Why must I move my site?

The content management system (CMS) that the old USC Dornsife website uses is proprietary and is no longer supported. We will be phasing it out later this year.

The new platform has many benefits including:

- Adoption of **WordPress** for our CMS, which is more **secure, easier to operate and more flexible** than our previous CMS
- Design that meets **ADA accessibility standards**, a federal requirement that websites are designed to be accessible for people with disabilities
- **Improved search functionality** within our site and enhanced ability for Google searches to find our content
- A library of website templates and tools that allow web administrators to **easily customize sites** consistent with the USC Dornsife website design structure and brand guidelines.

How do I move my site?

We will provide website training for you to rebuild your site on our WordPress CMS as well as assistance with building your site for people who need it.
