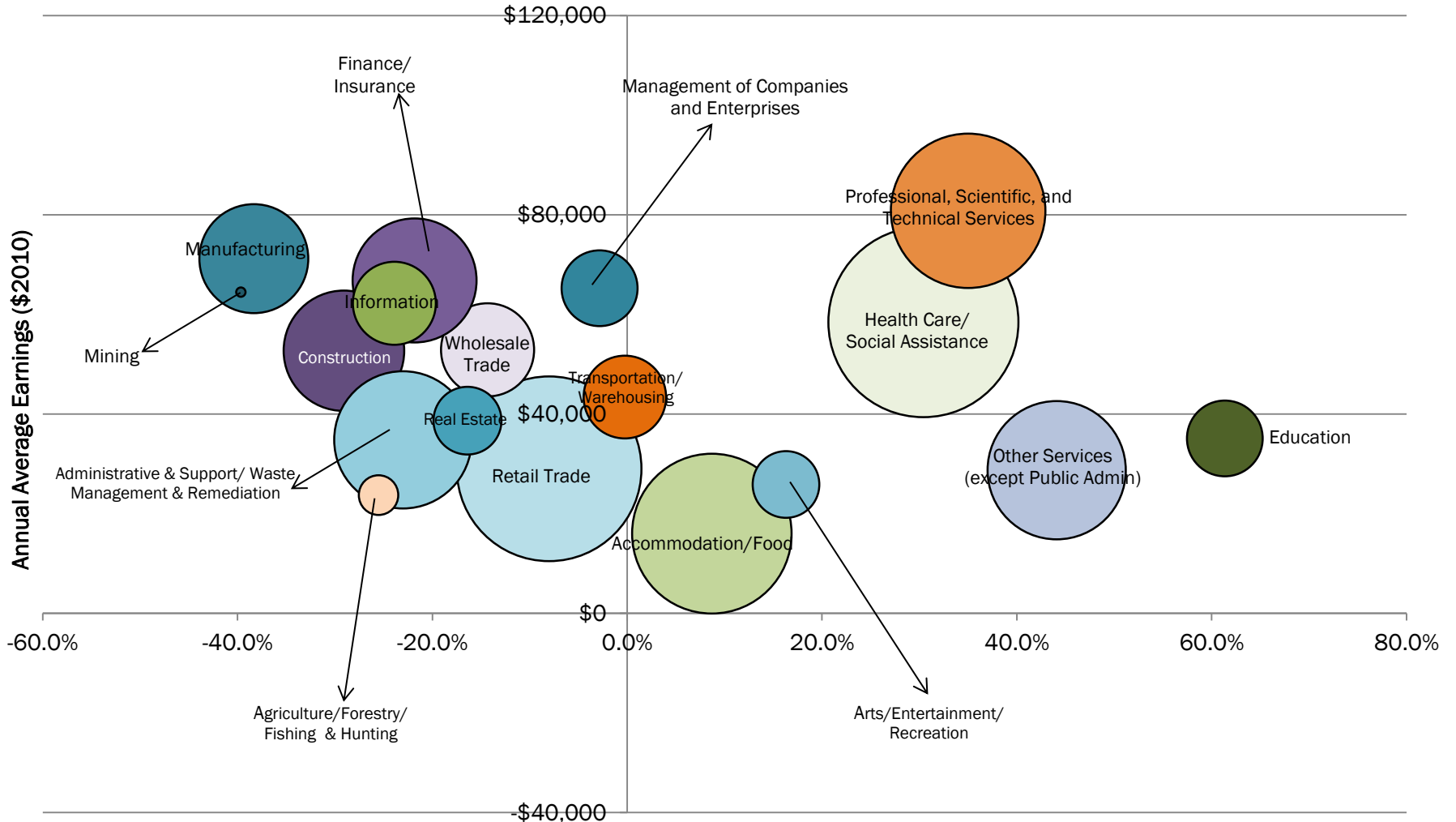

LINKING COMMUNITIES

Neighborhood Index : Using 5 indicators subtracting each from their mean of the county they are in and then dividing by the standard deviation.

Help determine the **combined effect of social factors** that impact **health and well-being**, including **poverty, unemployment, less than high school education, cancer risk, and premature births.**
