- The visiting scholar program runs the duration of one calendar year of 12-months. However, under certain circumstances, scholars may return to the host country earlier than the scheduled date.

Application Fee

Please send us \$500 non-refundable application and visa processing fee in the form of cashier's check or money order payable to "USC KSI."

Program Fee

The program fee is due on an annual basis. For professionals from government offices and corporations, the fee is \$12,000. For university professors, the fee is \$6,000.
