



ICT Summer Research Program

The University of Southern California Institute for Creative Technologies (ICT) is a federally funded and university affiliated research center that operates artificial intelligence, graphics, virtual reality (VR) and narrative advance low-cost immersive techniques and technologies to solve problems facing service members, students, and society. They allow veterans to go online and speak anonymously to an interactive virtual coach who can remotely recognize signs of depression, PTSD, and suicide risk.

ICT brings film and game industry artists together with computer and social scientists to study and develop immersive media for military training, health therapies, education and more.

Hours:

The general business hours for the ICT are 9:00 am to 6:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Work days are usually 8 hours per day with a 1 hour unpaid meal period. Your exact work hours may be negotiated with your supervisor, but may not exceed more than 8 hours a day or more than 40 hours per week.

Tasks Include:

- Run studies
- Annotate (transcripts of interviews)
- Data analysis
- Experimental design

Requirements:

- The ICT Research Program requires a 10 to 12 week commitment
- No preferred majors or coursework
- Letter of recommendation
- Enthusiasm
