**Points of Consideration**

- Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis.
- The Institute may not accommodate all qualified candidates. Submission of an application does not guarantee acceptance.
- Only complete applications will be considered, and incomplete or incorrect applications will significantly delay the process. Please review before submission.
- A confirmation email will be sent within two business days after receipt of the complete application.
- Additional interviews may be requested before the final decision is made.
- Acceptance decisions will be announced within ten business days after the receipt of complete application.
- The visiting scholar program runs the duration of one calendar year of 12-months. However, under certain circumstances, scholars may return to the host country earlier than the scheduled date.

**Application Fee**

Please send us \$500 non-refundable application and visa processing fee in the form of cashier’s check or money order payable to “USC KSI.”

**Program Fee**

The program fee is due on an annual basis. For professionals from government offices and corporations, the fee is \$12,000. For university professors, the fee is \$6,000.

**Acknowledgement**

I hereby apply to the USC KSI Visiting Scholar Program, and acknowledge that all the information provided in the application form is correct to my knowledge. I understand that the application and visa processing fee is non-refundable, and once accepted to the program and upon arrival on campus, I will pay the program fee of \$12,000 to USC KSI. I acknowledge that USC KSI does not provide any financial assistance to the visiting scholar’s stay, and once accepted to the program, as a visiting scholar I will abide by all of the conditions, as

expressed by the USC Office of International Services, associated with the granting of the entrance to the United States. Failure to meet the said conditions can result in the termination of the visiting scholar status and the visa.
